MIAMI MEGA JAIL

One-Hour Special Premieres December 15 at 8 PM ET

Investigative journalist Louis Theroux goes inside Miami's Mega Jail to find out what life is like behind bars in one of America's toughest penitentiaries. Housing 6,000 prisoners and processing more than 100,000, it is a vast, high-security lockdown for inmates awaiting trial and sentencing. Some get out in a matter of days, but others remain locked up for months, even years, in overcrowded cells where inmates lay down the law and impose their own brand of justice. Theroux meets with guards who police the vast penitentiary, and inmates who fight to survive inside MIAMI MEGA JAIL.

THE WILL: OUTRAGEOUS FINAL WISHES

One-Hour Special Premieres Wednesday, December 21 at 9 PM ET

For some people, what happens to their body after death is one last chance to make a memorable statement about their life, and a simple funeral or cremation just won't cut it. This special examines the most eccentric final wishes, from the eco-conscious who want their bodies disposed of in "green" ways to live funerals and a man whose casket pays homage to his favorite beverage, Pabst Blue Ribbon. While people can do whatever they want to their body or belongings as long as it's legal, a panel of lawyers, an estate-planning expert, and a mortician consultant evaluate the likelihood if any of these wild wishes would actually hold up in a funeral home or, more importantly, a court of law.

PREMIERES

HOSTAGE: DO OR DIE ** TV-14

Season 1 Premieres Thursday December 1 at 10 PM ET

Step into the world of hijackings, kidnappings, and standoffs in HOSTAGE: DO OR DIE, a collection of harrowing stories told from the perspective of the hostage negotiators, victims, witnesses, and sometimes the criminals themselves. Hosted by Detective Dominick Misino, an NYPD veteran and pioneer of modern-day hostage negotiating techniques, each episode breaks down a case minute-by-minute to see for the first time what it took to rescue the hostages or, in some instances, what went wrong. Stunning graphics and animation bring to life high-energy recreations, taking viewers where cameras could never go: straight into the tense crossfire of hostage negotiation.

- **15 Days in Hell Premieres Thursday, December 1 at 10 PM ET** This episode tells the chilling story of how corrections officer and single mom Lois Fraley survived 15 days of being held hostage by two inmates in an Arizona prison. As the longest prison hostage standoff in U.S. history, this is the nightmarish tale of how she endured physical, psychological and emotional abuse and lived to talk about it thanks to the work of 30 negotiators who refuse to give up.
Location: Buckeye, AZ

- **Negotiating With a Mad Man Premieres Thursday, December 8 at 10 PM ET** One of the most tragic sequences of events in Tampa Police history is the death of a child, the murder of three cops, a car chase and a young woman taken hostage – all in one day. Gunman Hank Earl Carr went on a vicious rampage, killing officers and wounding many civilians before holing up in a mini-mart with a pregnant hostage. Negotiator Marisabel Kelly and a team of negotiators talked Carr out of another murder before the day came to a bone-chilling end. *Location: Tampa Bay, FL*
- **Palm Bay Rampage Premieres Thursday, December 15 at 10 PM ET** What could possibly be worse than a 21-year old grocery clerk being taken hostage by a deranged gunman who has killed two cops, four civilians and wounded fourteen with no phone to reach the murderer? Robin Brown tells the dramatic story of how she played the roles of William Cruse's hostage and negotiator in order to survive. *Location: Palm Bay, FL*
- **FBI Takeover Premieres Thursday, December 22 at 10 PM ET** A gunman took nine FBI employees hostage inside their own headquarters on a quiet Sunday morning. It was up to Detective Frank McClure and his team to negotiate their way out. Hostages, negotiators and SWAT officers provide the play-by-play for one of the worst days in FBI history. How they got the hostages out is one amazing story. How they took out the gunman is another. *Location: Atlanta, GA*
- **Lindhurst High School Premieres Thursday, December 29 at 10 PM ET** Years before the Columbine shooting massacre, Lindhurst High School suffered an event of their own. How did a small town handle a deranged, young killer who took 80 students hostage? Played like the script from a psychological thriller, negotiator Chuck Tracy eventually freed all the hostages and managed to bring the shooter out alive. *Location: Yuba City, California*

STOLEN VOICES, BURIED SECRETS ** TV-14

Season 2 Premieres Monday, December 5 at 10 PM ET

As one of ID's highest-performing series, STOLEN VOICES, BURIED SECRETS shares the unique perspective of the victim through fictionalized, first-person narration based on the facts of each case. While the all-seeing narrator knows who was responsible, the series creatively allows viewers to piece together who is the culprit based on clues from investigators, family and friends as each story unfolds.

