PREMIERES

TIL DEATH DO US PART

Season Two Premieres Monday, November 9 at 10/9c

TIL DEATH DO US PART is a series of love stories twisted by rage, of passion soured by obsession, and of joy ravaged by paranoia. Each episode, illustrated through split-screen archive and originally shot material, follows a pair of star-crossed lovers as they embark on a relationship that will end in homicide, seeing that murder like true love is written in the stars.

- **Behind Closed Doors premieres November 9 at 10/9c**
To most people, teenage sweethearts Steven and Michelle Gibson seem to be happily married. They have four children and live a fun and adventurous life together. But the couple is harboring a dark secret – one that will tear the family apart.
- **The House Out on Wade Road premieres November 16 at 10/9c**
Byron and Michele Wright overcome broken homes to find solace in one another. But when their blissful union falls apart and a new man arrives on the scene, it unearths violent secrets and a shocking truth.

THE CRIMES THAT CHANGED US

New Series Premieres Wednesday, November 11 at 10/9c

Certain cases are seared into the American consciousness – they are a part of how we look at society, good and evil. But what would happen if we could go back in time, or back in crime, and look again? This unique series fully re-immerses the viewer in these cases as we experienced them at the time by pairing the best news archive with audio interviews, reintroducing these cases from a new standpoint. Each episode shows the evolution of how these cases were perceived by the public then and how we view them now, exposing how the times have changed, and revealing the lessons learned from each case.

- **Andrea Yates premieres Wednesday, November 11 at 10/9c**

Rusty and Andrea Yates look like the perfect family. Engineer Rusty works at NASA, and stay-at-home mom Andrea home schools their five children, earning her the nickname supermom. Unbeknownst to friends and family, Andrea is struggling with her grip on reality. Intense religious beliefs combined with severe postpartum psychosis lead her to believe she is receiving direct messages from Satan, urging her to kill her children. One morning Rusty receives a cryptic call from Andrea, begging him to come home from work. Worried, he asks if any of the children have been hurt - "all of them," she replies.

- **Atlanta Olympic Bombing *premieres Wednesday, November 18 at 10/9c***

On July 27, 1996 in Atlanta, Georgia, Olympics security guard Richard Jewell spots a bag containing three pipe bombs. Jewell alerts security and clears the area, averting even more fatalities. In the following days he is praised as a hero, but behind the scenes, he is being investigated as a suspect. The ensuing investigation into Jewell quickly turns into a media storm. As his world turns upside-down, the real culprit has only just begun a campaign of terror that will ultimately leave three dead and more than 150 injured before he is finally brought to justice.

THE MURDER TAPES

Season Three Premieres Wednesday, November 18 at 9/8c

Homicide investigations unfold through dramatic real footage in this groundbreaking series. Each episode of THE MURDER TAPES provides an up-close perspective of the case, incorporating body cam footage from the initial crime scene, surveillance video, and interrogation room recordings.

- **The Back of the Shed *premieres Wednesday, November 18 at 9/8c***

Family and friends of Danielle Marzejka and her boyfriend, Seren Bryan search desperately for the young couple who have been missing for days. Danielle's brother calls 911 after he and his father find what they believe are bodies stuffed into large black garbage bags in their shed. A series of shocking discoveries leads to a multi-state manhunt, involving Michigan and Ohio Police Departments as well as the U.S. Marshals. When investigators finally track down the person responsible, everyone is in a state of shock.

CRIMES GONE VIRAL

Season Finale Airs Wednesday, November 11 at 9/8c

CRIMES GONE VIRAL explores the riveting stories behind shocking crimes caught on camera that gain viral fame on the internet. From business security cameras to home surveillance systems and cell phone cameras, someone is almost always watching. Gripping clips of kidnappings, break-ins, wild car chases, violent road rage incidents and other crimes rack up millions of views. But CRIMES GONE VIRAL goes beyond the jaw-dropping footage to tell the full story. This series features compelling interviews and behind-the-scenes information of some of the internet's most viral crime clips.

- **Men Gone Wild *premieres Wednesday, November 11 at 9/8c***

When a man with a shotgun bursts into a home late one night, a young man is forced to defend himself and protect his fiancée. And then, a man goes on a violent rampage in a diner, and two women find themselves in a fight for survival.

- **Drunk Driving Terror premieres Wednesday, November 11 at 9:30/8:30c**

Two officers respond to a drunk driver speeding the wrong way down a highway and find themselves in a wildly dangerous situation. And then, a family follows a car swerving dangerously, and is forced to intervene to prevent tragedy.

SUSPICIOUS MINDS

Season Finale Airs Thursday, November 12 at 9/8c

Suspicion is contagious. What starts as a tiny spark of doubt focused on one individual can metastasize and cast a shadow on everything you, your community, and ultimately law enforcement thought to be true. SUSPICIOUS MINDS creates a visceral viewing experience where a murder mystery unfolds as a psychological thriller where suspicion and doubt cloud the perceptions of everyone involved.

