

JFK: THE LOST TAPES

Just a stone's throw from London is a leafy paradise which is home to the secret world of snow leopards. *Snow Leopards of Leafy London* is a series that captures intimate and never seen before footage, of snow leopards that live in London. Presented by wildlife filmmaker Adrian Cale, the series takes us to the very heart of one of the biggest snow leopard collections on earth to meet Dr Terry Moore who runs the Cat Survival Trust and has created a haven for these endangered cats. In this series, Adrian will find out just what goes into keeping snow leopards, Terry style, along with everyday work of the Trust and their other cat residents from behind and in front of camera, gaining an insight into the bigger picture of cat conservation and developing his own bond with snow leopards.







MEET THE SLOTHS

Run by Judy Avey-Arroyo for 20 years, this is the only sanctuary in the world devoted to saving orphaned and injured sloths, and is home to over 160 of them, some of whom have become an internet sensation. It's an upside-down world where the secrets of one of nature's most enigmatic creatures are revealed. And it's not all about snoozing! This series, captures the kookiness of sanctuary life with more than a twist of humour, and shows that a sloth's life is more than just slothful.

RHINO WARS

UK SERIES PREMIERE WEDNESDAYS FROM 13TH NOVEMBER, 9.00PM *Rhino Wars* investigates a war that is raging in Kruger National Park, South Africa. The death toll is astonishing; each year, nearly 700 rhinos fall prey to poachers. At the heart of the conflict is the worldwide commercial demand for rhino horns, an exotic commodity that's more valuable than gold. This series, witness the conflict between the country's poachers and South Africa's anti-poaching unit, which has recruited armed forces to stop the illegal and lucrative trade. Cameras unveil the incessant violence and excessive carnage as park rangers are murdered trying to protect the wildlife that's indigenous to their homeland.

Four current and former members of the U.S. Special Ops are brought in to survey the situation, train the antipoaching corps, exchange tactical information and go on the front lines themselves to help defeat these ruthless criminals before the rhinos are brought to total extinction. But can they turn a hopeless situation into a bright future for the majestic rhino?





FATAL ATTRACTIONS

UK SERIES PREMIERE FRIDAYS FROM 1ST NOVEMBER, 9.00PM What drives people to bring deadly animals into their homes as pets? This brand new series examines the most extraordinary pet attacks of recent years including Antoine Yates who kept a 500lb tiger in his New York apartment and raised an alligator in his bedroom. Ted Dres who was bitten on the face and neck by his 13-foot pet python, which then, in a feeding frenzy, coiled around his neck and asphyxiated him as his horrified girlfriend looked on.

Each episode of *Fatal Attractions* focuses on a different group of animals - primates, reptiles, big cats and more and reveals why people bring them into their homes, how the relationships develop and why, ultimately, these pets attack.





MY EXTREME ANIMAL PHOBIA




HEROES OF HELL ISLAND

The strategic island of Malta was no exception. Despite the fact that the best pilots were kept to defend London, this tiny island beat the odds. It was the most bombed place on earth, yet its pilots performed far better than expected. With their unconventional methods these pilots shot down Hitler's hopes of conquering North Africa and paved the way for the liberation of South Europe.

Heroes of Hell Island: The Men Who Saved Malta features exclusive interviews, accurate re-enactments, archive footage and CGI; this documentary tells a great story about the hardships and triumphs of an outstanding group of pilots.







BATTLE OF THE SOMME THE TRUE STORY

This gripping documentary follows a team of investigators who use forensic science to uncover the truth of what really happened on that fateful day. Originally, in 1916, cameraman Geoffrey Malins had been allowed to record the frontline. Since they had anticipated victory, the footage was combined with fake sequences when it all went horribly wrong. The film was then turned into 'The Battle of the Somme' which was a propaganda film used to rally a grieving nation. Now, with the help of dedicated historians and scientists. this 90 year old silent film surrenders its secrets.

Battle of the Somme: The True Story reveals the secrets and shows exactly which sequences were faked and which are real. This one-off episode finally tells the real story behind the historic event.







GREATEST TANK BATTLES

UK SERIES PREMIERE SUNDAYS FROM 17TH NOVEMBER, 9.00PM

Greatest Tank Battles recreates monumental armoured conflict at its most compelling. Filmed on battlefields across the world, and using stunning, ultra-realistic CGI animation and eyewitness accounts, this original series puts viewers in the heat of the battles. This new series re-enacts iconic wars including the Second World War, the Vietnamese war, whose tank armour turned the war in favour of the Communists. the battles of the South Pacific. where the role played by tanks in the decisive victory against the Japanese is often underplayed.

Later on in the series, follow as it investigates Michael Wittmann- one of the Second World War's greatest panzer aces and a formidable foe of the Allies, and the crucial battles in Northern Italy between the Canadians and the Nazis.







THE PRESIDENTS GATEKEEPERS

The President's Gatekeepers is a behind the scenes insight into the history of the White House Chiefs of Staff. Called the world's second toughest job - and also the world's worst, the White House chiefs of staff translate the presidents' policies into reality - or disaster. They are the inside eyewitnesses to history, and the confidants with whom the president, and the first lady, share their secrets. Spanning nine administrations discover which White House Chief of Staff Dick Cheney blamed for bringing on his first heart attack. And why was Rahm Emanuel so apprehensive about taking the iob?

Also, which 25-year-old Chief of Staff was put in charge of reviewing J. Edgar Hoover's infamous FBI files before forwarding them to the President? In this two part special, The President's Gatekeepers provides a compelling look at the world of the closest confidante the President has.
