EXTREME MEASURES

New Series Premieres Thursday, May 24 at 10/9c

- **Sister Act premieres Thursday, May 24 at 10/9c**

- **Girl Interrupted premieres Friday, May 18 at 9/8c**

New Episodes Premiere Sundays at 9/8c

- **Just Out of Sight premieres Sunday, May 20 at 9/8c**
