**THE ATLANTA CHILD MURDERS**

**Three-Part Special Premieres Saturday, March 23 at 8/7c**

In 1979, the city of Atlanta fell victim to a terrifying 23 months wherein 29 African-American youths were stolen from their families and found killed. Multiple suspicions lead nowhere, and conspiracy theories ran rampant. Decades later, no person has been tried for these murders, and the killer has never been confirmed. **HOMETOWN HOMICIDE**

**Finale Airs Tuesday, March 26 at 9/8c**

In HOMETOWN HOMICIDE, local news footage and other archive bring to life the stories of gripping murder investigations. These breaking news stories are vividly real, giving the viewer an urgent in-the-moment immediacy. Viewers will feel a jolt of excitement, as if they were witnessing these stories live.

- **This Just In premieres Tuesday, March 19 at 9/8c**  
After college student Jessica O'Grady vanishes late one night after leaving to see her boyfriend, locals are left to wonder if she was kidnapped. Another woman also disappeared a week earlier, and the town begins to question if there is a serial killer on the loose.
- **I Will Find You premieres Tuesday, March 26 at 9/8c**  
19-year-old Ali Kemp was working as a pool attendant in Leawood, Kansas in the summer of 2002 when she was viciously attacked in the middle of the day. News reports, family photos and home video tell the heartbreaking story of a father's tireless quest to find his daughter's killer.

## **ONGOING SERIES**

### **GRAVE MYSTERIES**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 9/8c**

Police say that solving a murder is like putting together a giant jigsaw puzzle. GRAVE MYSTERIES recounts some of the nation's most bewildering murder investigations, following investigators as they solve the case, piece by piece. Every new piece of the puzzle seems to send the investigation into surprising new directions. Sometimes, new pieces of the puzzle seem to confuse the picture but, in the end, one crucial piece is found that allows us to reconstruct the crime from beginning to end. With a clear-eyed view of what happened, the police are able to uncover the culprit and the shocking truth.

- ***Evil Among Us premieres Monday, March 18 at 9/8c***

In early August 2015, Jeffrey Kebler is found dead in his Clinton County, MI home. In order to track down his killer, detectives must follow a digital trail left by the victim. What they end up uncovering is far more than what they bargained for.

- ***New Year's Nightmare premieres Monday, March 25 at 9/8c***

On New Year's Eve in 2009, Mikarah Sanders is shot in a home invasion. Police search for the intruder by diving into her digital world, and are shocked where they learn the killer has been under their noses all along, driven by rage to commit a crime of passion.

### **BETRAYED**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 10/9c**

Things are not always as they seem in BETRAYED, which revisits heart-pounding cases of deception that ended in murder at the hands of a trusted family member, co-worker, lover, or friend. As investigators, family, and friends peel back the layers and facts of each case, the otherworldly narrator already knows where the breadcrumb trail ends. They guide viewers through the various relationships that comprise their life, raising suspicions about who will commit the ultimate betrayal and bring about their doom.

- ***Final Curtain premieres Monday, March 18 at 10/9c***

40-year-old Pasinetta Prince plays the many roles in her life with all the grace, charm and beauty of a movie star. She relishes the spotlight, however, the frame in her life isn't only on stage. Before long, a personal betrayal snuffs out Pasinetta's star.

- ***Deadly Crush premieres Monday, March 25 at 10/9c***

25-year-old Corey Parker is looking for fun and sun when she moves to the beach-side town of Jacksonville, Florida. Corey quickly establishes a new circle of friends, but she is unaware that someone has murderous intent that will end her life.

### **DEADLY RECALL**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 10/9c**

Some crime scenes are so dreadful that law enforcement want to forget them, but Detective Pat Postiglione operates differently; he wants to remember every single detail. DEADLY RECALL follows homicide Det. Pat Postiglione as he explores crime scenes with his photographic

memory and laser sharp eye for spotting key evidence. For some, this might be haunting, but for Det. Postiglione, it's his life calling.

- **How Did I Get Here? premieres Tuesday, March 19 at 10/9c**

On March 10, 1999, the remains of 31-year-old Christine Ullman is found 25 miles away from her home, two months after vanishing. Hidden inside the wooded crime scene is a clue that Pat recalls more than a year later, which leads to the capture of a dangerous predator.

- **Closing Time premieres Tuesday, March 26 at 10/9c**

In October of 1993, the body of 46-year-old Ronnie Bingham is found inside his popular Nashville bar, The Corral Club. As the search for Ronnie's killer enters its third month, Pat is sent to investigate a double murder of a young married couple at a Nashville motel. Although the homicides seem unrelated, Pat recalls a pivotal clue from the Corral Club that links the crime scenes together.

## **SEE NO EVIL**

### **New Episodes Premiere Wednesday at 9/8c**

SEE NO EVIL reveals how the deadliest crimes are solved by the only witnesses that never lie and never forget: surveillance cameras. With more shocking CCTV footage than ever before, SEE NO EVIL proves there's nowhere killers can hide.

- **I'd Kill to be You premieres Wednesday, March 20 at 9/8c**

On November 12, 2012, Atlanta entrepreneur Terry Porter is found shot dead, execution style in the front yard of his home. There are no witnesses and no forensic evidence at the crime scene, but the victim's credit cards are missing. In the hunt for leads, detectives attempt to track the killer's movements through CCTV surveillance footage.

