PREMIERES

[BEHIND MANSION WALLS](#) ** TV-14

Series Premieres Monday, June 6 at 10 PM

What happens to the rich and privileged when money no longer buys happiness? BEHIND MANSION WALLS slips under the veil of wealth to reveal sensational stories of mystery and murder. With society journalist Christopher Mason, BEHIND MANSION WALLS chronicles the secret affairs, hidden accounts, and false identities that lurk in the shadows of America's gated communities.

- **Death in Palm Beach Premieres Monday, June 6 at 10 PM ET**
 - *Deadly Divorce* - Rose Keil was exactly what real estate mogul Fred Keller was looking for in his fifth wife. The ambitious German model eagerly answered his classified ad and adopted his privileged Palm Beach lifestyle, but Fred was a controlling husband. In 2003, Rose filed for divorce and, despite signing a pre-nuptial agreement, felt she was entitled to half of Fred's \$100 million fortune. Rose may have been promised the world, but her life was cut short before she ever got a dime.
 - *Not Good Enough for Us* - Lita McLinton came from a wealthy African-American family, but skin color mattered more than breeding in her new, dominantly white Palm Beach neighborhood. For her husband, James Sullivan, being accepted into the local upper crust was top priority, and he blamed Lita when they weren't invited to society parties. She eventually filed for divorce, hoping to claim half of James' assets, but not before she was gunned down in 1987, setting off a 15-year cross-continental manhunt.
- **The Perfect Crime Premieres Monday, June 13 at 10 PM ET**
 - *The Evil Son* - Two days after Easter 1992, police discovered the bodies of airplane dealer Dale Ewell, his wife and daughter in their Fresno, Cal., home. Detectives immediately suspected the surviving son, Dana, a college student who wore high-end suits, told costly lies, and wanted to take over the family business. However, there was no evidence tying him to what seemed like the perfect crime. For three years, police chased leads while Dana sought his inheritance and dared police to cuff him.
 - *An Experiment with Murder* - Nathan Leopold, Jr. and Richard Loeb were wealthy University of Chicago students when they took the life of 14-year-old Bobby Franks in 1924. Believing they were intellectually superior and above the law, the duo convinced themselves they could get away with murder and used Franks to test their theory. Despite their supposed intelligence, "Leopold and Loeb," as they were known, left a fascinating trail of clues that crafted the perfect detective story rather than the perfect murder.
- **Fatal Dynasty Premieres Monday, June 20 at 10 PM ET**
 - *The Eccentric Millionaire* - It took years for the duPont family to become American royalty and just one moment for one wayward scion, John DuPont, to take it all away. In 1996, he shot Olympic gold medalist David Schultz outside the wrestler's home, then retreated to his Pennsylvania mansion, where he held police at bay for two days. Witnesses attested to

- duPont's bizarre behavior, noting that he installed booby traps in his house to ward off intruders and referred to himself as Christ Child.
- *To Save the Family Name* - Dean MacGuigan loved Pati Margello, but his mother, glamorous duPont heiress Lisa Dean Moseley, and her husband Christopher, disapproved of her cocaine and prostitution habits. In 1998, when police discovered Margello dead in an infamous Las Vegas motel and three hired killers were found with Moseley's family fortune, it became apparent just how badly the duPonts wanted Margello out of their lives.
 - **Rich Kids Premieres Monday, June 27 at 10 PM ET**
 - *The Society Murders* - When wealthy Australian socialite Margaret Wales-King and her husband Paul went missing in April 2002, the case had all the makings of a Dallas-style soap opera. The high-society couple was later found poisoned to death by their son Matthew Wales and his wife. He adamantly argued that his parents died not for their money but because he was tired of his mother using wealth to manipulate him. Feeling disempowered, Wales chose murder over mending their relationship.
 - *The Spoiled Robin Hood* - In Fort Worth, Texas, in 1992, Jack and Caren Koslow slept while 17-year-old Kristi waited downstairs for them to be killed. Caren died, but Jack survived and soon learned that his daughter was so desperate to collect her inheritance that she hired two men, including her boyfriend Brian Salter, to commit murder in exchange for \$1 million. Kristi described herself as a real-life Robin Hood, stealing from the rich to help Salter care for his ailing mother and buy a new car. In the end, all this rich kid got was a wealth of jail time.

