PREMIERES

TWISTED SISTERS

Season Three Premieres Monday, October 26 at 9/8c

From a quiet town near the Smoky Mountains, to the sunny skies of St. Petersburg, Florida, stories in this season span the nation, and across multiple different family dynamics. It's not always the sister who is the culprit of the crime, but sometimes the accomplice, victim, whistleblower or unintended spy. Each episode of the Khloé Kardashian-produced series TWISTED SISTERS is shrouded in mystery, heartbreak and hidden emotions, proving that where there are family ties, there are also family lies.

- **A Song for Sarra premieres Monday, October 26 at 9/8c**
The four Gilbert sisters struggle through a tough childhood made worse when it's suspected that Shannan, the oldest sister, has become a victim of the Long Island Serial Killer. Her mother and sisters embark on a fight for justice for the slain Shannan as Sarra begins a tragic decline into schizophrenia. When Shannan's body is finally found, Sarra's delusions worsen, leaving the question: will both sisters be lost?
- **Her Own Medicine premieres Monday, November 2 at 9/8c**
Georgia and Jeannie Plummer are two of ten siblings. They remain close until Georgia absconds with much of their inheritance from their mother, Birdie. The sisters don't speak for three years until Georgia once again reaches out to Jeannie for help. Being a good sister, Jeannie can't resist. But soon, Jeannie falls sick, and questions begin to arise.

EVIL LIVES HERE: SHADOWS OF DEATH

Evil casts a shadow. That shadow spreads outward for years, even decades, after a crime. It consumes everyone in its path, pulling them into darkness. EVIL LIVES HERE: SHADOWS OF DEATH explores the endless reach of evil – a reach that extends long after the crime itself. This

original series highlights the struggle to survive as innocent people find themselves caught in the wake of death and evil.

- **Truth, Lies, and Redemption premieres Thursday, October 29 at 10/9c**

In 1988, a man is released from jail after a judge deems his murder confession false. For over two decades, a family's hope for justice fades, as the killer walks the streets. But one tenacious detective refuses to let this cold case go.

- **The Path premieres Thursday, November 5 at 10/9c**

Detective David Waltemeyer is put in charge of the very first cold case squad for Anne Arundel County, Maryland. The first case he tackles is that of 14-year-old Lisa Haenel, who was murdered while on her way to school in 1993. As he dives into her file, he has no idea that seven years before Lisa's death, another woman met a similarly sudden demise.

KILLER IN QUESTION

Limited Series Premieres Sunday, November 1st at 9/8c

When a murder is committed, it sends shockwaves through a community. Investigators work to find the killer and bring closure to a community. But what happens when a case is closed, yet lingering questions remain? When doubt circulates throughout a city, and investigations are put under a microscope, people begin to ask: is the convicted truly the killer, or is someone evading the law while an innocent person sits taxed with their crimes? Join the hunt for answers and closure as ID delves into four stories of adjudicated cases, where the verdict remains under dispute. Walk step-by-step through critical crime scenes, key questioning and newfound evidence, with each episode telling both sides of a story. The conclusion is up for interpretation, and the viewer is left to decide: was justice served, or does the evidence just not add up?

- **The Hunted premieres November 1st at 9/8c**

In 1990, hunters Doug Estes and Jim Bennett are found shot to death in a state gaming area. Police suspect Jeff Titus, the man who owned the property just next door, but he is cleared by alibi witnesses. A reinvestigation by a cold case team nearly a decade later leads detectives back to Titus, and he is convicted of the murders. Titus maintains his innocence to this day, and with both the original investigators and the cold case team criticizing each other, the community does not know what to think. Upon further investigation, it is discovered that a serial killer was on the loose around the time of the murders. But is that one connection enough to prove that Titus is an innocent man?

