Psychological profiler Candice DeLong is the jungle guide on this fascinating tour of ID's deadliest female villains. What separates desperate damsels from powerful femme fatales? DeLong's criminal expertise helps her distinguish between emotionally-charged accidents and sociopathic intentions.

TRUE GRIME: CRIME SCENE CLEAN UP ** TV-14

Series Premieres Tuesday, July 19 at 10 PM ET

Television series often depict the lives of law enforcement, lawyers, and victims, but while they attempt to make sense of tragedy, who stays behind to remove the gruesome mess? TRUE GRIME: CRIME SCENE CLEAN UP introduces viewers to the strong-stomached team at Crime Scene Cleaners, who do just that. Follow owner Neil Smither and his crew as they respond to calls in real time and try to erase the physical reminders of graphic events. From sports cars toting murder scenes to homes hiding unsanitary secrets, the team's "office" changes daily. It's the type of company you hope never to call, but you're glad it exists.

- Road Rage *Premieres Tuesday, July 19 at 10 PM ET* Oakland, Cal.-based Crime Scene Cleaners is called to the scenes of two separate homicides in the same crime-ridden neighborhood, worrying Smither for the safety of his crew. Unfortunately, their effort at one of the sights leaves traces of blood behind, prompting the victim's great-grandmother to call in a complaint. Smither personally visits the woman to rectify the issue, displaying the importance of his company's commitment to restoring both the property and emotional stability of those affected by tragic incidents.
- Running Ragged *Premieres Tuesday, July 26 at 10 PM ET* As a 24-hour operation, Crime Scene Cleaners is on the scene no matter the time of day, making for brutal schedules and sleep-deprived staff. Smither arranges to hire some fresh faces, requiring an extensive vetting process due to the niche attractiveness of this line of work. Elsewhere, the entire crew is needed to scrub a hoarder's house, where the victim's decomposing body lay for weeks before being discovered.

WHO THE (BLEEP) DID I MARRY? ** TV-PG

Season 2 Premieres Wednesday, July 13 at 10 PM ET

Pulling back the curtain on bizarre double lives, WHO THE (BLEEP) DID I MARRY? examines stories of couples in which one spouse has hidden a shocking secret. From bank robbers to bigamists and international spies, these sometimes shocking characters will have viewers shaking their heads in disbelief and wondering how the truths behind these scandalous spouses were kept hidden for so long.

- Third Time's No Charm Premieres Wednesday, July 13 at 10 PM ET Tammi McCreary has never been lucky in love, so she thinks fate is finally on her side when she meets handsome Dr. Eric Perteet. Their romance is whirlwind, but Eric reveals that he quit medicine after his children and parents were killed. With Tammi by his side, however, he is ready to resume his medical career and love life. The two get married and Tammi is finally happy, until Eric is arrested for impersonating a doctor. As her reality crumbles, Tammi is left to figure out who it was she really married. Location: Atlanta
- From Protector to Predator Premieres Wednesday, July 20 at 10 PM ET Rickielee always wanted the perfect family, and feels her dream has come true after marrying Jeff Pelo, a 17-year police veteran and doting father to the couple's three children. But when Jeff is caught lurking outside another woman's home in the middle of the night, Rickielee's perfect existence unravels. Police have finally found the serial rapist that's been terrorizing young women for four years, and they are horrified to discover the perp is one of their own. Location: Bloomington, IL
- The Admiral's Wife Premieres Wednesday, July 27 at 10 PM ET Barbara Bentley is a happily single divorcee when she meets retired Rear Admiral John Perry. Barbara and John, a supposed winner of the Congressional Medal of Honor and speaker of seven languages, become inseparable. They marry in Tijuana one year later, but the honeymoon glow fades when Barbara notices her new husband's spending problem and reluctance to introduce her to his family. Her sneaking suspicion becomes real-life nightmare when the FBI exposes John as a conman who uses a fake persona to facilitate his crimes. Location: San Francisco Bay Area

I MARRIED A MOBSTER ** TV-14

Series Premieres Wednesday, July 13 at 10:30 PM ET

You see their lives portrayed in movies like *Married to the Mob* and *Goodfellas*, but rarely, if ever, do you hear them speak or get a glimpse into their lives. I MARRIED A MOBSTER presents stories of the mob from a new perspective: the women who had unprecedented access into this secretive world, where breaking vows could literally get you killed. With reenactments, archival photos and interviews, each episode tells the back-story of one family's rise and fall from the first person point-of-view of the Mrs.

