JOE EXOTIC: TIGERS, LIES AND COVER-UP

Three-Hour Special Premiere Begins Sunday, September 27 at 9/8c and Concludes Monday, September 28 at 9/8c

In a matter of months, Joe Exotic and his sworn enemy, Carole Baskin, have become household names. Their saga played out for the world to see, but what has happened since the cameras stopped rolling? Then in 2016, Kristal Reisinger heads out to take part in a drum circle in her new hometown of Crestone, Colorado, but she is never seen again. What happened to these missing parents?

On January 27, 2017, 20-year-old Elaine Park went to a movie with her boyfriend and then spends the night at his apartment. The next morning surveillance footage shows her leaving his home but is never seen again. Then on August 10, 2018, Matthew Weaver Jr. parties with a friend and then drives through the canyons but is never heard from again. Elaine and Matthew's vehicles have both been found in the Santa Monica Mountains, but neither of them can be found.

As pandemonium breaks out, with the man attacking everyone who tries to stop him, an unexpected hero shows up to save the day. A man with a large gun enters a bar late at night and orders everyone to get on the floor. He's looking for some quick cash, but one patron refuses to comply. In fact, he makes jokes, thoroughly confusing the gunman. Other customers laying on the floor with their hands up are terrified, convinced that the man's defiant attitude might get them all killed.