- **Whispers from the Woods premieres Thursday, November 12 at 9/8c**

After 19-year-old Erica Miller disappears into a frigid January night, the town of York, Pennsylvania is consumed with suspicion. Rumors fly as Erica's mother desperately searches for her daughter and investigators turn up new suspects around every corner. Friends and former classmates reveal unexpected details about the young woman beloved by everyone she met - whose trust, detectives believe, was betrayed by someone close to her.

CHAOS IN COURT

Season Finale Airs Friday, November 13 at 10/9c

CHAOS IN COURT examines clips of dramatic, unexpected, and cathartic courtroom moments. Each episode brings the backstories of the crimes and legal proceedings to the forefront with insightful analysis from a diverse panel of experts including judges, defense attorneys, prosecutors, and criminal psychologists. Featured within each episode are interviews with defendants, family members, and others who witnessed the action to help bring dramatic courtroom moments to life, and the emotional realities of what happens when the ultimate stakes are on trial.

- **Hate Kills premieres Friday, November 13 at 9/8c**

Two sons disrupt a trial after their father is found guilty of murdering their mother; a man with over two dozen mugshots is given a second chance at recovery; a defendant shouts an eerie message during a competency hearing; a woman accused of stabbing her husband with a swiss army knife screams at a Miami judge; a man shoves and injures a courthouse deputy, runs away, and leaves his son behind; and a defendant on weapons charges leads deputies on a wild goose chase through an Oklahoma City courthouse.

- **Terror in the Court premieres Friday, November 13 at 10/9c**

Parents of two murder victims exact revenge on militia members; an angry defendant packs a nasty punch; a woman seeking protection is manhandled by a judge; a man threatens to kill family members at a bond hearing; a deputy wrestles a defendant to

the floor; a drunk driver rams his car into a North Carolina courthouse; and a creative courthouse proposal shocks an unexpectant probation officer.

KILLER IN QUESTION

Limited Series Finale Airs Sunday, November 22 at 9/8c

When a murder is committed, it sends shockwaves through a community. Investigators work to find the killer and bring closure to a community. But what happens when a case is closed, yet lingering questions remain? When doubt circulates throughout a city, and investigations are put under a microscope, people begin to ask: is the convicted truly the killer, or is someone evading the law while an innocent person sits taxed with their crimes? Join the hunt for answers and closure as ID delves into four stories of adjudicated cases, where the verdict remains under dispute. Walk step-by-step through critical crime scenes, key questioning and newfound evidence, with each episode telling both sides of a story. The conclusion is up for interpretation, and the viewer is left to decide: was justice served, or does the evidence just not add up?

- ***The Man with the Rabbit's Foot premieres November 15 at 9/8c***

In 1997, three bodies are found in the walk-in refrigerator of a gas station in Lake Charles, Louisiana. Two years later, Thomas Cisco, an acquaintance of one of the victims, confesses to the murders. But family members of the victims are not at peace with Cisco's confession, as mistrust of their Parish's law enforcement runs deep – especially when it comes to the longtime Sheriff, whose son resembles a composite sketch released to the public. Cisco also proves to be unreliable in his accounts and over several years, he gives investigators approximately 20 different statements about what happened the night of the murders. Though Cisco is sentenced to 90 years in prison for the murders, many including the victims' families still believe he has an accomplice who roams free. They are convinced there's more to the story of contested events that they feel, until today, has not been told.

- ***The Bingo Queen premieres November 22 at 9/8c***

On an early morning in March 1997, Angie Nihoff stops by to check on her grandma, Olga Parlante, known to all her friends as The Bingo Queen. Angie is horrified to find that Olga has been brutally beaten and isn't moving. On a call to 911, a frantic Angie can't stop screaming, but some closest to Angie wonder if it is all an act. By the time detectives arrive on the scene, Olga has been pronounced dead. As detectives untangle a web of clues, they never find any concrete evidence tying Angie to the murder. 15 years later, detectives feed unidentified palm prints from the crime scene into a new advanced computer database. The prints match Bennie Hall, a burglar who is already in prison. Using this new evidence, Hall is convicted of Olga Parlante's murder and is sentenced to life in prison two decades after Olga's death. But to this day some detectives still believe there may be a second murderer, who has never been caught.

ONGOING SERIES

TWISTED SISTERS

New Episodes Premiere Mondays at 9/8c

From a quiet town near the Smoky Mountains, to the sunny skies of St. Petersburg, Florida, stories in this season span the nation, and across multiple different family dynamics. It's not always the sister who is the culprit of the crime, but sometimes the accomplice, victim, whistleblower or unintended spy. Each episode of the Khloé Kardashian-produced series TWISTED SISTERS is shrouded in mystery, heartbreak and hidden emotions, proving that where there are family ties, there are also family lies.