- **The Girl in the Lake premieres November 8th at 9/8c**

On the night of May 1, 1987, 11-year-old Teresa McAbee heads off down the road to a convenience store near her home in Mascotte, Florida. The next morning, a fisherman finds her body face down in the lake across the street. Before he even leaves the scene, the lead Sheriff's investigator is convinced he has a suspect, a local rookie cop named James Duckett. The Mascotte Police Chief maintains Duckett's innocence, but over the next couple months the investigator's clues fall in place and Duckett is sentenced to death. But 15 years later, a retired homicide detective contacts Duckett on death row. He uncovers a trail of questionable evidence and disputed facts. Slowly he becomes convinced that this man is innocent.

KILLER CARNIES

Limited Series Finale Airs Monday, November 2 at 10/9c

KILLER CARNIES unravels stories of violent crime with mysterious ties to carnivals, town fairs or arcades - deceptively cheery places perfectly poised for spine-chilling horror. Each case reveals the crime scenes behind the bright lights where detectives must piece together the truth, encountering suspicious drifters and family members left devastated by tragedy. In KILLER CARNIES, it becomes clear that it's not always fun at the fair.

- **Dungeon of Doom premieres Monday, October 26 at 10/9c**

When a 9-year-old child disappears from an amusement park on Long Island the race is on to stop a dangerous child abductor. But with a bitter custody battle and a family fighting amongst themselves, a child's life hangs in the balance. More than two weeks pass, and police leads are drying up. Then comes a voice message and a confession from someone they least expect that will change the lives of everyone.

- **House of Mirrors premieres Monday, November 2 at 10/9c**

In the picturesque town of Powell, Wyoming, a little girl disappears at twilight. In a community of 5,000 everyone rallies to comfort her devastated family. Police race against the clock to bring little Christin home, using top of the range technology to investigate all leads. But more than two weeks pass with nothing but dead ends. Could Christin have been taken by someone from the recently arrived carnival or a stranger visiting town?

ONGOING SERIES

HOMICIDE CITY

New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 9/8c

HOMICIDE CITY takes a deep dive into the crimes that shook Philadelphia to its core. The series explores cases from a darker time that had police detectives banding together across the metropolitan landscape in a sequence of manhunts. From the mansions of the wealthy suburbs to the rowhouse-lined streets of the inner city, each episode is told through the eyes of veteran homicide detectives, local beat reporters and the victims' families who lost so much.

- **Deadly Dance premieres Tuesday, October 27 at 9/8c**

When a young exotic dancer is found dead at the bottom of a 12-story bridge, detectives must determine if it's a suicide or the work of a sinister character who wanted more than a dance.

DEAD SILENT

New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 10/9c

Deep in the woods, inside an abandoned house, or along the shores of a sleepy lake, every snap of a twig or unidentified rustle can be a sign of danger. DEAD SILENT shows just how dark and desolate the great outdoors can be when no one can reach you, where myth, urban legend, and

horror movie dread collide to showcase twisted tales too frightening to be imaginary. Each hour-long episode features one spine-tingling and terrifying true story, interwoven with expert commentary from local authorities, true-crime experts, and psychologists, as well as first-person accounts from many of the victims who survived these nightmarish events.

- ***The Creek Bottom premieres Tuesday, October 27 at 10/9c***

College student and aspiring teacher Tammy Crowe has everything to live for: a loving family, a devoted boyfriend, and a promising future. But on her way to a friend's dinner party, Tammy's life takes an unexpectedly devastating and violent turn.

CRIMES GONE VIRAL

New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 9/8c

CRIMES GONE VIRAL explores the riveting stories behind shocking crimes caught on camera that gain viral fame on the internet. From business security cameras to home surveillance systems and cell phone cameras, someone is almost always watching. Gripping clips of kidnappings, break-ins, wild car chases, violent road rage incidents and other crimes rack up millions of views. But CRIMES GONE VIRAL goes beyond the jaw-dropping footage to tell the full story. This series features compelling interviews and behind-the-scenes information of some of the internet's most viral crime clips.

