BETRAYED

Season Three Premieres Monday, March 4 at 10/9c

In a town like any other town, they were a family just like any other family surrounding themselves with people they could trust... or, so they thought. Things are not always as they seem in BETRAYED, which revisits heart-pounding cases of deception that ended in murder at the hands of a trusted family member, co-worker, lover, or friend. As investigators, family, and friends peel back the layers and facts of each case, the otherworldly narrator already knows where the breadcrumb trail ends. They guide viewers through the various relationships that comprise their life, raising suspicions about who will commit the ultimate betrayal and bring about their doom.

- Suited for Murder premieres Monday, March 4 at 10/9c
 After two kids and two divorces, 62-year-old Kath Goble is making herself a priority for the first time in her life. The Charleston, West Virginia native is well-liked around town and known for her vibrant personality. However, her carefree ways soon catch up with her and she is betrayed in the worst way possible.
- Welcome to Murderhood premieres Monday, March 11 at 10/9c
 40-year-old Priscilla Strole is looking for a fresh start when she and her teenage son Kyle move to the small town of Fairfield, North Carolina. After navigating her way through a series of bad relationships, Priscilla's life finally seems to be on the right track. Little does she know that someone in her new life has evil intent.

DEADLY RECALL

New Series Premieres Tuesday, March 5 at 10/9c

Some crime scenes are so dreadful that law enforcement want to forget them, but Detective Pat Postiglione operates differently; he wants to remember every single detail. DEADLY RECALL follows homicide Det. Pat Postiglione as he explores crime scenes with his photographic memory and laser sharp eye for spotting key evidence. • Side Business premieres Tuesday, March 5 at 10/9c

Later, Callahan Walsh looks at Rudy Fernandez, whose teen romance with his high school sweetheart, Griselda Sandoval, allegedly turned deadly in Ontario, Canada.

KILLING TIME

New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 10/9c

KILLING TIME is a crime-mystery series that focuses on a critical period of time lost the day of a homicide. Detectives who worked the case recount their investigation step-by-step, revealing shocking discoveries that deepen the mystery at every turn.
