PREMIERES

HOMETOWN HOMICIDE: LOCAL MYSTERIES

New Series Premieres Monday, July 20 at 9/8c

HOMETOWN HOMICIDE: LOCAL MYSTERIES uses local news footage and other archive to bring to life the stories of gripping small-town murder investigations. The local news broadcasts give these stories an urgent in-the-moment immediacy. This news footage, along with the other archive, makes each story vividly real.

- Caught on Camera and The Mad Driver premieres Monday, July 20 at 9/8c
 When college bound teenager Kelsey Smith disappears from a Target in June 2007, investigators race to find her. When her body is eventually discovered, the search for her killer also becomes a call for reform in how cell phone data is used to trace people in danger. Then, when a rideshare driver goes on a shooting spree in Kalamazoo, MI, investigators are in a race against time to stop him from killing again.
- Closing Time and Late Breaking Homicide premieres Monday, July 20 at 9:30/8:30c When army medic Kelli Bordeaux disappears after a night out at a bar, a community comes together to find her. When she is declared dead a year later without a body, an independent investigator tries an unconventional tactic to gain the trust of the man suspected of her murder. Then, when Mason City morning anchor Jodi Huisentruit doesn't show up for work on June 27, 1995, it leaves a newsroom shaken and a community stunned. But 25 years after her disappearance, there are still few clues to where she might be.
- The Missing Teacher and The College Stalker premieres Monday, July 27 at 9/8c
 When popular history teacher Tara Grinstead vanishes without a trace in Ocilla, GA in 2005, a small town is stunned, and investigators have few leads for over a decade. But in 2017, a surprising witness comes forward with information that leads to her killers.

 Then, when University of Virginia student Hannah Graham doesn't return to her dorm

- one night in 2014, investigators soon connect the dots between Hannah and another missing young woman, Morgan Harrington, to bring a killer to justice.
- Fatal Family and The Southern Stalker premieres Monday, July 27 at 9:30/8:30c When the remains of the Brenizer family in Cushing, WI are found in a burned-out station wagon, investigators are baffled until a relative with a dark secret comes forward and blows the case wide open. Then, 17-year-old Tiffaney Wilson is murdered in Augusta, GA in December 1999. As women similar to her in age, build and hair color disappear and end up dead, people fear a serial killer is on the loose.