- **Poisonous Love Premieres Wednesday, June 15 at 10 PM** Tensions were high in Michael and Stacey Wallace's household when he suddenly fell ill and died in 1999. Stacey never grieved her supposed soulmate's death, and she soon remarried. Not much time passed, though, before Stacey's daughters discovered that, like clockwork, their new father had gotten sick and died suddenly of mysterious ailments. Police suspected Stacey had a hand in both deaths, but little did they know she was about to commit the ultimate crime in an effort to frame her daughter.
- **Devil in a Pinstripe Suit Premieres Wednesday, June 15 at 10:30 PM** Louise Gallagher had two bright daughters, a lovely home and a successful career, but was still looking for her prince charming. Conrad Cini seemed to be the perfect man, but little did Gallagher know he had a habit for deception. He said the mafia was on his tail and wanted to murder her and her daughters to teach him a lesson. The treacherous activity pushed her to cut off ties with her children to keep Cini from destroying their lives, too. In the name of love, Gallagher was suddenly homeless and on the run.
- **Devil of a Dad Premieres Wednesday, June 22 at 10 PM** Tim and Elaine Boczkowski were happily running an ice cream shop in Greensboro, N.C., when a horrific car accident left Elaine with a sudden change of heart. Despite separating, the couple kept living together for the sake of their three children, but the plan backfired when Elaine drowned in the bathtub one night. Tim showed little emotion and soon found a new love. Maryann Fullerton clearly adored her stepchildren, but tragedy struck again, landing Tim behind bars and his children on their own.
- **The Wily Widower Premieres Wednesday, June 22 at 10:30 PM** Barbara Daniels instantly fell head over heels when she met Oliver Killeen. Despite red flags that he wasn't who he said he was, Daniels threw caution to the wind and the two quickly married in a lavish ceremony. The honeymoon ended abruptly, though, when creditors began calling about unaccounted-for wedding expenses and Daniels realized that Killeen was actually a conman and bigamist. Years later, she crusaded to stop Killeen from terrorizing his next wife before it was too late.
- **In Bed with the Devil Premieres Wednesday, June 29 at 10 PM** Judith Mawson thought she hit the jackpot when she met Gary Ridgeway. The couple lived an idyllic lifestyle and shared a

fondness for the simple things in life, but Mawson's world came crashing down the day police showed up with reason to believe that Ridgeway may be the infamous Green River serial killer. With her husband charged for murdering several prostitutes in the Seattle area, Mawson's initial skepticism faded to disbelief as Ridgeway revealed his true colors.

NIGHTMARE NEXT DOOR TV-14

Season 4 Premieres Thursday, June 9 at 10 PM

How well do you know your neighbors? NIGHTMARE NEXT DOOR tells the tales of mysterious murders from behind white picket fences that rocked Middle America. Each hour bring a new murder mystery and a new look into the evil that can lurk in the heart and soul of a tight-knit community. Interviews with investigators, prosecutors, family members and/or neighbors piece together the twisting tale of a classic whodunit, and forensic experiments lead viewers into the heart of the investigation.

- **Murderer in the Midst Premieres Thursday, June 9 at 10 PM** Successful Korean-American business owner Robert Chae and his family are brutally attacked in their suburban Philadelphia home, leaving Chae dead. County investigators first believe the attack is part of a pattern of assaults against local Asian-American businesses, but soon discover an alarming connection that sends them racing to protect the Chaes from one of their very own.
- **Murder on Main Street Premieres Thursday, June 16 at 10 PM** Bloomsbury, N.J., is a quaint town, so a dark stain is left on the picture-perfect community when 38-year-old Monica Massaro is murdered in her house on Main Street. Investigators begin crossing suspects off their mile-long list, but months pass as progress on the case slowly creeps to a standstill. Suddenly, a chance tip comes in from 300 miles away and the race for Massaro's killer is back on.
- **Coed Confidential Premieres Thursday, June 23 at 10 PM** In Las Cruces, N.M., 22-year-old graduate student Katie Sepich disappears after a party and is later found raped, strangled, and burned to death in a nearby landfill. News of the murder leaves the college town gripped in fear and detectives scratching their heads as to who could be responsible. The three-year investigation leads police from the victim's inner circle to a potential serial killer traveling the country before they discover that the real killer is right under their noses.
- **Sea of Hate Premieres Thursday, June 30 at 10 PM** Port Hueneme, Cal., is a sleepy hamlet, so when hard-working mother Norma Rodriguez is found dead in her home, it sends shockwaves through the tiny seaside town. The local police department tries to calm concerns, but when two more murders take place that summer, the community is crippled with fear. Rumors of a serial killer run rampant, but it will take a capricious witness and 10 years to finally bring justice to all three crimes.

- **'Til Death Us Do Part Premieres Thursday, June 30 at 9 PM** After two decades of abuse, Deborah Brown flees her husband Steven's violent temper to live with her brother Don Wood and his friend Chris Brouillard. Her newfound safety is soon shattered when a woman claims that her car broke down and lures Don and Chris to the road, where a vengeful Steven waits to kill them. Deborah hears a knock on the door and comes face to face with her estranged husband and his accomplice Patricia Teeter. They kidnap Deborah to a motel and brutalize her, forcing a SWAT team to intervene before it's too late.

