That's when investigators discover that during all this time, Zarzycki's young friends had been keeping valuable information from police – information that leads police to Art Ream, a man with a long rap sheet of molesting teen girls. Ream is arrested for murder, and without confessing to killing Cindy Zarzycki, Ream tells police where her body was buried so that the Zarzycki family can finally bury their daughter. A man named Todd Alan Reed takes the bait, and when police run his background, they find a prior conviction for rape. I (ALMOST) GOT AWAY WITH IT TV-14

Season 2 Premieres Tuesday, October 26 at 10 PM (ET)

For these perpetrators, the stories may be different, but the motives are always the same – to stay out of prison and live life on the lam. The people profiled in **I** (**ALMOST**) **GOT AWAY WITH IT** evaded justice for years, sometimes decades, by using their families, fake identification and even violence to avoid capture. Viewers learn how law enforcement uses all means necessary to capture these fugitives. Additionally, each episode features an interview from prison with these slick culprits, who spill where they found shelter, how they changed their identities and how they almost got away with it.

FINAL JUDGMENT**TV-14 (V)

Documentary Makes Its Television Debut on Premieres Friday, October 8 at 10 PM

Roger Weisberg and Vanessa Roth's riveting film, *No Tomorrow*, makes its world television debut on ID under the title **FINAL JUDGMENT**. Exploring the role of media in the criminal justice system, this documentary provides commentary on the use of the death penalty. In 2005, Weisberg and Roth created *Aging Out*, which explored what happens to teenagers after leaving the foster care system. Tragically, it also became a chronicle of the last year of the life of one of its central characters, Risa Bejarano, who was murdered shortly after the film was released. This follow-up film looks at how the original documentary unexpectedly became the centerpiece of a dramatic trial in Judge Lance Ito's courtroom that would determine whether the alleged killer would live or die.

HUNT FOR THE MAD TRAPPER TV-14

A literal "cold case," **HUNT FOR THE MAD TRAPPER** tells the tale of an arctic CSI team. This team, consisting of world-class forensics investigators, travel to the Canadian Arctic to exhume the remains of the legendary fugitive, the "Mad Trapper," whose actions sparked a huge manhunt in Northern Canada. If they can recover the fugitive's DNA, they hope to solve the identity of the mysterious man who shot three Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) officers more than 75 years earlier.