- **Night Angel Premieres Monday, December 5 at 10 PM ET** Rosie Lerner was a typical teenager with the ability to find good in all people, including the bad boys she found herself befriending. With such a positive take on her risky choices, Lerner didn't see danger coming when she seemingly vanished into thin air one cold December night. Her family knew that something was wrong when she didn't come home, but police couldn't prove the possibility of murder without a body, and that's just how her killer wanted it. *Location: Lansing, MI*
- **Lethal Liason Premieres Monday, December 12 at 10 PM ET** Tori Vienneau was a young mother to baby Dean when their bodies were found strangled in their own apartment. Considered the best daughter and friend anyone could ask for, her loved ones were in complete shock at the thought of such violence. The crime's horrible nature made investigators and the community wonder what kind of animal would kill an innocent mother and her bouncing baby boy. Unfortunately, their answer wasn't very far from home. *Location: San Diego*
- **The Mask Premieres Monday, December 19 at 10 PM ET** Lisa Fein had everything she had ever dreamed of: a lovely home, a doting husband, and a wonderful infant son. Her small-town life had always been predictable and ordinary, but it was just the way she liked it. When Fein went missing in the middle of the night, an investigation was launched as the town processed the baffling disappearance. Little do investigators know, the identity of her killer is right under her fingertips. *Location: Galien Township, MI*
- **(In)Security Premieres Monday, December 26 at 10 PM ET** Bryan Ruff lived a simple, but charmed life. After marrying his high school sweetheart, Ruff became the father of two and worked as a nighttime security guard at a copper mine while studying for his nursing degree. Sometimes, the pressure of providing for a family at age 22 felt insurmountable, but he did anything to make it work. When Ruff disappeared, his wife wondered if the responsibility had become too burdensome. But when his body was found in the desert, they learned that Ruff's friends weren't as trustworthy as they seemed. *Location: Salt Lake City*

STALKED: SOMEONE'S WATCHING ** TV-14

Season 2 Premieres Monday, December 5 at 10:30 PM ET

With more than three million people falling victim to stalking in the United States each year, this widely misunderstood crime reaches far beyond celebrities and people in the public eye. **STALKED: SOMEONE'S WATCHING** profiles emotional stories of stalking victims and explores the twisted psychology of the people who relentlessly pursued them. Leading viewers through these tales of obsession is Michelle Ward, Ph.D., a criminal psychologist who has an expertise in neuroscience and personal experience as a stalking victim. Throughout each episode, Dr. Ward provides insight into the possible thoughts and motivations of the stalker and offers viewers important information they can use to protect themselves.

- **Dire Straits Premieres Monday, December 5 at 10:30 PM ET** Angelica Morales, a sweet and reserved college student residing outside New York City, falls in love for the first time when she meets a deceptively charming man, Joseph Hannan. He sweeps her off her feet but the relationship soon turns sour when Hannan's true nature is revealed. Morales tries to escape a vicious cycle of abuse, but Hannan refuses to let her go. He calls incessantly, follows her everywhere, and watches her every move. When Morales marries another man, Hannan's behavior only intensifies. Dr. Michelle Ward examines what happens when a person with no fear attempts to create terror. *Location: Staten Island, NY*
- **Signed, Your Deadly Fan Premieres Monday, December 12 at 10:30 PM ET** Successful comic book author and illustrator, Colleen Doran is used to getting fan mail and tries dutifully to correspond with everyone who shows interest in her work. However one of her fans, Walter Rose, wants more than just an autograph. Even though he has never met Doran, Rose believes he is in love with her and inundates her with love letters, cards, and gifts. When she spurns his advances, he attempts to ruin her career by spreading lies about her throughout the industry. Follow Dr. Michelle Ward as she journeys to find out what happens when a fan's admiration turns into a sick obsession. *Location: New York, NY*
- **Six Degrees of Separation Premieres Monday, December 19 at 10:30 PM ET** In 1996, Alexis Moore, a bright and free-spirited college graduate, meets a charismatic technology expert, Ben Streb, and the two begin a romantic relationship. But it isn't long before Streb reveals a disturbing side when he becomes violent and severely beats Moore over a trivial matter. She wants nothing more to do with him, however, Streb is a private investigator by trade and has the tools and knowledge to find her anywhere. In this episode, Dr. Michelle Ward explores this terrifying tale of cyber-stalking. *Location: Nevada County, CA*
- **Love is a Battlefield Premieres Monday, December 26 at 10:30 PM ET** Amanda Oliver is a young nurse living in the city of Decorah, Iowa, when she meets and falls in love with Steven Beach. In a whirlwind romance, they get married and start a family. But soon after their son is born, Oliver realizes she hardly recognizes the man she married as Beach becomes controlling and violent. Fearing for her life, Oliver flees with her child. Dr. Michelle Ward examines what happens when the man of your dreams turns out to be an endless nightmare. *Location: Decorah, Iowa.*

