**PREMIERES**

**BROKEN TRUST**

**New Series Premieres Wednesday, June 13 at 9/8c**

Who we choose to trust can be a life or death decision. BROKEN TRUST tells chilling real tales of when trust is betrayed with deadly consequences and how in the blink of an eye, the world we thought was safe can become unrecognizable and terrifying.

- **The Landlord premieres Wednesday, June 13 at 9/8c**

Karen Jenkins' building is in a rough area, but she's determined to help the neighborhood and all of her tenants along with it. The problem is that each of them seems to have something to hide. And one of them will do anything to keep those secrets safe.

- **Mirror in the Basement premieres Wednesday, June 20 at 9/8c**

When Adele and Stephen Craven bring in handyman Rusty McIntire to remodel their suburban basement, it kicks off a chain of events that raises their marriage to the ground, rocks their trust in the people around them and ultimately has deadly consequences.

**REASONABLE DOUBT**

**New Season Premieres Wednesday, June 13 at 10/9c**

In a justice system that's not always so just, families can be tormented by the question of guilt or innocence of their convicted loved ones. REASONABLE DOUBT returns with all-new episodes profiling the gut-wrenching process of re-exploring murder cases where the perpetrators convicted of the crime maintain their innocence. In the second season, retired homicide detective Chris Anderson teams with his new partner, criminal defense attorney Fatima Silva, to pore through evidence, interview witnesses and consult experts previously overlooked by police or barred by the court. At the end of each episode, the determined investigators evaluate their findings and either offer the convicted's family hope for an appeal, or clarity to accept the guilty verdict.

- **Convicted by a Hair premieres Wednesday, June 13 at 10/9c**  
In 2011, 19-year-old KC Grondin got his first girlfriend. It's also the year he was charged with her murder. Chris and Fatima reopen the case to see if KC's family is right to believe that his conviction was a grave injustice, or if the prosecution got it right and KC was an angry teenager driven to kill for lust and money.
- **High-Stakes Homicide premieres Wednesday, June 20 at 10/9c**  
Pest control worker Kim Cain was convicted of murdering a 71-year-old Palm Beach socialite. The prosecution argued she found Cain stealing her jewelry to support a gambling addiction. Cain's family is hoping Chris and Fatima can prove his innocence.

### **DISAPPEARED**

#### **Season Finale Airs Sunday, June 24 at 9/8c**

DISAPPEARED takes viewers inside the world of a family holding out hope that their missing loved one will be found. Cinematic recreations and poignant interviews with families, friends and law enforcement paint the picture of a missing person's last known whereabouts. Each episode concludes with a call to action asking viewers to share fresh leads or new information to reinvigorate cases for law enforcement.

- **Moment of Truth premieres Sunday, June 17 at 9/8c**  
When 70-year-old retired firefighter Michael Chambers goes missing, a bloody crime scene in his garage quickly indicates foul play. But authorities begin to believe that the crime scene may have been staged and that Michael may have left on his own.
- **A Date with Danger premieres Sunday, June 24 at 9/8c**
