**PREMIERES**

**IMPACT OF HATE: CHARLOTTESVILLE**

**Two-Hour Special Premieres Wednesday, August 12 at 9/8c**

When the college town of Charlottesville, Va. decides to remove its confederate statues, white nationalists and their supporters descend for a series of protests that culminate in the now infamous “Unite the Right” rally. Concerned citizens protest the influx of hate, including paralegal Heather Heyer. When a man deliberately drives his car into a crowd of counterprotesters, dozens are injured, and Heather is killed. On the third anniversary of her death, Investigation Discovery presents the two-hour special IMPACT OF HATE: CHARLOTTESVILLE. With storytelling driven by four different victim impact statements throughout – including three attack survivors as well as Heather’s mother – this emotionally gripping special allows us to hear directly from the victims about the horror they endured, and how the hateful actions of that fateful day left collateral damage for a lifetime.

**HOMETOWN HOMICIDE: LOCAL MYSTERIES**

**Season Finale Airs Monday, August 3 at 9/8c**

HOMETOWN HOMICIDE: LOCAL MYSTERIES uses local news footage and other archive to bring to life the stories of gripping small-town murder investigations. The local news broadcasts give these stories an urgent, in-the-moment immediacy to paint a vivid portrait of homicides that rocked these communities to their core.

- ***In Too Deep and Death at the Beauty School premieres Monday, August 3 at 9/8c***  
Michael Roark, a young soldier in Fort Stewart, Ga., joins a dangerous militia determined to overthrow the government. But when he decides to quit the group and start a new

life with his girlfriend Tiffany York, the consequences prove deadly. Then, Mackenzie Cowell, a cosmetology student in Wenatchee, Wash., disappears from school and is found dead by a river, leaving a family devastated and investigators without a clue. After months with no solid leads, investigators receive a mysterious tip that specifically points to the last person anyone would have expected could be capable of murder.

- **Burned Alive and A Mom Missing premieres Monday, August 3 at 9:30/8:30c**  
Jessica Chambers is set on fire and left for dead in Courtland, Miss. Her attempt to name her killer in the final moments of her life prompts a large-scale search, but when the suspects are narrowed to one man, doubts over his guilt lead to more questions than answers. Then, Theresa Still goes missing in Altoona, Wis., in late 2009, leaving friends and family sick with worry. When her body is found 100 miles away, investigators consider that the killer might be much closer to home.

### **THE MURDER TAPES**

#### **Season Two Finale Airs Tuesday, August 4 at 10/9c**

Homicide investigations unfold through dramatic real footage in this groundbreaking series. Each episode provides an up-close perspective of the case, incorporating body cam footage from the initial crime scene, surveillance video, and interrogation room recordings.

- **Twisted Upside Down premieres Tuesday, August 4 at 10/9c**  
When Kalamazoo, Mich. police receive an anonymous call claiming William Gray was attacked, thrown into the trunk of a vehicle and driven from the scene, a citywide manhunt begins. Day-after-day, officers hear versions of the same story and there are no new developments in their missing persons case. Detectives interview dozens of people who attended the party where William was last seen alive, however investigators face a wall of silence. Just as it seems they may never find William, dead or alive, an unexpected source surfaces, providing police with what they need to track down the body - and uncover the truth.

### **SEE NO EVIL**

#### **Season Six Finale Airs Wednesday, August 5 at 9/8c**

SEE NO EVIL reveals how the deadliest crimes are solved by the only witnesses that never lie and never forget: surveillance cameras. With more shocking CCTV footage than ever before, SEE NO EVIL proves there's nowhere killers can hide.

- **The Landlady premieres Wednesday, August 5 at 9/8c**  
When a beloved elderly landlady is found dead in her well, detectives find no clues at the crime scene that her killer was ever there. On the trail of her missing car, phone and credit cards, they cast their net across the city and reel in a web of lies. The security cameras in a local store help piece together her last days and lead police towards a series of suspects and a clear motive. But the case twists and turns with unexpected connections, dark revelations and a killer who disappears into the metropolis.

- **Blood Brothers premieres Thursday, August 6 at 9/8c**

### **New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 10/9c**

- **No Escape premieres Monday, August 3 at 10/9c**

- **Heart of Darkness premieres Monday, August 10 at 10/9c**

## **STILL A MYSTERY**

### **New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 9/8c**

Just because a case is closed doesn't mean the truth has been revealed. Suicide or murder? Runaway or kidnapping? Accidental or premeditated? STILL A MYSTERY re-examines cases

- **The Hidden Bodies premieres Tuesday, August 4 at 9/8c**

When the remains of 26-year-old Trish Haynes are discovered inside a washer-dryer set at the bottom of a pond, her gruesome murder shakes the entire community. Then, a series of disturbing events, including cars being firebombed, only add to the chilling mystery of the case. And, when 26-year-old Adam Campbell leaves a bar and just an hour later his body is discovered in a car that has been set ablaze, it leaves another town reeling. - **Why Did She Leave? premieres Tuesday, August 11 at 9/8c**

When her body is discovered, it is clear she was the victim of a murder. Then, Timmothy Pitzen's mother takes the 6-year-old on a surprise vacation that ends in Timmothy missing and another tragedy. Years pass, and someone appears out of nowhere with a possible solution. Will the mystery be solved?

- **The Hidden Clues premieres Tuesday, August 11 at 10/9c**

20-year-old Johmeik Simmons is a beloved athlete who beats cancer. But tragedy strikes one day when he goes out to run an errand and is found in a neighborhood home with a gunshot wound to the head. Authorities immediately conclude that Johmeik shot himself, but his family is convinced otherwise. Then, 20-year-old Jeannie Quinn's family is deeply disturbed by her romance with a much older man. When she turns up dead in a staged suicide, a secret in this man's past may hold the key to finding her murderer. Will these two young people's families ever be able to find out the truth?

## **A TIME TO KILL**

### **New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 10/9c**

- **The Missing Hotelier premieres Thursday, August 6 at 10/9c**

- **A Murder in Cordova premieres Thursday, August 13 at 10/9c**

When the body of 43-year-old Tina Coronna is discovered in the backseat of her abandoned truck, detectives must piece together clues gleaned from the victim's emotional husband, his mistress, and a neighborhood vigilante.

## **THE GENETIC DETECTIVE**

### **Network Premieres Air Saturdays at 10/9c**

THE GENETIC DETECTIVE follows investigative genetic genealogist CeCe Moore as she uses her unique research skills to transform the face of crime solving. By working with police

departments and crime scene DNA, Moore is able to trace the path of a violent criminal's family tree to reveal their identity and help bring them to justice.

- **The Phantom of Ramsey Street premieres Saturday, August 8 at 10/9c**  
From 2006 to 2008, a series of unsolved rapes haunted residents in Fayetteville, N.C. Investigative genetic genealogist CeCe Moore works on the case with the Fayetteville Police Department while she attends an annual true crime convention which happened to be held in New Orleans at the time.
- **Runaway Killer premieres Saturday, August 15 at 10/9c**  
Investigative genetic genealogist CeCe Moore works with the New Madrid County Sheriff's Department on the 1998 murder of Sherri and Megan Scherer, a mother and daughter from New Madrid, Mo. As the investigation takes Moore and detectives on a series of unexpected detours across the country, they uncover the identity of a previously unknown serial killer and Moore ends up meeting with the killer's daughter.
