MADELEINE MCCANN: AN ID MURDER MYSTERY

Two-Hour Special Premieres Sunday, April 7 at 9/8c

For Kate and Gerry McCann, the night of May 3, 2007 was the day their dream Portugal vacation turned into a living nightmare. This infamous night was when their 3-year-old daughter, Madeleine, vanished from their hotel room just yards from where the young parents were dining. Convinced she was kidnapped from her bed, the McCanns desperately plead for Madeleine's safe return, sparking a worldwide manhunt. But as international authorities ramped up their efforts, a veil of suspicion was cast on everyone by law enforcement and loved ones alike. Ten years following her shocking disappearance, ID examines what really happened to Madeleine McCann that fateful night in MCCANN: AN ID MURDER MYSTERY.

PREMIERES

UNBREAKABLE: LIVE TO TELL

New Series Premieres Monday, April 8 at 9/8c

UNBREAKABLE: LIVE TO TELL follows survivors, loved ones and witnesses as they share riveting stories of survival, recounting harrowing life-or-death situations they endured, and the permanent physical and emotional scars as they must heal after narrowly escaping death. Accompanied by thematic dramatizations and first-person interviews, UNBREAKABLE: LIVE TO TELL takes viewers on a twisted journey, examining suspicious warnings and missed signs leading up to the crime that changed their lives forever.

- **101 premieres Monday, April 8 at 9/8c**

Merry Jackson remembers her daughter Lori, who, after falling for charming single dad Scott Gellately, becomes caught in a cycle of abuse. Amid their troubling relationship, Lori gives birth to twins. Now, with the children's lives at stake, Merry vows to do everything in her power to help her daughter break free from Scott's controlling grip before things take a deadly turn.

NEVER SAY GOODBYE

New Series Premieres Tuesday, April 2 at 9/8c

We say goodbye to someone we love every day. But what if we never see our loved one alive again? Each episode of NEVER SAY GOODBYE tells the story of a harrowing murder investigation from the point-of-view of the last person to see the victim alive.

- ***Evil Lurks premieres Tuesday, April 2 at 9/8c***

A mother's worst nightmare comes to life when her 12-year-old son goes missing. An all-out search for the missing boy comes up empty, until a motorist makes a horrific discovery. Nothing can prepare this small town for the terrible secret revealed: evil has been hiding in plain sight.

- ***Overkill premieres Tuesday, April 9 at 9/8c***

A husband returns home to find his wife murdered just steps away from their infant daughter. The clues point to someone she knows, making everyone a suspect. Then, investigators uncover a dark secret and reveal a cold-blooded killer.

HOMICIDE CITY

Season Two Premieres Wednesday, April 10 at 10/9c

HOMICIDE CITY takes a deep dive into the crimes that shook Philadelphia to its core. The series explores cases from a darker time that had police detectives banding together across the metropolitan landscape in a sequence of manhunts. From the mansions and manicured lawns of the wealthy Mainline suburbs to the inner-city Badlands, each episode is told through the eyes of veteran homicide detectives, local beat reporters and the victims' families who lost so much.

- ***Family Tragedy premieres Wednesday, April 10 at 10/9c***

When 18-month-old Devon Manderach's body is found in a park outside Philly, police suspect the parents; but when her father calls looking for both the toddler and her mom, police quickly learn the case is more horrific and tragic than they imagined.

THE LAST 24

Mid-Season Premiere Wednesday, April 10 at 11/10c

THE LAST 24 follows determined investigators working the most shocking murder cases as they reconstruct the tragic final hours in the victim's life, in order to find their killer and crack the case.

- ***Somebody Knows Something premieres Wednesday, April 10 at 11/10c***

In rural Michigan, 34-year-old Deborah Boothby dies after a hit and run on the highway. The case remains unsolved for nine years until a team of detectives review the evidence and the cold case becomes a murder investigation.

