VALLEY OF THE DAMNED

Detectives must piece together the final hours before his death in order to see who had the means and the motive to take his life.

THE MURDER TAPES

New Episodes Premiere Wednesday at 10/9c

THE MURDER TAPES use every conceivable form of taped footage involved in a homicide case, sharing up-close perspectives from those at the scene and showing the aftermath of a murder in in a raw and unfiltered form.  Detectives use security and traffic cam footage to piece together the last night of her life, including an encounter with a mysterious stranger to find her killer.

DEADLY WOMEN

Beloved former F.B.I. criminal profiler Candice DeLong explores some of history's most fascinating female killers in DEADLY WOMEN, touring the twisted minds of women who kill. Femmes fatales, twisted sisters, desperate damsels: there's no shortage of these DEADLY WOMEN.

- Kill the Competition premieres Thursday, September 19 at 9/8c
 - Mary Jane Fonder became obsessed with the new priest at her church. But when she suspected a fellow parishioner was trying to steal his affections, she took out the competition. Wanda Stopa turned to the bohemian lifestyle and fell for a married man after failing to be hired as a female attorney. When her lover sent her away, she decided to hurt the person he loved most. After a breakup, Sabrina Koudier became convinced her children's nanny was a spy for her ex-boyfriend. When she couldn't get her to admit she her involvement, Sabrina decided to force it out of her.
- Fatal Fixation premieres Thursday, September 26 at 9/8c

Liz Golyar fell hard for a man she went on a few dates with and became obsessed. When her target of affection moves on to another woman, Liz's jealousy pushes her over the edge. Marie Arthur lost it when her lover fell for the charms of a single mother. Her jealousy was so extreme that she decided to fatally confront the man who ruined her life. Lucy Cruz couldn't move on after her long-term girlfriend Gloria decided she wanted to have a husband and children. Lucy went from begging to harassing Gloria in order to get her back — a move that proved fatal.

THE LIES THAT BIND