COPS & COYOTES ** TV-14

Season 2 Premieres Tuesday December 13 at 10 PM ET

Every year, billions of dollars-worth of narcotics is smuggled across the U.S.-Mexico border by drug mules, and millions of Mexican immigrants enter the United States illegally in search of a better life. In towns all along the border, law enforcement lives and works within the communities they have vowed to protect from the explosive increase in criminal activity. ID's **COPS & COYOTES** features a multiple-character law enforcement team battling to protect their town against a Mexican crime wave flooding across the fragile border.

- **The Real Wild West Premieres Tuesday, December 13 at 10 PM ET** With exclusive access to the front lines of the Mexican drug battle, DEA Agent Eduardo Chavez and his team face a dangerous situation making a cocaine bust in the drug trafficking hub of Albuquerque. Meanwhile, along the Rio Grande River in Texas, U.S. agents are busy tracking illegal immigrants, and Supervisor Shannon McCormick's life is threatened as he disarms a member of a Mexican cartel in the mountains.

- **Captive By Coyotes Premieres Tuesday, December 20 at 10 PM ET** With continued exclusive access to elite law enforcement, follow Border Patrol agents as they seize millions of dollars of cocaine and marijuana and ride along with undercover detectives in Phoenix to bring down a kidnap gang.
- **Hide and Seek Premieres Tuesday, December 27 at 10 PM ET** The Border Patrol in Texas plays a dangerous cat-and-mouse game with Mexican drug smugglers on the Rio Grande River. DEA agents Keith Brown and Eduardo Chavez tackle unpredictable methamphetamine and heroin dealers in the suburbs of Albuquerque. And at Ajo Border Patrol, Agents Shannon McCormick and Ryan Buchmann use their tracking skills to capture dope traffickers in the Arizona desert.

FINALES

COLD BLOOD TV-14

Season 3 Finale Airs Tuesday, December 20 at 9 PM ET

COLD BLOOD returns to the crime scene so that viewers can examine all the evidence for themselves. Combining the thrill of mystery with the visceral experience of true crime drama, this series presents competing versions of what may have happened, and re-enacts the events from different perspectives as new evidence comes to light. Each episode tells the story of one homicide investigation that revolves around the forensic investigation of the crime scene, and follows the clues wherever they may lead.

- **Home Invasion Premieres Tuesday, December 6 at 9 PM ET** In a tiny, peaceful town where nothing much happens, a mother finds her daughter Jessica Carpenter, raped and murdered on the living room floor. The neighborhood goes on high alert while police swing into action to catch her killer. When their lead suspect's DNA doesn't match, the Carpenters are destroyed and post a reward for any new leads. Five months later, a jailhouse informant fingers his cellmate for the crime. The new suspect lived nearby and was seen near Carpenter's home, but refuses to give his DNA. Have the police got the right man? *Location: Aiken, SC*
- **The Day the Music Died Premieres Tuesday, December 13 at 9 PM ET** Austin is world famous for its laidback music scene and rowdy spirit, but the party ends when single mother and nightlife regular Natalie Antonetti is savagely beaten in her sleep. Eighteen days later, Antonetti dies, and the investigation kicks into high gear but not without its challenges. Antonetti's friends, Austin's counter-culture musician community, want nothing to do with the police. A composite sketch of a suspicious man seen lurking outside her apartment is drawn up but no one matches the description. It's not until investigators discover a vitriolic note from a spurned lover that they establish their first real suspect. *Location: Austin, TX*
- **The Lost Boy Premieres Tuesday, December 20 at 9PM ET** Hollywood, Florida is a fast-growing city but still has a peaceful, small-town feel, until six-year-old Adam Walsh steps into a stranger's Cadillac in a mall parking lot and disappears into thin air. Law enforcement launches the state's biggest manhunt in history but finds Walsh's mutilated remains two weeks later. Police make it their mission to track down his killer, but a tragic stream of errors mars the investigation. *Location: Hollywood, FL*

