Jason deVilliers currently serves as executive producer, co-creator, writer, and director of "**The Aquabats! Super Show!**" on the Hub Network. Christian Jacobs, deVilliers, Donna Ebbs, and Nate Rogers are executive producers of "The Aquabats! Super Show!" from AWESOME FORCES! Productions.

DeVilliers' feature film credits include "The Flyboys" starring Tom Sizemore and Stephen Baldwin, which he co-wrote and co-produced, as well as "Ben Banks," starring Mischa Barton, on which he served as an executive producer and editor.

His television work includes serving as a writer, director and editor on Nickelodeon's BAFTA Award winning series "Yo Gabba Gabba!," which was also nominated for an Emmy<sup>®</sup> Award. Additionally, deVilliers serves as co-creator and co-producer for "DrumHeads," a top-rated reality show on the Halogen Network, for which deVilliers produced, directed and edited the pilot. He also directed 14 episodes of "The Aquabats! Super Show!" and co-wrote seven of them.

Besides his film and TV credits, deVilliers has directed, shot and edited music videos and several commercials, including spots for Vans shoes and Skullcandy headphones.

DeVilliers attended Art Center College of Design in Pasadena, Calif., where he graduated with honors. Originally from Oregon, deVilliers currently lives in Southern California with his wife Kelly and son Liam.
