BTK: A KILLER AMONG US

Two-Hour Special Premieres Sunday, February 17 at 10/9c

In 1974, the city of Wichita, Kansas lost its reputation as a peaceful community when Dennis Rader began his killing spree with the murders of four members of the Otero family. The hunt for a murderer who detailed his desire to “bind, torture, and kill” his victims held the city of Wichita on edge for over 30 years, who eventually dubbed him the “BTK Killer”. Tormenting police and the media with notes and remnants of his crimes, BTK continued to correspond with the public, until his insatiable need to be recognized for his crimes led to his arrest in 2005. BTK: A KILLER AMONG US exposes BTK Killer Dennis Rader’s shocking double life through comprehensive interviews with law enforcement, victim’s family members, and arguably the most important person to Rader: his daughter, Kerri Rawson.

GRAVE MYSTERIES

HEART OF DARKNESS

New Series Premieres Saturday, February 9 at 9/8c

- **Lust for Murder premieres Saturday, February 9 at 9/8c**

The only trace of the killer is an inflammatory message on the wall that accuses Stacie of infidelity. With the writing on the wall as their first clue, police must unpack the secrets in Stacie's life to find her murderer.
- **History of Violence premieres Saturday, February 16 at 9/8c**
After a series of bad relationships, Edwardyne Williams thinks she has finally found love with her third husband, Mike. But when 50-year-old Edwardyne goes missing the week after Thanksgiving, family and friends fear the worst. After an exhaustive two-week search, her body is found in an isolated wooded area less than a mile from her home. At first, it appears to be a random act of violence, but as police dig deeper they discover an unlikely suspect with a violent past, who has been holding a grudge against Edwardyne for years.

AMERICAN NIGHTMARE

Season Finale Airs Tuesday, February 12 at 9/8c

Our best times, our warmest memories, our worst nightmares. When real life home movies and photos meet real crime scene video and stills, murder mysteries become emotional powerhouses in AMERICAN NIGHTMARE.

- **No Good Deed premieres Tuesday, February 5 at 9/8c**
Winter in Iowa gets an extra chill when Shirley Wilson's son find her stabbed to death in her home. With no visible signs of forced entry, detectives believe this grandmother of 12 knew her assailant, leaving the family wondering who has betrayed them in cold blood.
- **The Answering Machine premieres Tuesday, February 12 at 9/8c**
When a charitable, up-and-coming actress is killed in her home, police believe an angry, vengeful killer is responsible. But no one could expect the lies, obsessions, and evidence that would be uncovered in this shocking cold case.

BODY CAM

Season Finale Airs Tuesday, February 12 at 9/8c

Later, Callahan Walsh explores law enforcement's claims that Gloria Shulze from Scottsdale, AZ is allegedly a freeloading drunk driver who has repeatedly cheated the legal system. Shulze has been on the lam for 24 years after allegedly killing anti-drunk driving advocate, Angela Maher.