IN PLAIN SIGHT

New Series Premieres Friday, April 12 at 11/10c

IN PLAIN SIGHT is a riveting whodunit, featuring disturbing cases of murder and serious crime where the culprit was interviewed by the media, posted in social media or newspaper reports and brazenly showed their face while all the time they had blood on their hands.

- ***It Was All a Lie premieres Friday, April 12 at 11/10c***

Wounded and bleeding Charles Stuart calls 911 with a terrified tale of carjacking that results in the death of his pregnant wife. As police mount a manhunt for the killers, they begin to suspect something doesn't add up.

- **Blinded by Blonde premieres Friday, April 12 at 11:30/10:30c**

Brian Barrett was shot to death just before he was supposed to meet his online dream girl. To catch the killer, police must venture into the murky world of chat rooms. They discover an entire online fantasy world where nothing is what it seems, and everyone is corrupted by lust and jealousy.

MURDER DECODED

New Series Premieres Saturday, April 6 at 9/8c

In the wake of every murder, clues appear. Some are easy to spot, and some are well-hidden. MURDER DECODED tells the forensics-driven stories of committed investigators, from finding the tiniest trace evidence, to using cutting-edge science to understand its relevance. The investigators in MURDER DECODED work to decipher which clues mean nothing and which ones will put a killer behind bars all to bring justice to victims' loved ones.

- **Footsteps in Blood premieres Saturday, April 6 at 9/8c**

A man calls 911 when he finds blood inside a friend's home. When officers arrive on the scene, they enter to find a beloved community activist shot dead. Detectives must piece together bloody footprints, bullet fragments, and a credit card trail to find a cold-blooded murderer.

- **Twisted Scripture premieres Saturday, April 13 at 9/8c**

After hunters discover the body of a missing young woman, police uncover a shocking secret she kept hidden from friends. Blood spatter and incriminating receipts help investigators decode her demise at the hands of a monster.

MURDER IN THE HEARTLAND

Season Two Premieres Sunday, April 14 at 9/8c

In MURDER IN THE HEARTLAND, it takes a village of vigilant neighbors, family members, shopkeepers and local police to piece together the stories of tragedy and justice committed within a community's core walls. MURDER IN THE HEARTLAND relies on the collective viewpoints of everyday American townfolk to share critical clues in the homicides that forever changed their lives and how they understand their home.

- **The Friends You Keep premieres Sunday, April 14 at 9/8c**

Home will never feel safe again after Jill finds her daughter Emma Walker cold to the touch in her own bed. Quickly ruling out suicide, investigators search for a suspicious man in black caught on a neighbor's home surveillance camera.

GRAVE MYSTERIES

Season Finale Airs Monday, April 1 at 9/8c

Police say that solving a murder is like putting together a giant jigsaw puzzle. GRAVE MYSTERIES recounts some of the nation's most bewildering murder investigations, following investigators as they solve the case, piece by piece. Every new piece of the puzzle seems to send the investigation into surprising new directions. Sometimes, new pieces of the puzzle seem to confuse the picture but, in the end, one crucial piece is found that allows us to reconstruct the crime from beginning to end. With a clear-eyed view of what happened, the police are able to uncover the culprit and the shocking truth.

- **Death on the Highway premieres Monday, April 1 at 9/8c**

28-year-old Michael Sandy is an interior designer in Williamsburg, Brooklyn. In 2006, Michael's habit of trusting strangers he meets online leads him to someone who isn't what they seem – putting Michael's life in jeopardy.

DEADLY RECALL

Season Finale Airs Tuesday, April 9 at 10/9c

Some crime scenes are so dreadful that law enforcement want to forget them, but Detective Pat Postiglione operates differently; he wants to remember every single detail. DEADLY RECALL follows homicide Det. Pat Postiglione as he explores crime scenes with his photographic memory and laser sharp eye for spotting key evidence. For some, this might be haunting, but for Det. Postiglione, it's his life calling.

