Rapaport exploded onto the silver screen in 1993 in "Zebrahead" and received an Independent Spirit Award nomination for Best Male Lead. Since then, Rapaport has starred in numerous acclaimed films, including Woody Allen's "Small Time Crooks," Spike Lee's "Bamboozled," John Singleton's "Higher Learning," and Ted Demme's "Beautiful Girls." His other film credits include "Hitch" with Will Smith and Eva Mendes; "Men of Honor" opposite Robert DeNiro; "The Sixth Day" with Arnold Schwarzenegger; "Mighty Aphrodite"; "Kiss of Death"; "True Romance"; and "Deep Blue Sea." Rapaport made his feature directorial debut with the documentary "Beats, Rhymes and Life: The Travels of A Tribe Called Quest," which was nominated for a GRAMMY Award for Best Long Form Music Video.

His body of work also includes notable television appearances on "The War at Home," "Boston Public," "Friends," and "Prison Break."