- Cheryl and Philly: A Love Story *Premieres Wednesday, July 13 at 10:30 PM ET* Cheryl and Phil "Philly" Caruso's marriage begins and ends with betrayal. Both young lovers walk away from their fiancés to start a lavish life together on Long Island funded by Philly's "printing company." Cheryl thinks she's living an honest life, until Philly gets a court summons. Try as he might to conceal the truth from his wife, Philly is convicted of racketeering and drug dealing, leaving Cheryl shattered, broke, and alone in raising their two daughters. *Location: Long Island*
- Working Mom *Premieres Wednesday, July 20 at 10:30 PM ET* Most mafia wives turn a blind eye while enjoying the spoils of their husbands' illicit activities. One Staten Island wife, however, can't settle for being a mere accessory. Not only does Andrea Giovino closely follow the risky behavior of her mob husband, John Fogerty, but she literally has blood on her hands. With the FBI knocking at her door, Andrea must decide whether to give herself up or turn her back on the mafia at risk of death. *Location: Staten Island*
- The Grim Reaper *Premieres Wednesday, July 27 at 10:30 PM ET* Linda Schiro, a beautiful Brooklyn teen, finds herself in a love triangle with two made men. Both want her for their own despite each already having a wife, so it's up to the Colombo crime family to name the better man. Greg Scarpa, one of the most feared mafia enforcers, takes home the prize, and as the couple's relationship blossoms, they live a life of romance, danger, mystery, and trust. Greg even reveals his past as a paid FBI informant. Linda becomes a doting wife while surviving a gang war, the loss of a child, and being left alone as her husband's world unravels. *Location: Brooklyn*

DEADLY WOMEN TV-14

Season 5 Premieres Friday, July 29 at 10 PM ET

DEADLY WOMEN takes viewers on a journey into the bizarre world of women who kill for thrills. While male murderers are often driven by anger, impulse and destruction, women usually have more complex, long-term motives. Featuring Candice DeLong, a former FBI agent and criminal profiler, this series explores the psyche of female killers, showing what turns love affairs into fatal attractions or how twisted minds and dark secrets can send women on lethal rampages.

• Twisted Thrills Premieres Friday, July 29 at 10 PM ET

- O Christina Walters was the leader of The Crips, one of America's largest and most violent gangs. In 1998, she ordered a group of would-be members to take part in an initiation killing of three people. Two of the victims, Tracy Lambert and Susan Raye Moore, were shot to death, but Debra Cheeseborough miraculously survived seven bullet wounds. Location: Raleigh, NC
- O Judith Adams eloped with her soul mate, Alvin Neelley, though their marriage was hardly an epic love story. Within a few years, they were committing a tri-state rampage of robbing lone women, convenience stores and gas stations. When they grew bored of their life on the lam, the Neelleys began abducting, raping and murdering young women. Locations: Georgia, Texas
- O In the early morning hours in rural Australia, a murderous plot went awry. Six friends took turns attempting to kill an innocent man, Joseph Snabel. However, despite their many efforts, Snabel refused to succumb to death. Irene Masilne finally took matters into her own hands and finished him off by suffocating him with a plastic bag. Location: Australia

FINALES

I (ALMOST) GOT AWAY WITH IT ** TV-14

Season 3 Finale Airs Tuesday, July 19 at 9 PM ET

For these perpetrators, the stories may be different, but the motives are always the same – to stay out of prison and live life on the lam. The people profiled in I (ALMOST) GOT AWAY WITH IT evaded justice for years, sometimes decades, by using their families, fake identification and even violence to avoid capture. Viewers learn how law enforcement uses all means necessary to capture these fugitives. Additionally, each episode features an interview from prison with these slick culprits, who spill where they found shelter, how they changed their identities and how they *almost* got away with it.