- **Smoky Mountain Murder premieres November 9 at 9/8c**

Denice and Aaron Smith appear to be the perfect, loving couple until Denice's infidelity crumbles the marriage. The divorce proceedings are bitter, and Aaron is awarded custody of the children. Not long after, Aaron is found dead in what appears to be a robbery gone wrong. The kids are missing, as is Denice. After a massive manhunt, investigators find the kids safe and sound, with Denice. But there is more to the story than meets the eye.

- **The Good Sister premieres November 16 at 9/8c**

A serious childhood illness limits the mental development of Debbie Burns, requiring her older sister Barbara to care for her. For nearly 40 years, the sisters live a modest, peaceful life together in St. Petersburg, Florida. But a substantial inheritance disturbs the calm in the Burns home, pitting one sister against the other until, finally, one of them snaps.

HOMICIDE CITY

New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 9/8c

HOMICIDE CITY takes a deep dive into the crimes that shook Philadelphia to its core. The series explores cases from a darker time that had police detectives banding together across the metropolitan landscape in a sequence of manhunts. From the mansions of the wealthy suburbs to the rowhouse-lined streets of the inner city, each episode is told through the eyes of veteran homicide detectives, local beat reporters and the victims' families who lost so much.

- **The Last Party premieres Tuesday, November 10 at 9/8c**

A wild party ends in terror as a bright, young mom's cries for help fall on deaf ears. When detectives retrace her final steps, they find a trap with no way out.

- **The Kensington Strangler premieres Tuesday, November 17 at 9/8c**

When Elaine Goldberg's body is found in a vacant lot in Philadelphia, police believe they discovered a prostitute who had overdosed. But when two more young women's bodies are discovered in the same part of town, detectives fear they have a serial killer on their hands.

DEAD SILENT

New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 10/9c

Deep in the woods, inside an abandoned house, or along the shores of a sleepy lake, every snap of a twig or unidentified rustle can be a sign of danger. DEAD SILENT shows just how dark and desolate the great outdoors can be when no one can reach you, where myth, urban legend, and horror movie dread collide to showcase twisted tales too frightening to be imaginary. Each hour-long episode features one spine-tingling and terrifying true story, interwoven with expert

commentary from local authorities, true-crime experts, and psychologists, as well as first-person accounts from many of the victims who survived these nightmarish events.

- **The Girl on the Billboard premieres Tuesday, November 10 at 10/9c**
After 15-year-old Jasmine Block mysteriously vanishes into thin air, her mother Sarah launches a crusade to find her before it's too late. But when the sickening truth behind Jasmine's disappearance surfaces, it leaves Sarah in shock.
- **The Red River premieres Tuesday, November 17 at 10/9c**
After Allison Walker goes missing just days before Christmas, investigators scour her pig farm in Adairville, Kentucky in search of clues. They quickly discover that the deep, dark secret to her whereabouts lies within her own family.

EVIL LIVES HERE: SHADOWS OF DEATH

New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 10/9c

Evil casts a shadow. That shadow spreads outward for years, even decades, after a crime. It consumes everyone in its path, pulling them into darkness. EVIL LIVES HERE: SHADOWS OF DEATH explores the endless reach of evil – a reach that extends long after the crime itself. This original series highlights the struggle to survive as innocent people find themselves caught in the wake of death and evil.

- **The Ride Along premieres Thursday, November 12 at 10/9c**
In 1993, shortly after Christmas in Manhattan Beach, California, Pam Schultz gets a call that changes the course of her life forever. Her fiancé of just a few weeks, Martin Ganz, has been killed in the line of duty. What's worse, that night he was on patrol with his 12-year-old nephew for a ride along. Patrol Officer Tim Zins is working the graveyard shift in Manhattan Beach, California.. All is quiet until suddenly, the strangest thing happens: a child's voice emerges from his police radio. Within seconds, he realizes that it is a terrifying cry for help that he will never forget.
- **Buried Dreams premieres Thursday, November 19 at 10/9c**
On the morning of November 24th, 2007, in Bethany, Oklahoma, Katherine McDaniel wakes up to find that her 20-year-old daughter Lauren never returned home after going out the previous night. Most alarming of all: Lauren is five months pregnant and has no access to the crucial medication she needs to keep her and her unborn baby safe. Officer Angelo Orefice turns on the radio and hears a report about an abandoned vehicle discovered in at a local park. It belongs to a young woman who was just reported missing. Lauren's friend Vanessa Ward walks through the brush and tall grass at a wildlife refuge, looking any indication that the ground had been recently dug up. Vanessa knows what she is looking for, but she doesn't want to find it: the body of her beloved friend.
