Season 1 Premieres Friday, February 3 at 10 and 10:30 PM ET

Season 1 Moves to New Timeslot Friday, February 24 at 8 and 8:30 PM ET

Each episode of KILLER TRIALS: JUDGMENT DAY revisits an infamous trial that captured the attention of media, concerned citizens and curious onlookers everywhere. This compelling series takes you behind courthouse doors to hear from the people who witnessed each trial's grisly confessions, secret circumstantial evidence and enlightening witness testimony firsthand.

- **The Railroad Killer Premieres Friday, February 3 at 10 PM ET** In August 1997, university students Holly Dunn and Chris Maier are attacked while taking a short cut home along railway tracks. Maier is bludgeoned to death. Dunn is raped, brutally beaten and left for dead. Amazingly, she survives and vows to bring her attacker to justice. The police investigation leads to Angel Maturino Reséndiz, an itinerant Mexican, and when eight more victims are found, Reséndiz makes the FBI's Top Ten Most Wanted list. Then, the police make a critical break when Reséndiz actually turns himself in. It is a trial that would build to an extraordinary confrontation between the killer and Dunn, his only surviving victim, as she bravely tells the jury every detail of her ordeal and identifies the Railroad Killer. *Location: Lexington, KY*
- **Lesbian Vampire Killers Premieres Friday, February 3 at 10:30 PM ET** In October 1989, Tracey Wigginton, her lesbian lover, Lisa Ptaschinski, and another couple lure a drunk, 47-year-old Edward Baldock into their car before driving him to a park on the banks of the Brisbane River. With the promise of showing him "a good time", Wigginton stabs Baldock fifteen times in an attack so brutal it practically severs off his head. But Wigginton makes a crucial mistake when she leaves her credit card at the crime scene. She is quickly arrested and convicted of murder, and

then the attention turns to her friends. Are they deranged vampires or willing accomplices?

Location: Brisbane, Australia

- **Upstate Ax Man Premieres Friday, February 10 at 10 PM ET** Joan Porco suffers severe head and facial trauma when she is viciously attacked with an ax in her own home. Her husband, Peter, is murdered and she identifies her son, Christopher, as her attacker. Christopher is arrested and indicted for the crimes, but when Joan comes out of a coma, she refuses to testify against her son. In fact, two years after the attacks, Joan walks into the courtroom arm in arm with Christopher, only adding to the drama of one of the most famous murders in New York state. *Location: Delmar, NY*
- **The Trusted Neighbor Premieres Friday, February 10 at 10:30PM ET** In January 2002, 12-year-old Ashley Pond disappears on her way to school. Exactly two months later, her friend and classmate, Miranda Gaddis, also goes missing. A major hunt for the girls is launched, but the search produces no leads, no suspects and no trace of the girls. Then the case takes a bizarre turn when neighbor and family friend, Ward Weaver III, tells a local paper that he is the FBI's prime suspect. At the same time he denies having anything to do with the crime. But Weaver has a history of violence and sexual abuse towards women, and eight months after the girls' disappearance, he is caught trying to flee town after violently assaulting his son's girlfriend. Now, with the break they've been waiting for, police search Weaver's house only to find Gaddis' body in a storage shed and Pond's body buried beneath a concrete slab in the backyard. Will Weaver ever admit to taking these innocent girls' lives? *Location: Portland, OR*
- **Deadly Harvest Premieres Friday, February 17 at 10PM ET** Ray and Faye Copeland run a farm in Missouri, and in 1989, one of their farm hands makes an anonymous call to the police fearing for his life. He claims 76-year-old Ray has pointed a gun at him and he says he's seen human remains on the farm. Police start investigating Ray and suspect he is hiring transients to buy cattle for him with bad checks and then killing the drifters once they outlast their usefulness. But to prove their theory, the police must find bodies. They embark on an exhaustive search throughout the Copeland's farm and eventually five bodies turn up. At her trial, 69-year-old Faye denies any knowledge of her husband's scams, but investigators believe she is involved. Faye refuses to testify against her husband in what turns out to be an historic case. *Location: Missouri*
- **Do No Harm Premieres Friday, February 17 at 10:30PM ET** When Kathleen Grundy dies unexpectedly, her daughter, Angela Woodruff, is convinced that Dr. Harold Shipman is at fault. Prior to Grundy's death, she changed her will and left all her money to Shipman. Woodruff suspects this will is a forgery, and persuades police to exhume her mother's body. Tests reveal that Grundy had received an enormous hit of morphine immediately prior to her death, and records from a local pharmacy show that Shipman has been stockpiling huge quantities of the potentially lethal drug. This revelation coupled with further investigation leads police to charge the family doctor with murdering fifteen of his former elderly patients. Shipman pleads not guilty to all charges, but this is just the beginning as a public enquiry into Shipman concludes that the final death toll is in fact significantly greater. *Location: Preston, England*
- **The Real Victims Premieres Friday, February 24 at 8 PM ET** In October 1994, distraught mother, Susan Smith appears on local TV and radio with her husband to appeal for the safe return of their two missing sons. Smith claims the children have been abducted by a carjacker. The police, the public and the press join a county-wide search for the missing boys, but the police are suspicious of Smith's account of events. Nine days later, Smith confesses she knows where her children are: at the bottom of a nearby lake. Upon strapping her children into their car seats, she drove her car into the lake and let her children drown. The only question at her trial is should she get the death penalty or are there mitigating circumstances which explain her horrific crime? *Location: Union City, SC*
- **The Killer Next Door Premieres Friday, February 24 at 8:30 PM ET** When 13-year-old Graeme Cunningham goes missing in July 1983, his panicked mother, Shona, calls the police. After several dead ends, Detective Don Bell comes across Arthur Bishop, whose so-called stepson is a close friend of Graeme's. During questioning, Bishop unexpectedly reveals that he killed Graeme and four other missing boys, then proceeds to lead police to the desert and the graves of his victims. The trial begins in March 1984, but prosecutors must prove these murders were calculated and committed by a sane man. Convincing a jury that Utah's most notorious