- **Call Me back, Chris premieres Wednesday, March 27 at 9/8c**

In February 2008, Christopher Duncan left his apartment in San Antonio Texas, never to return again. Police have little to go on until surveillance footage has the potential to reveal the identity of a dangerous killer.

## **IN PURSUIT WITH JOHN WALSH**

### **New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 10/9c**

IN PURSUIT WITH JOHN WALSH takes the audience on a journey through the eyes of family members, friends and authorities who are desperate for resolution, detailing two fugitives and two missing children each hour. Every week, John and Callahan dissect each unique story from top to bottom, sharing current interviews with surviving family members and friends, chasing down new clues and reviewing the evidence in each case. The series will utilize crime scene photos, telephone calls and location-specific recreations, turning these cases into active hunts with help from the ID viewers at home.

- **Deadly Daughter premieres Wednesday, March 20 at 10/9c**

As a part of the neighborhood watch in El Cerrito, CA, everyone thought Alicia "Lisa" Osibin could be trusted. John Walsh looks at whether Alicia may be responsible for her own mother, Mary Osibin's murder. Then, Callahan travels to Alpine, CA to speak with Andrea Wesche, who is desperate for the capture of her alleged abuser, Frederick McClean.

- **Murder in Appalachia premieres Wednesday, March 27 at 10/9c**  
John Walsh investigates how Eric Jones, the son of a preacher in Appalachia, VA, allegedly murdered his ex-wife, Janina Jefferson. Later, Callahan Walsh tries to make sense of how a dispute over a dog in Albuquerque, NM, could provoke Ricardo Villanueva Cordova to allegedly murder Michael Sanchez in broad daylight.

## **DEAD OF NIGHT**

### **New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 9/8c**

DEAD OF NIGHT features nail-biting true stories of victims working the graveyard shift who are thrust into real-life nightmares. A killer lies in wait to strike the most vulnerable, those alone in the dark. When the sun sets, the body count will rise.

- **Kill Me Twice premieres Thursday, March 21 at 9/8c**  
When residents of Allentown, PA learn a vicious serial killer is roaming the streets, the city starts buzzing with fear. For months, the unidentified attacker preys on innocent women in the middle of the night, covered by the cloak of darkness. When one woman catches a glimpse of the monster, she puts her life on the line to get him off the streets.
- **He Shouldn't Be With Us premieres Thursday, March 28 at 9/8c**  
Family and friends of Patricia Miller are horrified when she is murdered just months after moving to escape a troubled relationship. The violent crime scene is a shock to the police, leaving the community on edge. When another murder scene is discovered in a nearby town, all of their questions may be answered.

## **KILLING TIME**

### **New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 10/9c**

KILLING TIME is a crime-mystery series that focuses on a critical period of time lost the day of a homicide. Detectives who worked the case recount their investigation step-by-step, revealing shocking discoveries that deepen the mystery at every turn. As suspects are identified and hours, minutes and seconds of the victim's last day slowly come to light, a window of missing time appears. Investigators use everything from surveillance footage to credit card statements to GPS data to piece together the rest of the timeline and solve the murder.

- **While You Were Sleeping premieres Thursday, March 21 at 10/9c**  
A couple is attacked while sleeping at home, and only the wife survives. She first implicates her own son, but later claims he couldn't have done it. With little forensic evidence placing Chris at the scene, detectives need to determine whether a son was capable of killing his own parents.
- **Mommy's Not Moving premieres Thursday, March 28 at 10/9c**  
Shauna Tiffay is still dressed in her work uniform when she is discovered dead in her Las Vegas home. Security cameras caught her clocking out only hours before. After reports of a previous intruder, detectives Dan Long and Terri Miller piece together a timeline of events to reveal something sinister afoot in Sin City.

## **SECRETS OF THE MORGUE**

### **New Episodes Premiere Fridays at 10/9c**

SECRETS OF THE MORGUE explores high-profile murder cases from the perspective of the medical examiner as they work alongside homicide detectives to bring justice to murder victims and their families. A victim's body tells a hidden story, and these post-mortem experts help solve crimes by unraveling the mystery from the inside out. From initial observations at the scene of the crime to the autopsy and beyond, each episode gets under the skin to unlock riveting crime puzzles.

- **Murder on the Mountain premieres Friday, March 22 at 10/9c**

When a single mom is murdered in Colorado, detectives soon have three prime suspects in their sights. Although each insists he had nothing to do with the crime, DNA from all three is found on the victim's body.

- **Lady in the Lagoon premieres Friday, March 22 at 11/10c**

The body of a transgender woman is found in a pond outside of Cleveland. Detectives close in on three prime suspects, but it's up to the medical examiner to find a forensic link between the victim and her killer.

- **Lake of Lies premieres Friday, March 29 at 10/9c**

Patricia Wlasuik's body and truck are found in a lake in rural New York. Hysterical with grief, her husband explains she was drunk and drove off the road. Detectives try to reconstruct the accident, but the story isn't adding up. The autopsy soon reveals a critical clue that suggests there is a more sinister truth.

- **Severed Ties premieres Friday, March 29 at 11/10c**

Facing the shattered remains of a horrible crime and one of the biggest mysteries of her career, a forensic anthropologist pores over a box of bones in search of a microscopic missing link.
