**TRUE CONVICTION**

**Season Two Premieres Tuesday, April 16 at 10/9c**

TRUE CONVICTION explores real stories of how homicide cases are solved on the street and won in the courtroom in a close cooperation between detectives and prosecutors. In each episode, Nicolazzi visits the scene of the crime, examines the case through the eyes of the prosecutor, and meets with key figures at the center of the case including the loved ones and investigators. Along the way, Nicolazzi shares her personal reflections and insight into the case, connects elements of the story to her own experiences as a prosecutor, and reveals how the complex layers of each murder investigation came together in the courtroom.

- **The Stalker premieres Tuesday, April 16 at 10/9c**  
After computer whiz Cari Farver goes missing, she starts sending threatening text messages to a new boyfriend, his ex-girlfriend and her mother. It is up to the police to determine if she is a deranged stalker or the victim of foul play.
- **Protecting a Friend premieres Tuesday, April 23 at 10/9c**  
Young mother Tyshika Askins is found dead in her home, and police find compelling evidence that point to her baby's father as the killer. But after charging the wrong man, police know the key to solving the case lies in an orange juice container left out on the kitchen counter.

**New Series Premieres Thursday, April 18 at 10/9c**

To hunt down the most heartless of killers, investigators must carefully gather clues to build an accurate profile and there's always traces of the fiend somewhere left behind. Detectives often enlist the best specialized minds and techniques to help decipher the cryptic messages from the killer. - **Seeds of Death premieres Thursday, April 18 at 10/9c**

- **Burning Secrets premieres Thursday, April 25 at 10/9c**

### **New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 9/8c**

- **Hunting Ground premieres Tuesday, April 16 at 9/8c**

- **Michigan City Murder premieres Wednesday, April 17 at 9/8c**

- **The Blood Trail premieres Wednesday, April 24 at 9/8c**

## **HOMICIDE CITY**

### **New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 10/9c**

- **Pine Hill Massacre premieres Wednesday, April 17 at 10/9c**  
When Bill and Catherine Stuart are executed in their home along with their three-year-old daughter, police look to the surviving daughter Miriam for clues. Her description of the killer leads detectives deep into the roots of Philadelphia's criminal underworld.
- **The Professor's Wife premieres Wednesday, April 24 at 10/9c**

When Ellen Robb's husband finds her murdered in their quiet suburban Philadelphia home, evidence initially points to a robbery gone wrong. But as police dig deeper into the couple's life. They learn the motive may be far more sinister.

### **THE LAST 24**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 11/10c**