FACING EVIL WITH CANDICE DELONG ** TV-14

Season 2 Finale Airs Friday, December 23 at 9 PM ET

Retired FBI criminal profiler Candice DeLong goes behind prison walls to sit down with the actual femmes fatales featured on ID's DEADLY WOMEN. Having been described as the real-life Clarice Starling, the FBI agent at the center of *Silence of the Lambs* and *Hannibal*, DeLong interprets these intimate interviews for audiences with help from an impressive repertoire of sleuthing skills that include trailing terrorists, going undercover within gangs and hunting for the infamous Unabomber.

- **A Nail in the Coffin Premieres Friday, December 2 at 9 PM ET** Dawn Silvernail grew up in the mountains and had a happy childhood, but is now serving time in prison as a convicted murderer. How did she get to this point? After falling into a relationship with a dangerous, controlling man, Silvernail found herself entangled in a passionate web of dominance, lesbian sex, betrayal, and a depraved plan for murder. Former FBI profiler Candice DeLong wants to discover the truth. Where did it all go wrong for Dawn Silvernail? *Location: Earlton, NY*
- **Homicidal Honeyooner Premieres Friday, December 9 at 9 PM ET** On a quiet suburban street, 20-year-old newlywed Ashley Humphrey kills Sandee Rozzo. Humphrey claims she was

brainwashed by her husband, Tracey, who, at the time of the shooting, was facing 10 years in prison for brutally attacking Rozzo. He wanted her dead, so he got his new wife to kill her on their honeymoon. From her prison in Florida, Humphrey talks to former FBI profiler Candice DeLong to find out how a love-struck girl becomes a deadly puppet. *Location: Pinellas Park, FL*

- **The Black Widow Bride Premieres Friday, December 16 at 9 PM ET** Hardware store owner Gerry Boggs is attacked with a stun gun, hit over the head with a shovel, and shot him three times in the back. Boggs knew his killer. It was his ex-wife, [Jill Coit](#). Boggs and Coit were fighting over property and about to go to civil court, when Boggs uncovered some secrets about his ex's past. Coit allegedly took matters into her own hands, but maintains today that she didn't do it. Is she an innocent woman or a black widow? From her prison cell in Florida, Coit speaks to former FBI profiler Candice DeLong. *Location: Steamboat Springs, CO*
- **Teenage Terror Premieres Friday, December 23 at 9 PM ET** It's a teenage love story gone terribly wrong: 18-year-old Sarah Luderman is stabbed to death by 19-year-old [Rachel Wade](#). While fighting over a boy, months of rivalry end in a deadly rumble. It was a feud that started in cyberspace but ended in the real world. How did a teenage drama reach this dramatic breaking point? Is Wade really a victim who acted in self-defense? From her prison in Florida, she tells former FBI profiler Candice DeLong her side of the story. *Location: Clearwater, FL*

ON THE CASE WITH PAULA ZAHN ** TV-14

Season 5 Continues Sundays at 10 PM ET

Profiling fascinating true stories and featuring gripping interviews conducted by Emmy Award-winning journalist Paula Zahn, ON THE CASE is a shining example of ID's core brand mission to investigate life's mysteries through riveting storytelling. Zahn's journalistic expertise and passion for the truth resonate as ON THE CASE unravels shocking investigations that have dominated headlines and intriguing original stories uncovered exclusively for ID's audience.