- Got Shot in the Leg *Premieres Tuesday, July 5 at 10 PM ET* After a friend is fired, Konh Chung Bounnam and three accomplices rob the restaurant where he worked. The plan quickly goes awry and three workers are brutally executed. Bounnam and his friends go on the run but he is shot during the robbery and needs medical attention. The others are caught or turn themselves in, but Bounnam remains free despite his injury. He escapes close calls with the cops in North Carolina and Canada until his need for money draws the FBI's attention. *Location: Memphis, TN*
- Got to Hide in a Swamp *Premieres Tuesday, July 12 at 10 PM ET* In shackles and chin-deep in a swamp, Dominic Reddick is on the run after escaping a prison transport van. Despite having cops and K-9s on his trail, Reddick hitches a ride with a friend to Savannah, GA, and thanks him by sleeping with his girlfriend. Fueled with jealously, the friend rats him out to the cops. Reddick narrowly escapes by hiding in the woods, but desperately needs food. He comes across some doughnuts in a convenience store dumpster. Little does he know that the cops are waiting inside. *Location: Sumter County, FL; Savannah, GA*
- Got to Work on a Crab Boat *Premieres Tuesday, July 19 at 9 PM ET* **Please note time change Kenneth "Speedy" Raulerson flees all the way to Alaska after robbing a bank in Florida. He quickly adapts to life in the Alaskan wilderness and supports himself by getting work on a crab boat. Once homesick, he returns to Florida to hide in the backwoods and live off the land. Raulerson suspects it's only a matter of time before he's caught and prepares to go down fighting. Police decide the only way to level the field is to lure him out of the woods and capture him on their turf. *Location: Levy County, FL*

THE DEVIL YOU KNOW TV-14

Season 1 Finale Airs Wednesday July 6 at 10 PM ET

DEVIL YOU KNOW delves into the secret lives of men and women who masquerade as law-abiding citizens but, behind the charade, are hiding deadly intentions from their loved ones. As each story unfolds, family and friends give first-hand accounts of the unimaginable betrayal that left them in the dark. These harrowing personal testimonials take viewers on a twisted journey as witnesses wrestle with the demons and devils they have come to know all too well.

• Devil of a Husband *Premieres Wednesday, July 6 at 10 PM ET* Barbra Reifel thought her fairytale was just beginning when she said "I do" to Michael Mastromarino, one of Manhattan's most successful oral surgeons. Their young family had an impeccable reputation, until Michael and his mistress were arrested for drunk driving. Barbra's last straw finally came when Michael violated his probation and lost his license to operate. After rehab, however, Michael was a changed man and the family began to repair itself emotionally and financially. The Mastromarinos were finally happy when a gruesome discovery shocked them and the nation.

Zachary's father, Christian Longo, is the only family member still unaccounted for, causing agents to question whether the family has fallen victim to an outside attack or if the real predator came from within. *Location: Waldport, OR*
- **Deadly Game** *Premieres Friday, July 8 at 10 PM ET* Mild-mannered pizza delivery man Brian Wells stuns the FBI when he calmly robs a bank with a strange collar-like bomb wrapped around his neck. As the bomb ticks down to Wells' sure death, he insists to authorities that he has been set up and is not acting alone. Is Wells telling the truth? The FBI hunts for an answer and is drawn into a complex web of lies and deceit spun by an unexpected mastermind. *Location: Erie, PA*

- A Betrayal at Charisma Farms *Premieres Sunday, July 3 at 10 PM ET* When Robert Dorotik's body was found on the side of the road, it appeared he was the victim of a jogging accident. Suspicious circumstances, however, led investigators to conclude that Dorotik had been murdered, re-dressed and left there in an attempt to throw police off track. Instead, the trail led to his wife, Jane, who disapproved of his plans to sell their horse farm and later pointed the finger at her own daughter, leaving the jury to decide who was responsible for the betrayal at Charisma Farms. *Location: Roanoke, VA*
- Mystery in the Mountains *Premieres Sunday, July 10 at 10 PM ET* Kathryn Dockweiller disappeared without a trace from her home in the Manzano Mountains near Albuquerque. There were no signs of forced entry and Dockweiller's car was still in the driveway, but days later her bound and lifeless body was found in a shallow grave just a few miles from home. At first, police targeted her husband, but his air-tight alibi led them off his trail. It wan't until a retired FBI profiler revisited the cold case that investigators finally solved the mystery in the mountains. *Location: Albuquerque, NM*

- A Slip of Fate *Premieres Sunday, July 17 at 10 PM ET* Hazelynn Stomps crawled up a steep hill from Oregon's Gordon Creek to tell passersby she had just survived being thrown off a bridge. As paramedics treated her injuries, she reported a harrowing story to police. Apparently, two men attacked her and her husband Gerald, and now he's missing. The story became more and more shocking to police as they uncovered a sinister plot that cost the life of decorated war veteran Gerald Stomps at the hands of a loved one. *Location: Corbett, OR*
- Murder Ordained? *Premieres Sunday, July 24 at 10 PM ET* Sandy, wife of small-town minister Tom Bird, is found dead in her car, submerged in a Kansas river. With questions still unanswered about what caused the supposed car crash, investigators were forced to rule Bird's death an accident. The case plateaued until Martin Anderson, husband of Tom's secretary, is killed by a masked gunman. Were the deaths connected? Police investigators pulled the shrouds off an unholy affair and sinister plot to kill two innocent victims. *Location: Emporia, KS*

