PREMIERES

HOMICIDE HUNTER: LT. JOE KENDA

Season 9 Premieres Wednesday, August 28 at 9/8c

HOMICIDE HUNTER: LT JOE KENDA is a riveting non-fiction investigative series of murder cases told through the personal experience of retired detective, Lt. Joe Kenda. With his personal interviews and compelling storytelling style, Kenda captivates us with the details of a different investigation each week, beginning from when he got the homicide call to when the case was closed. Unlike many true-crime shows, this series delivers the realities of the emotional and psychological effects of a murder on the investigator. Set in Colorado, a state known for its suburban lifestyle, these murders are all the more compelling because they are stories of homicide that can happen to anybody.

- ***Cynthia premieres Wednesday, August 28 at 9/8c***

The body of a vibrant young mother is found frozen in a deserted cemetery. When all leads dry up, the case runs cold. However, years later, Kenda reopens the investigations and recognizes the sinister hallmark of a serial killer.

THE MURDER TAPES

New Series Premieres Wednesday, August 28 at 10/9c

THE MURDER TAPES use every conceivable form of taped footage involved in a homicide case, sharing up-close perspectives from those at the scene and showing the aftermath of a murder in its most raw and unfiltered form. Viewers see and hear it all, from the initial crime scene investigations via body cam, to home security tapes, to the interrogation room footage that reveals heart-pounding confessionals. The tapes capture the reactions from loved ones and families in real time, record investigator's first impressions of the scene, and show exactly how theories begin to arise. Viewers see the case at its begin and follow it to the end, proving that when the tapes roll, the truth emerges.

- **Episode premieres Wednesday, August 28 at 10/9c** Don Fluitt, a divorced father of three, homeless advocate and former firefighter, is found dead in his garage four days after Christmas. Now, body-cam video and original audio capture the detectives' desperate hunt for the killer while family members and close friends point the finger at one another.

DEADLY WOMEN

Season 13 Premieres Thursday, August 22 at 9/8c

Beloved former F.B.I. criminal profiler Candice DeLong explores some of history's most fascinating female killers in DEADLY WOMEN, touring the twisted minds of women who kill. Femmes fatales, twisted sisters, desperate damsels: there's no shortage of these DEADLY WOMEN.

- **Fatal Love premieres Thursday, August 22 at 9/8c**
Roger Spaulding leaves his wife Jackie after she runs the motel he gave her into the ground, and when faced with financial ruin, Jackie resorts to lethal measures to get the money she thinks she deserves. Lucille Miller appears to have it all, but when she realizes that she is the sole beneficiary of her husband's life insurance policy, she takes matters into her own hands to get what she wants. Then, in 2011 Julie Dixon hides the financial failure of the joinery business she has with her partner David Twigg, and when the company goes bankrupt, she'll do whatever is necessary to make sure he doesn't discover her secret.
- **Beauty and the Beastly premieres Thursday, August 29 at 9/8c**
Ex-actress Amanda Perry Hayes wants to start a new life with aspiring musician, Grant Hayes, but when a custody battle with Grant's ex-girlfriend stands in the way, the couple goes to extreme lengths to fulfill their dreams of full-custody. Beulah Annan lives a life of indulgence, but when her secret lover tries to end their relationship, she snaps. Then, Hazel Stewart finds sparks a relationship with Colin Howell, and to make their relationship permanent, they decide their spouses have to go.

THE LIES THAT BIND

New Series Premieres Thursday, August 22 at 10/9c

Everyone is hiding something. It may be a harmless secret, or it might be something far more serious, like a terrible betrayal of trust or shocking indiscretion. In some cases these lies can stay hidden, in other cases they are revealed with time. But then there are times when an event is so cataclysmic that everyone's truths are laid bare. In THE LIES THAT BIND, episodes tell the story of murder investigations that gradually exposed one truth after another, revealing the sinister conflicts that simmer beneath seemingly placid and bucolic communities.

- **Cult of Personality premieres Thursday, August 22 at 10/9c**
In 2014, gunshots are reported in the Rogers home. Maria Edwards, who phoned 9-11, refuses to give her statement without a lawyer present. As detectives look deeper into the case, the lies slowly start to unravel and they follow a lead that runs from the UK all the way to Iberville Parish, Louisiana.
- **Smoke and Mirrors premieres Thursday, August 29 at 10/9c**

On March 21, 2011, a fire burned down a parsonage behind a church, and Pastor David Allen lost his wife Paula as a result. Once the fire had settled, a fire marshal investigated the site and discovered that there was more to the story than an accidental fire.

Season Two Premieres Saturday, August 24 at 10/9c

THE CASE THAT HAUNTS ME takes a sweeping cinematic dive into 8 evocative true crime stories told directly from the detectives who led each case. From mysterious vanishings to twisted family murders, these are the unforgettable cases that disrupt law & order and keep authorities up at night.

- **The Long Walk Home premieres Saturday, August 24 at 10/9c**
Like most nights, 17-year-old Jennifer Teague walked home from her late shift at work, but this time, she never made it home. As the missing persons case turns into a homicide, Detective Greg Brown turns to the town to help him find the killer.
- **Permission to Die premieres Saturday, August 31 at 10/9c**
It's been decades since the last murder in the peaceful town of Killaloe, Ontario, so when new hire Detective Ken Leppert learns that Scott Dell's suicide may have been a calculated killing, it sends shockwaves through town. But who would want this kind, mild mannered family man dead?

TIL DEATH DO US PART

New Episodes Air Tuesdays at 10/9c

TIL DEATH DO US PART is a series of love stories twisted by rage, of passion soured by obsession, and of joy ravaged by paranoia. Each episode, illustrated through split-screen archive and originally-shot material, follows a pair of star-crossed lovers as they embark on a relationship that will end in homicide, seeing that murder like true love is written in the stars.

- **Vows, Lies, and Whispers premieres Tuesday, August 20 at 10/9c**
Free-spirited Hope follows her heart to Oklahoma to marry Jerry Meek, but it's not long before kids come along, and the honeymoon is over. On the night of February 21, 2002, a series of mysterious events shatter the family and remain unresolved for years.
- **Love, Sex, and Trucking premieres Tuesday, August 27 at 10/9c**
Frances and Bill Hall Jr. appear to be the perfect couple with two kids, a successful business and a 30-year marriage. However, on October 13, 2013, an unexpected encounter leads to a fatality, and the investigation reveals a story of infidelity and obsession.

- ***Dragged to Hell premieres Sunday, August 25 at 10/9c***

Amanda Storms has enjoyed a happy relationship with her husband, Philip Cabrera, an enthusiastic stepdad to her three children. However, when Amanda gets pregnant, Philip becomes abusive, and when he moves out, Amanda is grateful for the help of her friend Andrew Shepherd – until a terrible night of violence changes everything.

EXTREME MEASURES

New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 9/8c

Losing a loved one to murder is an emotionally devastating experience, and when the crime goes unsolved, the pain is even worse. For many, that agony is completely debilitating, but for some, these raw emotions give rise to determined action.
