TRUTH AND LIES: JONESTOWN

Special Airs Monday, October 22 at 8/7c

A charismatic religious leader moves his congregation from California to a remote area in Guyana with the goal of creating an isolated society. But this new settlement results in the death of 918 people, including a congressman and the religious leader himself.

THE LAST DEFENSE: JULIUS JONES

Special Airs Saturday, October 28 at 8/7c

Executive produced by Viola Davis and Julius Tennon, THE LAST DEFENSE explores and exposes flaws in the American justice system through emotional, in-depth examinations of the death row cases of Darlie Routier and Julius Jones. The series seeks to trace the path that led both Routier and Jones to their places on death row, while taking a deep look into their personal stories. This instalment follows former high school basketball state champion and star football player Julius Jones on death row after he was convicted for the murder of a businessman in 1999.

HOME ALONE

New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 10/9c
