**MURDER CHOSE ME**

**Season Three Premieres Thursday, May 2 at 9/8c**

- **Road to Ruin premieres Thursday, May 2 at 9/8c**  
A hard-working family man is gunned down while doing a favor for a friend. As Rod Demery searches for answers, he's confronted with a name from his past, and an all too familiar tragedy. When more blood is spilled, Demery is pushed to his breaking point.
- **Loose Cannon premieres Thursday, May 9 at 9/8c**

### **UNBREAKABLE: LIVE TO TELL**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 9/8c**

- **Snow Day premieres Monday, April 29 at 9/8c**

Gina Edwards' dreams of having her cousin live close by are quickly dashed when her aunt's live-in boyfriend, Stephen, starts showing a darker side. As the three women team up to take a stand against Stephen, a seemingly normal night ends in tragedy.

- **My Scar premieres Monday, May 6 at 9/8c**

Young mother Gabby McKenzie feels like she's finally back on her feet after a bad break-up with the father of her son. But when her new boyfriend begins spending time at her dad's house, it's not long before her family home becomes a violent war zone.

### **BETRAYED**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 10/9c**

Things are not always as they seem in BETRAYED, which revisits heart-pounding cases of deception that ended in murder at the hands of a trusted family member, co-worker, lover, or friend. As investigators, family, and friends peel back the layers and facts of each case, the otherworldly narrator already knows where the breadcrumb trail ends. They guide viewers through the various relationships that comprise their life, raising suspicions about who will commit the ultimate betrayal and bring about their doom.

- **Prescription for Murder premieres Monday, April 29 at 10/9c**

After church-going mother-of-two Marilyn Reza is found dead in her home, investigators turn their attention to the members of her local church. However, a secret confession at her funeral brings the true murderer to light.

### **TRUE CONVICTION**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 10/9c**

TRUE CONVICTION explores real stories of how homicide cases are solved on the street and won in the courtroom in a close cooperation between detectives and prosecutors. In each episode, Nicolazzi visits the scene of the crime, examines the case through the eyes of the prosecutor, and meets with key figures at the center of the case including the loved ones and investigators. Along the way, Nicolazzi shares her personal reflections and insight into the case,

connects elements of the story to her own experiences as a prosecutor, and reveals how the complex layers of each murder investigation came together in the courtroom.

- **A Mother's Nightmare Tuesday, April 30 at 10/9c**

- **Mother's Day Murder premieres Tuesday, May 7 at 10/9c**  
59-year-old grandmother Patricia Mery is discovered dead in her home on Mother's Day. Police investigating the crime uncover evidence of friction in the family. As the investigation unfolds, the evidence points to a very unlikely suspect.

### **HOMICIDE CITY**

- **Danger Comes Home premieres Wednesday, May 8 at 10/9c**

#### **New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 11/10c**

- **Blood Money premieres Wednesday, May 1 at 11/10c**

- **A Dangerous Business premieres Wednesday, May 8 at 11/10c**
