COLD VALLEY

Special Premieres Thursday, November 29 at 9/8c

This investigative documentary follows two women as they work to unravel the mysterious disappearances that tormented the Lewis Clark Valley in the 1980s. The most chilling part of these cases? Investigators are certain who the killer is, but no one has been able to gather enough evidence to confidently prosecute him. Now Detective Jackie Nichols and Gloria Bobertz enter the scene, dusting off the case files, tracking down old witnesses and pursuing new leads.

- **Person of Interest premieres Thursday, November 29 at 9/8c**
Between 1979 and 1982, five young people went missing or were found murdered in the Lewis Clark Valley. Decades later, Detective Jackie Nichols picks up the trail and begins her hunt for a serial killer who has evaded justice for over 40 years.
- **Hunting a Killer premieres Thursday, December 6 at 9/8c**
Detective Jackie Nichols continues her hunt for an elusive serial killer responsible for the murder and disappearances of five young people in the Lewis Clark Valley. This is her last chance for justice and time is running out.

BODY CAM

New Series Premieres Tuesday, November 27 at 10/9c

Taking viewers on the ultimate ride-along, Investigation Discovery announces BODY CAM, a gripping new series that gives viewers their own eyewitness look at the life-or-death instant decisions of policework, as told by officers' own body camera footage. Offering an immersive portrayal of life on the streets, BODY CAM engages a unique storytelling technique combining the body camera footage with first-hand accounts to virtually place viewers in harrowing

moments as the suspense builds and the tension rises. Each episode tells multiple stories of those who vowed to protect and serve in unflinching detail, offering viewers their own personal perspective of officers in life-threatening circumstances. From domestic disputes to ambushes and traffic stops gone dangerously awry, BODY CAM profiles just how quickly seemingly routine situations can escalate into tragic altercations.

- **Officer Down premieres Tuesday, November 27 at 10/9c**

Officers find themselves pitted against a lone gunman holed up in a suburban home; The nerve of a rookie cop is tested when a routine stop on the highway goes horribly wrong.

- **Shots Fired premieres Tuesday, December 4 at 10/9c**

A domestic dispute turns into a hostage situation when children's lives are at stake; an apparent vehicle accident turns into a shocking multiple murder with armed killers on the run; a disturbance at a liquor store leaves an officer fighting for his life.

DEADLY LEGACY

New Limited Series Premieres Sunday, December 9 at 10/9c

Depraved serial killer John Wayne Gacy hunted in the streets of Chicago in the 1970s, luring 33 young men to a violent death. While many have considered John Wayne Gacy's terrifying reign of terror closed, the case was re-energized in 2011 when the Cook County Police Department decided to reopen the case. Each episode of DEADLY LEGACY follows Detective Sergeant Jason Moran takes viewers through his investigation as he receives thousands of tips, scours through evidence, and narrows in on three missing persons, interviewing their family, friends, and original investigators, ultimately solving each case.

- **Part One premieres Sunday, December 9 at 10/9c**

William "Bill" Bundy disappeared from the Chicago area after failing to come home from a party in October of 1976. After the resurgence of the Gacy case, his sister Laura contacts Detective Moran to see if Bill's disappearance was somehow connected to Gacy. Moran agrees to look into Bill's disappearance, and finally uncovers the mystery of what happened to Bill.

THE NIGHT THAT DIDN'T END

New Series Premieres Tuesday, November 27 at 11/10c

When a person is murdered, their life's story comes to an abrupt end. But for the loved ones left behind, it's just the start of an unending nightmare. THE NIGHT THAT DIDN'T END brings to the forefront the raw, undying emotion that lives in the wake of a homicide, through the eyes of those closest to the events and most damaged by the loss. Their lives will never be the same, but in the end, their grief-filled recollections and vividly recounted first person descriptions, come together to reveal the truth behind the tragedy.

- **Night on the Parkway premieres Tuesday, November 27 at 11/10c**

HOME ALONE

Season Finale Airs Tuesday, November 27 at 8/7c

When night falls and you're the only one at home, the coziest of houses can transform into a sinister, unfamiliar labyrinth. A noise in the yard or an unfamiliar shadow down the hall can send shivers down the spine, especially when you discover there is someone else in the house. In HOME ALONE, a quiet suburban house becomes the setting for unimaginable horror. Highlighting stories of revengeful exes who refuse to disappear, the victims find that the walls around them are no longer a safe sanctuary.

- **The Men Who Stole Christmas premieres Tuesday, November 27 at 8/7c**

THE CORONER: I SPEAK FOR THE DEAD

Season Finale Airs Friday, December 7 at 10/9c

They say everybody has a story to tell. Graham Hetrick knows every *body* has a story, and it's his job to listen. The child of an undertaker, Graham grew up in a funeral home. For him, being around dead bodies is a normal part of life. For the last 25 years, Graham has been the Coroner of Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. He handles close to 700 suspicious deaths each year. THE CORONER: I SPEAK FOR THE DEAD chronicles some of his most mysterious and disturbing homicides. While detectives search for clues among the living, Graham - a medical death investigator - is uncovering the secrets of the dead.

- **While You Slept premieres Friday, November 30 at 10/9c**
When Jimmy Felder's mutilated body is found in his bedroom, Dauphin County Coroner Graham Hetrick arrives to one of the bloodiest crime scenes he's ever seen. Graham must read Jimmy's wounds to discover a rage that lies dangerously close to home.
- **He'll Open the Door premieres Friday, December 7 at 10/9c**
When the body of nursing student Hitender Thakur is found shot to death behind the counter of the Harrisburg, PA convenience store where he works, it's up to Coroner Graham Hetrick to help police hunt a killer who has disappeared without a trace.

Patricia's sister becomes suspicious the fire was deliberate and with the sheriff's office refusing to help, starts an investigation on her own. Sharon battles silence for ten years until the surprising culprit brags one too many times, allowing her to slowly tease out the truth.

- ***A Killing in Kendrick premieres Tuesday, December 4 at 9/8c***

Donna Fontaine and her boyfriend Fred Palahniuk are found shot dead in a burning building in remote Kendrick, Idaho. It's clear some in Kendrick know the killer, but the

killer knows how to keep them quiet. Detectives must learn how to break down the silence to catch Donna and Fred's killer.

HOMICIDE HUNTER: LT. JOE KENDA

New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 9/8c

Murder changes the life of a victim, the convicted killer, and their families... but what about the investigator? Enter retired homicide detective Lt. Joe Kenda, who spent 23 years with the Colorado Springs Police Department and has seen his fair share of madness, mystery, and murder. With one of the highest case closure rates in the country at 92 percent, Kenda's crime-solving process has helped bring closure to many heartbroken families. In each episode, he cracks open his case files using an eidetic memory that recalls even the smallest of details, with an intense, deliberate drawl and cool, no-nonsense demeanor that leaves viewers hanging on every word.

- **Staged to Kill premieres Friday, December 7 at 11:30/10:30c**
Mechanic Ed Postma love cars, so when he pulls over to a remote convenience store to help with a breakdown, he wasn't expecting to be shot to death. Persistent police work uncovers a bitter love triangle fueled by jealousy and rage.

KILLER UNKNOWN

New Episodes Premiere Saturdays at 10/9c

What happens when the finest investigators in America come out of retirement to bring their collective experience and talents to bear on solving some of the world's most notorious cold murder cases?
