Billy Brown Executive Producer, "R.L. Stine's The Haunting Hour: The Series"

Billy Brown is executive producer of the 2013 and 2014 Daytime Emmy® Award-winning series "R.L. Stine's The Haunting Hour: The Series" on the Hub Network. Dan Angel, Harvey Kahn and Kim Arnott also serve as executive producers of the program, which is from Front Street Pictures in association with The Hatchery, LLC.

Brown is an Emmy, Peabody and Writers Guild of America (WGA) award-winning writer and producer who has been creating, writing and supervising quality film and television production for 29 years. In 2007, along with longtime collaborator Dan Angel, Brown wrote and produced the first in a series of direct-to-DVD movies, "R.L. Stine's The Haunting Hour: Don't Think About It," in partnership with Universal Home Video and The Hatchery Entertainment. The movie premiered in September 2007 and earned him a Writers Guild Award nomination for Best Writing in Children's Script – Long Form or Special.

In television, Brown served as the head writer for the children's series, "Goosebumps," which is based on the popular book series by the master of children's horror R.L. Stine. Brown's additional credits include creator of "The Fearing Mind" and "Night Visions," as well as executive producer of the 2002 television movie, "Door to Door," which received an American Film Institute Award, Peabody Award, Primetime Emmy® Award and Critics' Choice Television Award.

Brown resides in Austin, Texas with his two children.
