PREMIERES

HIGHWAY TO HELL

New Limited Series Premieres Saturday, November 16 at 10/9c

Millions of people travel along the 160,000 miles of America's highways each day, often passing people they will never encounter again. But what if the person at the wheel next to you had deadly intentions in mind? On HIGHWAY TO HELL, secrets, stalking, and murder become the currency of the road. For some people, innocent journeys become deadly trips, and not everyone will reach their destination.

- The Last Ride premieres Saturday, November 16 at 10/9c
 59-year-old long-haul trucker Bob Nelson is a week out from finishing his last ride across country when he suddenly stops contacting his wife, Mary Ann. Nelson's truck is found abandoned in Georgia, and police discover a crime scene. Clues suggest he wasn't alone in the truck and they consider the possibility that Nelson is leading a double life. The discovery off the highway sparks a multi-state manhunt lasting 15 years, until a well-kept secret is finally revealed.
- Murder in the Fast Lane premieres Saturday, November 23 at 10/9c Everyone knows respected urologist Dr. Gulam Moonda in Hermitage, Pa. Originally from India, Moonda came to the U.S. in the 1960s. A decade later he meets Donna, "the All-American girl," and despite their 20-year age gap, they forge a strong relationship. In 2005, they embark on a house hunting mission in Ohio, but an hour into their journey a seemingly random attack ends in tragedy. As investigators close in, they discover some questionable connections that send jaws to the floor.

 Sunny travels to the quiet coastal town of Milford, Connecticut to revisit the murder of Kelsey Monahon, a 28-year-old pregnant woman who was found dead in her home.

Police find no forced entry, an open safe that is missing money, and rope with unknown DNA on it, but have little else to go on. While detectives cast their initial suspicions close to home, the story of a surprising chance encounter leads investigators to a much stranger truth.

• Break, Enter, Kill premieres Tuesday, November 19 at 10/9c 33-year-old Lisa Fein is abducted from her rural Galien, Michigan home in the dead of night. Her 11-year-old son, Jake, witnesses the attack and tells police his mom was attacked by a man in a snowmobile helmet. After a three-day search, Lisa's body is found in a shallow grave only a quarter mile away. While their sole witness points the investigation in one direction, DNA leads them in another.

HOMICIDE HUNTER: LT. JOE KENDA

 A young man is found dead behind the wheel of his taxi. With robbery seeming unlikely,
 Kenda and Gaenzle wonder if this was personal. Could this stem from a dispute at his
 other job as a radio DJ? Or rumors of failing marriage? The possibilities seem endless.
