PREMIERES

IN PURSUIT WITH JOHN WALSH

Season Two Premieres Wednesday, January 15 at 10/9c

IN PURSUIT WITH JOHN WALSH takes the audience on a journey through the eyes of family members, friends and authorities who are desperate for resolution, detailing two fugitives and two missing children each hour. Every week, John and Callahan dissect each unique story from top to bottom, sharing current interviews with surviving family members and friends, chasing down new clues and reviewing the evidence in each case. The series will utilize crime scene photos, telephone calls and location-specific recreations, turning these cases into active hunts with help from the ID viewers at home.

• American Nightmare premieres Wednesday, January 15 at 10/9c

John profiles dangerous fugitive Leroy Headley. When Headley calls 911 in South
Burlington, Vermont, claiming to have shot his girlfriend, police race to the home of
Anako Lumumba, but it is too late to save her. As authorities search high and low for
Headley, they learn that he is accused of sexually assaulting two minors, and Anako had
been living in mortal fear of her violent ex-boyfriend. Later, Cal goes on the ground in
Abilene, Texas to learn more about a tale of predatory sexual abuse. When a young man
comes forward and alleges he was sexually assaulted, the predator's own wife goes to
police to report the abuse. A firestorm of controversy erupts when the alleged abuser is
named: after school church daycare worker Jeffrey Forrest. Eventually, more victims
come out of the shadows with similar claims.

HOMETOWN HOMICIDE

 On the night of December 6, 2014, an individual calls in a car fire off a rural road in Courtland, Mississippi. When first responders arrive at the scene they are met with a horrifying scene: walking toward them is 19-year-old Jessica Chambers who is engulfed

in flames. As Jessica reaches the first responders, they ask her what happened. With some of her last breaths she whispers a name that sounds like Eric or Derrick. It takes more than a year before police finally believe they've found her killer.