- **A Stranger's Knock Premieres Sunday, December 4 at 10 PM ET** [Norma Ates](#) was shot and killed in her own bedroom. Her body was discovered when firefighters responded to a fire inside her house. Investigators suspected the killer had staged the scene to make it look like a robbery gone wrong and then set the home on fire to cover their tracks. After years of searching police finally find two mysterious strangers who had been seen outside the house just before the crime took place. Their story will help solve the mystery and convict the most unlikely of suspects. *Location: Baker, FL*
- **Twice is no Accident Premieres Sunday, December 11 at 10 PM ET** Police couldn't understand how [Fran Smith](#) had the physical ability to leave her home without assistance. The newlywed lived in a three-story walkup and had recently suffered a broken hip. Police were suspicious of her new husband's story but they had no solid proof of foul play. The case went cold, until Smith's daughter and sister jump started the investigation by uncovering a vital clue. Their mother wasn't the first Mrs. Smith to disappear under mysterious circumstances. *Location: West Windsor Township, NJ*
- **Lost in the Fire Premieres Sunday, December 18 at 10 PM ET** When [Lucy Johnson](#), a pregnant mother of two, was found shot twice in the back of the head, her family and friends pointed police to several possible suspects. At the time of her murder, the 31-year-old ER nurse was twice divorced and embroiled in a nasty custody battle with an ex-boyfriend. But as the investigation unfolds, police stun everyone by zeroing in on the most unlikely of targets. *Location: Gastonia, NC*

DISAPPEARED ** TV-PG

Season 4 Continues Mondays at 9 PM ET

Each episode of DISAPPEARED begins at the time immediately before the individual vanished, and chronicles the search for clues hidden beneath seemingly everyday behavior that may indicate what happened to the missing. While some of the resolutions are heartwarming and others tragic, many cases remain open to this day and continue to be a source of unbearable frustration for the loved ones left behind. For the open cases that have gone cold, DISAPPEARED asks viewers to share any fresh leads in hopes of deciphering what truly happened to the missing.

- **Vanished in Vermont Premieres Monday, December 5 at 9 PM ET** Seventeen-year-old Brianna Maitland found life on her parents' remote farm boring, so in the fall of 2004, she transferred high schools to be with her friends. But after a short while, Maitland dropped out and couch-surfed with help from friends and boyfriends. With no consistent place sleep each night, it took four days for her family to realize she had gone missing. After numerous searches and an extensive investigation, the Maitlands are left to wonder what really happened to their daughter. Police think it all points to foul play, while others speculate that the teen was taken. But by whom? *Location: Montgomery, VT*
- **Midnight Walk Premieres Monday, December 12 at 9 PM ET** Lily Aramburo, a new mother and recovering drug addict, falls back into her old habits with her fiancé, Christen Pacheco. She goes to rehab but is kicked out for failing a drug test. The next day, after smoking crack with Pacheco and two friends, Aramburo walks out of her condo at 2 a.m. carrying two bungee cords. When she doesn't return, family and friends wonder if she's committed suicide. Before long, however, suspicions begin to swirl around Pacheco. Now, thanks to the persistence of Aramburo's loved ones, investigators may be close to unraveling the truth. *Location: Miami, FL*
- **The Wedding Ring Premieres Monday, December 19 at 9 PM ET** Tina McQuaig was a 27-year-old wife and mother. On the evening of March 15, 2000, after work at the hospital, she called her babysitter to say she's stopping at the grocery store on her way home. That was the last anyone heard from McQuaig. When her car was found four days later, her keys and purse were gone, as if she parked and walked away. As authorities probe McQuaig's life, they discovered secrets that stun her husband and family. *Location: Baldwin, FL*

THE WILL: FAMILY SECRETS REVEALED ** TV-PG

Season 2 Continues Wednesdays at 9 PM ET

Investigation Discovery invites viewers on an emotional journey of family members dealing with the aftermath of a loved one's final wishes in THE WILL: FAMILY SECRETS REVEALED. Hotly contested and sometimes surprising, a person's last will is often a very telling sign of how they perceived their loved ones – a single document outlining the distribution of every penny, asset and heirloom formerly in their possession. Each hour-long episode of THE WILL presents the most curious and contentious real-life stories of family inheritance, capturing personal drama filled with conspiracies, mysteries, tension and turmoil.

- **The Estate of Rock Hudson Premieres Wednesday, December 14 at 9 PM ET** Rock Hudson, the handsome Hollywood star, dies quietly in his sleep in his Beverly Hills home, called "The Castle." At age 59, he becomes the first major celebrity revealed to have AIDS. His death sparks a bitter lawsuit between his estate and Marc Christian, a younger man claiming the actor knowingly exposed him to HIV. An ugly trial leads to the jury's landmark decision about a partner's duty to disclose a potentially deadly diagnosis. But did Hudson really conspire to lie to his partner, or did Christian duped the jury and public? *Location: Hollywood, CA*
- **The Estate of Wayne Perry Premieres Wednesday, December 28 at 9PM ET** In 2005, renowned country songwriter Darrell "Wayne" Perry dies of throat cancer in an Ohio hospital at the age of 55, leaving four children and an estate valued at more than one million dollars. His death sparks a five-year legal struggle for control of his estate, a struggle that takes place against a backdrop of mega-churches and faith-healing televangelism. *Location: Monroe, OH*