killer of the twentieth century is mentally competent may prove more difficult than originally imagined. *Location: Salt Lake City, UT*

Each one-hour episode showcases some of the most baffling and challenging cases in contemporary law enforcement, and commends the unwavering investigations that led to the arrest of these unlikely culprits. - **The Perfect Family Premieres Sunday, February 26 at 10 PM ET** In May 2007, the quiet neighborhood of Manheim Township, PA is rocked to its core by a gruesome triple homicide. Tom and Lisa Haines, and their 16-year-old son Kevin, have been brutally stabbed to death in the middle of the night. Only 20 year-old daughter, Maggie, escapes unharmed. To all who knew them, the Haines were the perfect family. Who could possibly want them dead? With little to go on, investigators pull back the layers of the Haines' lives in hopes of finding their killer. Is it possible that survivor Maggie knows more than she is letting on? - **The Art of Murder Premieres Sunday, February 12 at 10 PM ET** When police discover art student Samantha "Shelley" Nance stabbed to death in her own bed, they immediately treat the murder as an act of jealousy and rage. Investigators find no signs of forced entry, but there is evidence the killer has tried to clean up after the crime. As they close in on a suspect they uncover a bizarre love triangle that is at the heart of the murder. *Location: Dallas, TX*

The store is found in disarray and cash has been stolen. But as they look at the evidence more closely, surveillance video, two sets of bloody footprints, and remarkable police work prove the plot behind Murray's murder is far more sinister than ever imagined. *Location: Bethesda, MD*

Pulling back the curtain on bizarre double lives, WHO THE (BLEEP) DID I MARRY? examines stories of couples in which one spouse has hidden a shocking secret. From bank robbers to bigamists and international spies, these sometimes shocking characters will have viewers shaking their heads in disbelief and wondering how the truths behind these scandalous spouses were kept hidden for so long.

- **Gold Digging Grandma Premieres Saturday, February 4 at 9PM ET** Elden Bowen wanted to share the rest of his life with a good woman, and sweet, petite Shirley Cassara seemed to fit the bill. Both had been married previously, but were looking forward to spending their golden years together. About four months into their marriage, Cassara pushed to have her name added to Bowen's property deeds and bank accounts and sought power-of-attorney privileges. Bowen agreed, but shortly after making the changes, Cassara became more distant and illusive. Two

years later, an unwitting victim of Cassara's fraudulent claims, Bowen finally came face to face with the real Shirley - a woman who wanted much more than his heart. *Location: Gloucester, VA*

- **The Weapon Inside Me Premieres Saturday, February 11 at 9 PM ET** After two marriages, Dallas native Diane Reeve warily re-entered the world of dating at the encouragement of friends. Through an online dating site, she met tall, dark and handsome Frenchman, Philippe Padiou, and was soon swept off her feet. The two began a passionate romance that evolved into an energetic relationship full of travel and adventure. But only a few years later, Reeve ended the relationship when she learned of Padiou's sexual indiscretions. A routine medical exam revealed that she had contracted HPV from Padiou, and after becoming uncharacteristically fatigued the following winter, she received a phone call with life-shattering news. Padiou had hidden much more from her than a few illicit affairs - his deadly deception would leave Reeve fighting for her life. *Location: Dallas, TX*

STOLEN VOICES, BURIED SECRETS ** TV-14

Investigation Discovery's captivating series STOLEN VOICES, BURIED SECRETS revisits mysterious murders through the lens of the fictionalized, first-person perspectives of the victims. As investigators, family, and friends peel back the layers and facts of each case for viewers, the otherworldly narrator already knows how their story ends and supplies all-knowing observations hinting at breaks to come in the case.

