**PREMIERES**

**SOUTHERN GOTHIC**

**New Series Premieres Monday, April 27 at 10/9c**

There is a place where deep-rooted tensions and skeletons in the closet are thickly veiled by generations-learned etiquette and hidden agendas, and behind every sun-worn smile there's a dark secret. A place that can be just as shadowy as the muddy waters that run through it, especially when it comes to planning, committing, and covering up a crime. While highlighting how law enforcement in the South is a personal business, SOUTHERN GOTHIC explores the duplicitous characters, unique settings, and boundless mystery of murder in the American South.

- **They Call Me Animal premieres Monday, April 27 at 10/9c**  
After three teens vanish, the residents of Hawkins, Texas', worst fears are realized when they're found dead. Details of a related robbery identify a suspect, but after a rattling jailbreak, the city must mobilize the largest manhunt in state history to nab the culprit.
- **Memphis Blues premieres Monday, May 4 at 10/9c**  
A loving mother is murdered at a gas station in Memphis, Tennessee. As police search for clues, a mysterious letter threatens to complicate the already-tense relationship between local law enforcement and the community they're sworn to protect.

**REASONABLE DOUBT**

**Season Three Finale Airs Tuesday, May 5 at 10/9c**

In a justice system that's not always so just, families can be tormented by the question of guilt or innocence of their convicted loved ones. REASONABLE DOUBT profiles the gut-wrenching process of re-exploring murder cases where the perpetrators convicted of the crime maintain

their innocence. Retired homicide detective Chris Anderson teams with criminal defense attorney Fatima Silva, to pore through evidence, interview witnesses and consult experts previously overlooked by police or barred by the court. At the end of each episode, the determined investigators evaluate their findings and either offer the convicted' s family hope for an appeal, or clarity to accept the guilty verdict.

- **Murder at her Doorstep premieres Tuesday, April 28 at 10/9c**

When a pregnant woman finds a box at her door, she picks it up and it explodes – killing her and her unborn baby. A multi-year investigation ensues, and her ex is convicted. Now, Mike Johnson's mom and daughter seek help to prove his innocence.

- **It Wasn't Me premieres Tuesday, May 5 at 10/9c**

Roosevelt Myles, a small-time drug dealer, is convicted of murdering a teenage boy on Chicago's West Side in 1992. Now, his sister and fiancée have reached out to Chris Anderson and Fatima Silva, convinced he is serving time for a crime he didn't commit.

### **Season One Finale Airs Thursday, May 7 at 9/8c**

A shocking murder with no viable suspects and no solid leads. The baffling homicides in IF I SHOULD DIE can only be solved with help from the victims themselves, speaking from beyond the grave through their own words and guiding investigators to their killers.

- **Axe to Grind premieres Thursday, April 30 at 9/8c**

### **New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 10/9c**

Some crime scenes are so dreadful that law enforcement want to forget them, but Detective Pat Postiglione operates differently; he wants to remember every single detail. DEADLY RECALL follows homicide Det. Pat Postiglione as he explores crime scenes with his photographic memory and laser sharp eye for spotting key evidence. For some, this might be haunting, but for Det. Postiglione, it's his life calling.

- **Cris-Cross premieres Wednesday, April 29 at 10/9c**