Convicted on two counts of second-degree murder, she has been a model prisoner for twenty years but was denied parole for not showing sufficient remorse. New Episodes Premiere Tuesdays at 10 PM

For these perpetrators, the stories may be different, but the motives are always the same – to stay out of prison and live life on the lam. The people profiled in I (ALMOST) GOT AWAY WITH IT evaded justice for years, sometimes decades, by using their families, fake identification and even violence to avoid capture. Viewers learn how law enforcement uses all means necessary to capture these fugitives. Additionally, each episode features an interview from prison with these slick culprits, who spill where they found shelter, how they changed their identities and how they *almost* got away with it.

- **Got to Run with My Buddy Premieres Tuesday, June 7 at 10 PM** In 2008, Larry McClendon escapes a New Mexico jail after being locked up for killing a storeowner. He and co-escapee Michael England collect supplies from a family's house, but are forced to hide in a backyard pigpen when police arrive. As newspapers report on the escape, McClendon cross-dresses to evade capture. England's family is questioned and gives up important clues to the inmates' whereabouts, making it only a matter of time before the cops pick up on McClendon's scent.
- **Got Caught in a Love Triangle Premieres Tuesday, June 14 at 10 PM** Henry Lee Marshall was never a violent man, until he fell madly in love with Martha Leathers. Too bad she's married. The obsessed Marshall stalks her, threatens the couple with violence, blows up their cars, and ultimately kills Martha's husband. Marshall goes on the run, successfully evading the law for nine years, but never forgets about Martha. Petty crimes and a shoe-shining business keep him afloat, until one day he is caught in broad daylight by Martha herself.
- **Got a Boyfriend to Support Premieres Tuesday, June 21 at 10 PM** Steven Russell, otherwise known as "Houdini" or "King Con," escapes from a Houston jail and fakes credentials to obtain a job. After embezzling thousands from the company, he is imprisoned for fraud and soon meets fellow inmate Phillip Morris. The two become lovers, and when they are separated, Russell stops at nothing to be reunited. He impersonates a judge and even fakes having AIDS. Once out of prison, the couple lives a lavish lifestyle until the FBI closes in on Russell's latest cons.
- **Got to Impersonate a Guard Premieres Tuesday, June 28 at 10 PM** Dennis Hope works at grocery store, abusing his privileges to study the security guard who collects cash from the store each day. Finally, he puts a plan into action and robs multiple stores, but is caught and sentenced to 80 years in prison. Fearing for his safety, Hope believes his only option is to escape. He spends the next two months on a crime spree, until the cops convince his girlfriend to help capture Hope and put him back behind bars.

Miraculously, she lives and even regains her voice, but the predator, Dennis Bradford, remains at large for almost 20 years. - **Baby Grace Premieres Friday, June 17 at 10 PM** In 2007, the body of an unidentified toddler is found in a storage container in Galveston, TX. Investigators are stumped, and call in the FBI on a case that garners international attention. Hundreds wonder if the pretty blonde is their missing child, but one family will bear the burden of discovering that the child known in headlines as “Baby Grace” is actually their child, Riley Ann Sawyers, and she died at the hands of her parents.
- **Sex & Candy Premieres Friday, June 24 at 10 PM** After a date night in 2003 with his wife, Inga, Brian Wilson wakes up to find that she’s nowhere to be found. The suburban Washington, DC, mother has supposedly run to the store to buy some candy, but no one sees her again until she turns up dead 15 miles from home. The FBI uncovers shocking secrets as they look behind the perfect family façade and discover what really took place behind closed doors.

Investigators followed a trail of money and phone records that led them to Eric Buzbee, a well-known community figure in a family that had lived there for generations and owned a great deal of the land. After two long years, Buzbee was put on trial, but the verdict left the community wondering if the right person was charged with Wilson’s murder.
- **Under Suspicion Premieres Sunday, June 12 at 10 PM** Jami Sherer was a beautiful young wife and mother with a promising career at Microsoft. In September 1990, she called her mother to say she was on her way for a visit but never arrived. With no body or evidence to suggest a crime had taken place, police hit a wall in their search for answers. It wasn’t until years later, when a team of cold case investigators began digging through old files, that prosecutors agreed to treat Sherer’s disappearance as a homicide. Would her killer ever be brought to justice?
- **A Mother’s Nightmare Premieres Sunday, June 19 at 10 PM** Ten-year-old Joel Kirkpatrick was murdered in his own bed. Police suspected his mother, Julie, after she reported seeing a mysterious intruder vanish in the night, and an author writing a book on the case seemed to have uncovered an important lead. Yet Kirkpatrick’s murder remained unsolved for another decade while police dealt with painful accusations, a confession and lingering doubts about whether justice would ever be served.
- **A Murder at Loose Chippings Premieres Sunday, June 26 at 10 PM** The Haysoms were a worldly and wealthy couple who had just retired to the peaceful Virginia countryside when they were murdered inside the stately home known as Loose Chippings. Investigators believed the killings could have been a robbery gone wrong and later considered the possibility that Satanists were involved. As they dug deeper into the double murder, a brilliant globe-trotting couple confessed to the crime, but evidence showed that only one of them was telling the truth.
