THE LAST 24

New Series Premieres Friday, May 11 at 9/8c

- Monster at the Gates premieres Friday, May 11 at 9/8c
 - A Jacksonville firefighter discovers his wife's body in the bedroom of their gated home. His confession of infidelity initially makes him the prime suspect. But it's a stolen car caught on CCTV that ultimately leads investigators to the killer.
- Blind Terror premieres Friday, May 11 at 10/9c
 Investigating a murder in a luxurious Miami suburb, detectives uncover a thriving law practice that made plenty of enemies, a business partner caught in a lie, and a troubled son with a lifelong grudge.

- The Silencer premieres Thursday, May 10 at 10/9c
 With the help of a neighbor, an injured woman calls 9-1-1 saying an intruder broke into her boyfriend's home and shot them both. Police respond and find the boyfriend dead.
 Cops must decipher strange evidence left behind to identify the killer.

THE KILLER BESIDE ME

New Episodes Premiere Saturdays at 10/9c

THE KILLER BESIDE ME exposes the dark underbelly of workplace evil, where rivalry romance and the abuse of power culminates in murder. How well do you really know your co-workers?

- In Broad Daylight *premieres Sunday, May 13 at 9/8c*Mother of three, Holly Cantrell, is seen on security video exiting the Oklahoma hospital where she works; but Holly never returns home. Police learn Holly was keeping secrets, and her loved ones wonder if those had anything to do with her disappearance.