- ***Child's Nightmare premieres Wednesday, October 28 at 9/8c***

As a car heads straight into the ocean with screaming children hanging out the windows crying for help, bystanders rush in to try and help. Then, a terrifying scene unfolds as two sleeping children are unaware that armed burglars are right next to them.

- ***Get Out premieres Wednesday, October 28 at 9:30/8:30c***

A busy couple watches helplessly through a streaming security camera as a man burglarizes their home. Then, a woman inexplicably fires a gun into a house and returns to toss in a flaming torch.

- ***Knock, Knock, Who's There? premieres Wednesday, November 4 at 9/8c***

In California, a doorbell camera captures a disoriented woman trying to break into a home as the terrified homeowner prepares to protect herself. In Texas, a panicked woman with restraints on her arms rings a doorbell in the middle of the night.

- ***Don't Mess with Me premieres Wednesday, November 4 at 9:30/8:30c***

A mother is inside a gas station when a man steals her car, with her 13-year-old and 6-month old daughters inside. Then, when a waitress is sexually assaulted, she takes matters into her own hands against her assailant.

CHAOS IN COURT

New Episodes Premiere Wednesdays at 10/9c

CHAOS IN COURT examines clips of dramatic, unexpected, and cathartic courtroom moments. Each episode brings the backstories of the crimes and legal proceedings to the forefront with insightful analysis from a diverse panel of experts including judges, defense attorneys, prosecutors, and criminal psychologists. Featured within each episode are interviews with defendants, family members, and others who witnessed the action to help bring dramatic courtroom moments to life, and the emotional realities of what happens when the ultimate stakes are on trial.

- **Abuse of Power premieres Wednesday, October 28 at 10/9c**

A killer's life is spared by a jury's mistake; two families brawl in a courthouse lobby after a rescheduled murder hearing; a man forgets something very important before walking into an Oklahoma City courthouse; a Hamilton County judge finds herself on the other side of the courtroom; a man frustrated with a courthouse payment policy is attacked by deputies; and an upset commissioner throws an attorney out of a Maricopa County courtroom.

- **Rage Quit premieres Wednesday, November 4 at 10/9c**

A once promising high school basketball star loses his chances at the NBA after being sentenced for abusing a girlfriend; an inmate shoots two deputies dead and holds hostages at a Michigan courthouse; an angry defendant throws chairs during a sentencing hearing; a convicted sex offender attacks a district attorney; a man facing multiple drug charges leap frogs his way out of court; and a Rastafarian pot proponent tells a Wisconsin court commissioner he requires a translator.

SUSPICIOUS MINDS

New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 9/8c

Suspicion is contagious. What starts as a tiny spark of doubt focused on one individual can metastasize and cast a shadow on everything you, your community, and ultimately law enforcement thought to be true. SUSPICIOUS MINDS creates a visceral viewing experience where a murder mystery unfolds as a psychological thriller where suspicion and doubt cloud the perceptions of everyone involved.

- **Rumors in the Halls premieres Thursday, October 29 at 9/8c**

Suspicion lands close to home when 17-year-old prom queen Aquilla Flood is found shot dead in her bedroom by her mother and her uncle, who claim to have heard nothing the night the young woman died. The investigation descends on Aquilla's high school, where her closest friends are caught up in a storm of speculation. Her friends point detectives to three young men, each a person of interest, until a few frames of footage from a security camera gives detectives the crucial key the need to figure out who killed Aquilla.

- **Everyone Knows Her Name premieres Thursday, November 5 at 9/8c**

Rumors swirl within the student community of Murfreesboro, Tennessee after the shocking death of Heather Maples. The only clues to find her killer are a love letter and a bloody fingerprint found at the scene -until the young woman's cell phone unlocks a web of potential suspects and motives. Local students confront the sobering truth a murderer is lurking among them, as detectives retrace Heather's last night out at local bars to pull her killer out of the shadows.