DEVIL YOU KNOW TV-14

Season 1 Continues Wednesdays at 10 PM ET

DEVIL YOU KNOW delves into the secret lives of men and women who masquerade as law-abiding citizens but, behind the charade, are hiding deadly intentions from their loved ones. As each story unfolds, family and friends give first-hand accounts of the unimaginable betrayal that left them in the dark. These harrowing personal testimonials take viewers on a twisted journey as witnesses wrestle with the demons and devils they have come to know all too well.

- **Devil in Disguise Premieres Wednesday, December 7 at 10 PM ET** John Perry swept Barbara Bentley off her feet and gladly brought her into a glamorous scene of fancy parties and first class service. Perry told Bentley he was an admiral in the Navy and boasted about his numerous accomplishments. Charmed and in love, Bentley quickly married her admiral but the bliss was short lived as the FBI discovered that Admiral Perry's life was a complete lie. With the authorities

quickly closing in on his life of deception, Perry would attempt to get rid of the person who knew his lies most intimately, his wife. *Location: San Francisco, CA*

- **The Ultimate Betrayal Premieres Wednesday, December 14 at 10 PM ET** Val Wright, a wife and mother, raised her two young children in a tight-knit community. But in the fall of 1995, a horrific attack left one teenager dead and another clinging to life. The town's citizens were shocked by the brutality of the attacks and flood police with tips, but no suspects come to light. Five days after the attack, police receive a phone call from the killer that sets the pattern for a seven-month game of cat and mouse. Meanwhile, Wright's perfect life begins to unravel as her husband comes under suspicion for the murders. Could it be possible that her husband is behind the gruesome attacks? *Location: Abbotsford, British Columbia*
- **Life on the Run Premieres Wednesday, December 21 at 10 PM ET** Chip St. Clair's family moved from town to town, never staying long enough for him to make many friends. His parents were the life of the party, though, and St. Clair often heard how lucky he was to have such a great dad, but behind closed doors it was an entirely different story. The smallest of things could send his father into a rage. In his early twenties, St. Clair's life was turned upside down when his girlfriend, Lisa, reported to police that his father was giving him a brutal beating. After his father was arrested, St. Clair discovered that everything he knew about his life had been a lie, and the man who raised him was far more evil than he ever thought. *Location: Auburn Hills, MI*
- **Looks Can Kill Premieres Wednesday, December 28 at 10 PM ET** Dewayne Barrentine's new live-in girlfriend, Tausha Fields, seemed like the best of both worlds: a devoted single mother and an insatiable lover. She bent over backwards to make Barrentine feel like a king, and she was attentive with his son. Barrentine couldn't believe what had fallen in his lap. Fields didn't like to talk about her past, but when she did, her stories seemed farfetched. Intrigued by her mystery, Barrentine decided to do a little investigating online and was astounded to discover his girlfriend had been married five times all before turning 32, and that's not the only skeleton in her closet. *Location: Marianna, FL*

I (ALMOST) GOT AWAY WITH IT TV-14

Season 4 Continues Thursdays at 9 PM ET

For these perpetrators, the stories may be different, but the motives are always the same – to stay out of prison and live life on the lam. The people profiled in I (ALMOST) GOT AWAY WITH IT evaded justice for years, sometimes decades, by using their families, fake identification and even violence to avoid capture. Viewers learn how law enforcement uses all means necessary to capture these fugitives. Additionally, each episode features an interview from prison with these slick culprits, who spill where they found shelter, how they changed their identities and how they *almost* got away with it.