• Above the Law Premieres Monday, July 4 at 10 PM ET

- o Buying Justice In Texas, oil heir T. Cullen Davis was known for two things: being at one point the state's richest resident and causing the most infamous murder trial in state history. In 1974, his wife Priscilla Wilborn won their mansion as a divorce settlement, making Davis so mad that he returned one night and massacred Wilborn, her boyfriend, daughter, and two house guests. After reportedly bribing his attorney to win, the jury found Davis not guilty of first-degree murder on the notion that a millionaire would never commit murder without hiring a hit man. Location: Fort Worth, TX
- Scorned When Anne Marie Fahey went missing in June 1996, family members turned to her diary for answers. A scheduling secretary to the Governor of Delaware, Fahey had been having a secret affair with Tom Capano, a prominent lawyer with a dark side. Police thought he was their man, but they didn't have witnesses, a murder weapon or even a body. Circumstantial evidence, however, indicated foul play. The man who arrogantly believed he could get away with murder, in fact had not. Location: Wilmington, DE

• The Wayward Son Premieres Monday, July 11 at 10 PM ET

- O The Pipe Bomber Even though Margaret Hitchcock Benson showered her sons with the proceeds from a \$10 million tobacco fortune, they were far from being mama's boys. In fact, she lived in fear that they wanted her dead. In 1985, Benson was in the driveway of her Naples, Fla., home when a pipe bomb exploded between the front seats of her car, killing herself and her son, Scott, and seriously injuring her daughter, Carol Lynn. Soon it would be revealed that mother really did know best. Location: Naples, FL
- The Son Rises Ambitious, bold and brash, Charlie White was a larger-than-life Texas millionaire who harbored an unbridled passion for the fairer sex. Charlie seemed well-liked, until police discovered him dead in 2005 and learned that he had no shortage of enemies, including his own son, Darin. Charlie had made a habit of satisfying his sexual appetite with Darin's girlfriends, and the son had had enough. Location: Horseshoe Bay, TX

• Fatal Greed Premieres Monday, July 18 at 10 PM ET

O The Glensheen Murder – Elisabeth Congdon, daughter of Minnesota mining magnate Chester Congdon, was still single when she fatefully decided to adopt a daughter. Marjorie was spoiled, sociopathic and couldn't wait to inherit her mother's millions. In 1977, Elisabeth and her nurse were found dead in the family's estate, Glensheen. Evidence led police to Marjorie and her husband Roger Caldwell. He admitted to both

- murders before committing suicide, but Marjorie was acquitted. She went on to lead a life of crime, committing arson, fraud and murder in multiple states. *Location: Duluth, MN*
- o Billionaire Boys Club To outsiders, California's Billionaire Boys Club (BBC) appeared to be an investment group. In reality, however, it was a cult-like order led by Joe Hunt, a charismatic sociopath who preached a Machiavellian approach to life. In 1984, after losing millions in investment scams gone awry, Hunt turned to kidnapping and murder to solve the BBC's mounting financial problems. All he ever wanted was everything, but someone else had to suffer so he could get it. Location: Los Angeles

• A Family Feud Premieres Monday, July 25 at 10 PM ET

- Ohio business into a \$50 million corporation, and built a lengthy list of enemies along the way. His fast-track ride to the top came to a violent halt in August 1980 when he was found shot to death in his home. The investigation yielded conflicting leads with clues pointing toward the Mafia, the drug world, and the gay community. Eventually, one of Milo's own relatives was found guilty in a murder-for-hire plot so complicated that 11 people were convicted over it. *Location: Bath, OH*
- The Special Delivery When Donald Levine discovered his brother, Robert, was embezzling profits from their \$25 million business empire, he didn't know how much it would eventually cost him. Donald confronted his brother, but Robert hit back with deadly force. In 1989, a hit man went to Donald's Illinois home. Posing as a deliveryman, he shot and killed Donald and his wife. Their son escaped, and with his help, authorities tracked down Robert until he surrendered. Location: Munster, IL

WICKED ATTRACTION TV-14

New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 9 PM ET

WICKED ATTRACTION examines what happens in the mind of the "average" person when they fall under the spell of a sadistic predator. Forensic psychologists and criminal profilers uncover horrifying clues and reveal the true stories of people driven to commit murder together. This series investigates some of the most terrifying crimes in recent history and delves inside the criminal mind to explore the psychological motivations behind deadly duos.