- **Stalked premieres Tuesday, April 2 at 10/9c**

26-year-old Florence Ballino is found dead in her apartment in an unusual condition. Her attacker deliberately left behind clues in an attempt to confuse investigators. It is up to Detective Postiglione to identify one clue that links the murder to someone that's been hiding in plain sight.

- **No Body No Crime premieres Tuesday, April 9 at 10/9c**

Detective Postiglione is investigating a crime scene with a unique challenge: there is no victim. Pools of blood indicate something terrible has occurred, but the young woman is nowhere to be found. Pat is tasked with finding her body and a possible murderer.

IN PURSUIT WITH JOHN WALSH

Season Finale Airs Wednesday, April 3 at 10/9c

IN PURSUIT WITH JOHN WALSH takes the audience on a journey through the eyes of family members, friends and authorities who are desperate for resolution, detailing two fugitives and two missing children each hour. Every week, John and Callahan dissect each unique story from top to bottom, sharing current interviews with surviving family members and friends, chasing down new clues and reviewing the evidence in each case. The series will utilize crime scene photos, telephone calls and location-specific recreations, turning these cases into active hunts with help from the ID viewers at home.

- **Stolen Life premieres Wednesday, April 3 at 10/9c**

John Walsh explored the case of Edgardo Perez who is accused of preying on older men. Perez allegedly robbed and murdered Gordon Machek from Farmington Hills, MI. Then, Callahan Walsh travels back to Boulder, CO where teenaged babysitter Chris Deiningger confessed to abusing 29 kids in his care before fleeing the country.

DEAD OF NIGHT

Season Finale Airs Thursday, April 11 at 9/8c

DEAD OF NIGHT features nail-biting true stories of victims working the graveyard shift who are thrust into real-life nightmares. A killer lies in wait to strike the most vulnerable, those alone in the dark. When the sun sets, the body count will rise.

- ***I Know What Happened to That Girl premieres Thursday, April 4 at 9/8c***
19-year-old college student Lisa Taylor vanishes quietly into the darkness. Months later a shocking discovery is made, and the residents of the small town of Salisbury, Maryland begin to question those they once believed were innocent.
- ***Alibi Lullaby premieres Thursday, April 11 at 9/8c***
Police in Weimar, California are puzzled when a murder shakes their small town. A cryptic message is left behind at the scene, but the identity of the killer remains a mystery. Promises are broken and old secrets emerge, breathing new life into the investigation.

KILLING TIME

Season Finale Airs Thursday, April 4 at 10/9c

KILLING TIME is a crime-mystery series that focuses on a critical period of time lost the day of a homicide. Detectives who worked the case recount their investigation step-by-step, revealing shocking discoveries that deepen the mystery at every turn. As suspects are identified and hours, minutes and seconds of the victim's last day slowly come to light, a window of missing time appears. Investigators use everything from surveillance footage to credit card statements to GPS data to piece together the rest of the timeline and solve the murder.

- ***Keep Your Friends Close premieres Thursday, April 4 at 10/9c***

SECRETS OF THE MORGUE explores high-profile murder cases from the perspective of the medical examiner as they work alongside homicide detectives to bring justice to murder victims and their families. A victim's body tells a hidden story, and these post-mortem experts help solve crimes by unraveling the mystery from the inside out. From initial observations at the scene of the crime to the autopsy and beyond, each episode gets under the skin to unlock riveting crime puzzles.

- ***Into the Wilderness premieres Friday, April 5 at 10/9c***
Months after she is reported missing, the remains of 24-year-old truck driver Zilpha Lowery are discovered on the banks of a North Carolina lake. Investigators spend years exhausting every lead and looking for new evidence. It will take more than a decade and cutting-edge technology to finally track down her killer.
- ***Ashes to Ashes premieres Friday, April 5 at 11/10c***

When the hastily cremated remains of a church-going grandmother and her troubled daughter are discovered in the basement of an Ohio home, local investigators are joined by one of the most experienced pathologists in the country to solve the case.