- **Got to Steal a Rich Woman's Jewelry Premiere's Thursday, December 1 at 9 PM ET** In 1985, Kaysie Dudley's mother gets fired from her job as a caregiver for an elderly widow named Geneva Kane. As revenge, Dudley and her mother hatch a plan to steal the 77-year-old's expensive rings. In the heat of the moment, Kane resists the assault and Dudley resorts to the unthinkable: cold blooded murder. Police attribute cause of death to strangulation and cuts to the throat. Over the course of the next year, Dudley hops from town to town, keeping one step ahead of the law until a tip from a friend finally ends her run from justice. *Location: Daytona Beach, FL*
- **Got to Make a Dummy Out of Sheets Premiere's Thursday, December 8 at 9 PM ET** With at least seven escapes and just as many life sentences, Frankie Lee Bass will stop at nothing to be free. His first escape occurs in 1974, only 2 months before he is to appear before the parole board. The thrill of breaking out leaves a lasting impression and Bass soon becomes one of the most prolific escape artists in Florida's history. From scaling razor wire fences to blasting through walls with a hijacked tractor trailer, Bass is determined to let nothing stand between himself and freedom. With Florida's best law enforcement hot on his heels, how long will he be able to stay out? *Location: Pinellas County, FL*
- **Got to Escape from the Rock Premieres Thursday, December 15 at 9 PM ET** William Van Poyck has a long history of criminal behavior dating back to his childhood. At age 17, he is sentenced to a term of 25-to-life for robbery. Years later, he becomes one of the few inmates to ever successfully escape from The Rock, a high-maximum security prison reserved for the most hardened criminals. He is able to avoid capture for over a month before being caught and sent back to prison. After being released on parole, Van Poyck returns to his old ways robbing banks

and even an armored car. In 1987, Van Poyck prepares for his most daring crime yet: ambushing a prison transport van to free another inmate. *Location: Palm Beach County, FL*

- **Got to Run to Mexico with My Kids Premieres Thursday, December 22 at 9 PM ET** In 2009, 29-year-old mother of three Valerie Castellano robs a bank to escape a warrant coming down for her arrest on fraud charges for passing bad checks. She flees to Mexico along with her three children and her girlfriend, Becky. Soon after the robbery, police target Castellano as their prime suspect. Mexico turns into a nightmare of extreme poverty, abuse, and a nearly-fatal illness for the fugitive and her children. Her mother sends money for rent and food, but the family barely survives. Back in Indiana, police focus their attention on Castellano's mother, hoping that she will be the key to her daughter's capture. *Location: Bunker Hill, IN*
- **Got to Pretend I'm a Priest Premieres Thursday, December 29 at 9 PM ET** After a series of bad decisions and mounting criminal charges, Fred Brito despairs that he'll never get a job through legitimate means. He uses his skills as a master impersonator to obtain a series of high-profile positions, a court psychiatrist, jet fighter pilot, and even a Catholic priest, all while on the run from the law. With LAPD's best detectives tracking him, he attempts to change masks fast enough to stay one step ahead. *Location: Los Angeles*

DEADLY WOMEN ** TV-14

Season 5 Continues Fridays at 10 PM ET

Femmes fatales, twisted sisters, desperate damsels: there's no shortage of these DEADLY WOMEN in season five of Investigation Discovery's cheeky hit series about women who kill for thrills. While male murderers are often driven by anger, impulse and destruction, women usually have more complex, long-term motives. Featured interviews with former F.B.I. criminal profiler Candice DeLong help viewers distinguish between the emotionally-charged impulses and sociopathic intentions that lace each story.

- **Pleasure from Pain Premieres Friday, December 2 at 10 PM ET**
 - Kerry Lynn Dalton was "mad" by her own admission. Irene May, a drug addict who shared a home and needles with Dalton, found out too late just how evil she could be. Dalton believed her roommate had stolen from her, betrayed her friends and that she was a rat and snitch. Bent on revenge, she tortured and killed May. On March 8, 1995 Dalton was convicted of first-degree murder with the special circumstances of torture and lying in wait. She is still on death row. *Location: Live Oak Springs, CA*
 - Living in London in the mid-18th Century, Elizabeth Brownrigg was an eminently respectable wife, mother of sixteen children, and professional midwife. But the care with which she raised her own children would belie the monstrosities she inflicted upon the daughters of other mothers. Brownrigg inflicted a lifetime of pain on her maid servants, killing the one who infuriated her the most. She was found guilty of murder and hanged in 1767. *Location: London*
 - The de-facto wife of Thomas Morris, Martha Rendell, cold-bloodedly murdered three of his children by swabbing their throats with hydrochloric acid. Although the children died slow and agonizing deaths, Rendell savored each moment of their torture. Under the pretense of love, she set up a vigil beside each dying child and took delight in seeing her victims writhe in agony. From it, she somehow derived a form of sexual satisfaction. Rendell was sentenced to death and hanged in late 1909. *Location: Perth, AUS*
- **Lethal Love Premieres Friday, December 9 at 10 PM ET**
 - Nineteen year-old Alice Mitchell was the daughter of a wealthy merchant and a society girl of Memphis. She and Freda Ward had become close friends at the Higbee School for Girls. So close that they declared their love for each other and planned to elope to St. Louis to live together as spouses. When Ward's family stopped the relationship, events took a dreadful turn. In 1892, Mitchell accosted Ward in the middle of downtown Memphis, cutting her throat with a straight razor. She was sentenced to life in an insane asylum on the pretense that a sane woman would never love another woman and entertain the notion of marrying her. *Location: Memphis, TN*
 - For Susan Wright, the art of seduction came easy. As an ex-stripper, she was able to use her body to get her way, and so in 2003, she put on a satin nightgown, placed candles around the bedroom and waited for her abusive, drug-addicted husband, Jeffrey, to come home. When he arrived, Wright playfully tied his hands and feet to the bedpost and