- 57 Seconds *Premieres Thursday, July 7 at 9 PM ET* In the fall of 1989, a hired assassin shoots Daytona Beach businesswoman Lisa Fotopoulos while she sleeps... then his weapon jams. Her husband, Kosta, is awakened by the noise, grabs his own gun, and kills the intruder. Lisa miraculously survives and detectives identify the shooter as Bryan Chase. They soon overturn Kosta's extramarital affair, prostitute ring business, money counterfeiting habit, and pension for videotaping his murders. *Location: Daytona Beach, FL*
- Dante's Inferno *Premieres Thursday, July 14 at 9 PM ET* Celebration quickly turns to tragedy in Eustis, Fla., when a gang of masked gunmen interrupt a bachelor party to demand money and valuables. They open fire after robbing the group, killing Bernard Blunt and Kison Evans and seriously injuring Josh Daniel. Investigators target Angel Glenn, a stripper who was secretly providing information on the party to the robbers. She quickly gives up her accomplices, boyfriend and drug dealer Donte Hall and his identical twin Dante. *Location: Eustis, FL*
- Bad Fortune *Premieres Thursday, July 21 at 9 PM ET* The Little Saigon community of Orange County, Cal., is shaken when well-known fortune teller Ha Smith and her daughter Anita Vo are butchered and slathered in white paint. While investigators puzzle over the evidence, they discover sex shop owner Tanya Nelson is charging a cross-country shopping spree to Smith's credit cards. Nelson, a former client of Smith, had become enraged when the fortune teller failed to reunite her with an illicit lover, so she convinced a married man to help her exact revenge in exchange for helping him explore his secret homosexual fantasies. *Location: Garden Grove, FL*
- Road to Nowhere *Premieres Thursday*, *July 28 at 9 PM ET* Maurice Mason is obsessed with his girlfriend, Jennifer Hitchcock, and whisks her away to Wisconsin in order to cut off ties with her loved ones. After police rescue her, Mason recruits his impressionable nephew Bennie Frier as an accomplice and heads to Hitchcock's hometown of Lincoln, NE, where he beats and stuffs her in the trunk of her own car. With their new captive, the duo robs and shoots two innocent men. They kill Hitchcock once back in Wisconsin, and as a final act of freedom, enjoy a lavish meal before calling police to confess their crimes. *Location: Lincoln, NE; Wisconsin*

NIGHTMARE NEXT DOOR TV-14

New Episodes Premiere Thursdays at 10 PM ET

How well do you know your neighbors? NIGHTMARE NEXT DOOR tells the tales of mysterious murders from behind white picket fences that rocked Middle America. Each hour bring a new murder mystery and a new look into the evil that can lurk in the heart and soul of a tight-knit community. Interviews with investigators, prosecutors, family members and/or neighbors piece together the twisting tale of a classic whodunit, and forensic experiments lead viewers into the heart of the investigation.

- **Death in Santa Barbara** *Premieres Thursday, July 7 at 10 PM ET* The seaside town of Santa Barbara is a picturesque resort community with an eclectic mix of easy-going attitudes and savoir faire. But one night in 2004, the quiet is shattered by a single gunshot ending the life of 27-year-old grad student Jarrod Davidson. The only evidence is a mangled bullet slug and a mysterious houseplant found at the victim's doorstep, but as detectives dig into Davidson's private life, they discover that the sunny California boy may have been mixed up with the wrong crowd. *Location: Santa Barbara, CA*
- No Safe Harbor *Premieres Thursday, July 14 at 10 PM ET* Safety Harbor, Fla., is a quiet town where downtown shops close early and kids play in the street. It's at the end of one of Safety Harbor's many cul-de-sacs that 32-year-old Nikki Halpin is beaten to death in her own home and in front of her two young sons. With several people on the suspect list, it isn't until detectives hear a mysterious 911 recording that they have the clue needed to solve Halpin's murder. *Location: Safe Harbor, FL*
- **Skeletons in the Closet** *Premieres Thursday, July 21 at 10 PM ET* Investigators are at a loss after 18-year-old Brittany Loritts is murdered in her Salisbury, NC, home. With no murder weapon or physical evidence, they go door to door asking for clues, relying on neighbors to piece together Loritts' final hours. When an unexpected suspect fits the profile, the investigation plows forward as detectives unlock a closet full of skeletons and find that this family home is built on buried secrets. *Location: Salisbury, NC*