- straddled him. That's when she reached down, pulled out a butcher's knife and plunged it into his chest. She Wright was sentenced to 25 years in prison. *Location: Houston, TX*
- Laressa Schuster was unwilling to lose half of her successful agricultural chemicals business and beautiful home to her ex-husband, Tim. With an ever-growing hatred towards him, Schuster's one-time love turned lethal. She enlisted the help of her laboratory assistant to knock him out with chloroform, dump his body in a barrel and fill it with acid. Schuster and her accomplice were both sentenced to life without parole. *Location: Fresno, CA*
 - **Baby-Faced Killers Premieres Friday, December 16 at 10 PM ET**
 - In 1983, Shirley Katherine Wolf and Cindy Lee Collier stabbed 85-year-old Anna Brackett 28 times with a knife from her own kitchen. After confessing to the grisly murder, Wolf and Collier were sentenced to the maximum penalty under California law. Both confessed that the murder was "a kick" and that they wanted to do another one. They thought it was fun. *Location: Auburn, CA*
 - Courtney Dunkin's story is one of a little girl who went to live with her paternal grandparents, John and Betty Dunkin, because her parents had divorced, her father was an alcoholic and relatives didn't talk about her mother. In 1994, now teenage Dunkin and a friend talked on the telephone about killing the friend's boyfriend. But the focus soon shifted to grandma. After hanging up the phone, Duncan walked into her grandmother's bedroom, talked for a little while and then shot her. She will be eligible for parole in 2034. *Location: Grapevine, TX*
 - At the age of 12, Lorraine Thorpe's parents separated and she was sent to live with her alcoholic father. Few could have imagined at the time just how dramatically this move would change her life forever. Three years later, Thorpe turns to excessive drinking. Along with friend Paul Clarke, she was found guilty of smothering her dependent father and torturing and beating to death Clarke's girlfriend, Rosalyn. Sentenced to life in prison, Thorpe would become Britain's youngest convicted female double murderer. *Location: Suffolk, UK*
 - **Senseless Slayings Premieres Friday, December 30 at 10 PM ET**
 - LaFonda Fay Foster and Tina Hickey Powell had violent and troubled pasts, both having spent time in jail for various offences. On a spring evening in 1986, after a four-day binge of drinking and cocaine use, the close friends found themselves out of money and out of drugs. Intent to let the good times roll, they persuaded a friend and four acquaintances to go for a drive. But by morning, all five passengers were dead, murdered one by one in horrific circumstances, their bodies strewn across a five-mile radius. *Location: Lexington, KY*
 - In 1982, Melinda Harmon bludgeoned her husband, David, to death in the bed they, but it would be 20 years before she and their close friend Mark Mangelsdorf would be convicted of the crime. The murder was so vicious that responding officers had trouble discerning the gender or any identifying features of the victim, which to seasoned investigators was a telltale sign of a crime of passion. Both murderers are still incarcerated today. *Location: Olathe, KS*
 - Judy Moran, matriarch of the infamous Moran criminal family of Melbourne, lost her husband and two sons in a gangland war. She turned from grieving widow to murderer, convicted of the brazen daylight shooting of her brother-in-law, Des "Tuppence" Moran. He was shot seven times at a cafe in the, and although Moran did not pull the trigger, she did order the hit. It took the jury seven days to find the 66-year-old grandmother guilty of orchestrating the public killing, and of being an accessory after the fact. *Location: Melbourne, AUS*