- **Into the Wild Premieres Monday, February 6 at 10 PM ET** Steven Wood was a teacher, an avid outdoorsman, and a loving father living in Yucaipa, CA. But when he went missing and his truck was found abandoned on the side of the road, rumors started to surface about a man suffering from depression who may have fell victim to a satanic cult. The case went cold until police apprehended a young runaway who told the tragic story of a man that met his end while trying to do the right thing. *Location: Yucaipa, CA*
- **Twisted Love Premieres Monday, February 13 at 10 PM ET** Laura Salmon was Little Miss Murfreesboro. A 17-year-old hometown crowd-pleaser who loved performing for people, Salmon was always smiling. So when one day she went for an afternoon drive up into the Tennessee countryside and didn't come back, police immediately suspected foul play. Salmon's body was found in the middle of a field, near a quarry, far from any potential witnesses. It eventually took investigators more than 16 years to find out who was Laura's last audience. *Location: Murfreesboro, TN*
- **Fatal Crossroads Premieres Monday, February 20 at 10 PM ET** Ron Whitehead was a hard-working father who happily provided for his family in the suburbs of Seattle. Looking forward to retirement, he never anticipated how violently his life would be cut short. On an early spring morning in 2005, 61-year-old Whitehead's body was found shot dead at an intersection a few miles away from his home. A year passed by and the killer still walked free until a stroke of luck broke the case. What originally appeared to be a carjacking gone wrong, in the end, turned out to be no accident at all. *Location: Des Moines, WA*
- **Man Down Premieres Monday, February 27 at 10 PM ET** Robert Lustig lived a quiet life in a small New Mexican community. As a volunteer firefighter and police officer, he spent his days helping people. So when Robert failed to call his mother on her birthday, his family knew something was wrong. A year went by without any sign of Lustig when his body was found inside a junkyard refrigerator. A search for his killer led investigators in an unexpected direction as they began to wonder if it was possible that Lustig was killed by friendly fire. *Location: Deming, NM*

ONGOING SERIES

DARK MINDS ** TV-14

Season 1 Continues Wednesdays at 10 PM ET

In DARK MINDS, crime author M. William Phelps and criminal profiler John Kelly revisit unsolved homicides believed to be the work of serial killers. Joining them in the hunt for answers is an unlikely and

anonymous source: a convict serving multiple life sentences for a series of murders. Known only to audiences as “13,” this unique source offers his “expert” opinion about potential motivations behind these chilling cold cases, using his own personal experience to formulate theories.

- **The Eastbound Strangler Premieres Wednesday, February 1 at 10 PM ET** In November 2006, the bodies of four women were discovered in a drainage ditch behind a row of hotels, on the edge of Atlantic City. After years of intense investigation, law enforcement remains baffled by the fact that the victims’ shoes were missing, and that their heads were all pointing east. Three of the women were known prostitutes, so the police wonder whether the killer has a cross to bear against fallen women. Is there a religious basis for the eastward positioning of the bodies? And are the later murders of four prostitutes in Long Island connected? Investigative journalist M. William Phelps and profiler John Kelly will need to call on the personal insight of convicted serial killer “13” to get inside the dark mind of the murderer now known as The Eastbound Strangler. *Location: Atlantic City, NJ*
- **The Babysitter Killer Premieres Wednesday, February 8 at 10 PM ET** In the 1970s, the affluent Detroit suburbs were almost idyllic. Children played in the streets with their friends, and stayed out until the streetlights went on. It was the perfect picture of childhood until a predator struck, shattering that innocence forever. Between 1976 and 1977, four children were abducted, sexually assaulted and murdered. Each child was held captive from four to 19 days, and their bodies were found freshly bathed, their nails scrubbed clean, and their clothing laundered and pressed. The murderer soon becomes known as The Babysitter Killer. For investigative journalist M. William Phelps, the torture and slaying of these children is unbearable. Phelps and profiler John Kelly go on a wild ride as they put together an unusual profile, uncovering a darker side of suburbia, as startling details and new persons of interest come to light. And convicted killer, code-named 13, has unique insight into the mind of this murderer, and definite ideas about what kind of madman would prey upon innocent children. *Location: Detroit, MI*
- **The Woodsman Premieres Wednesday, February 15 at 10 PM ET** On the streets of Main South in Worcester, Massachusetts the working girls are no strangers to danger. But between 2003 and 2007, that danger hits a whole new level. Five young women went missing and their skeletal remains were discovered shortly thereafter in woods outside the city. The victims are all young mothers caught up in drugs and prostitution. They also happen to be petite, dark-haired and dark-skinned. It appears that newly nicknamed Woodsman has a type, but investigators wonder why. Extremely reminiscent of his own sister-in-law’s murder, this case is personal for investigative journalist M. William Phelps. Thankfully, there is hope for justice, because profiler John Kelly has a strong person of interest, and “13” happens to have a unique insight into this particular killer’s mind. *Location: Worcester, MA*
- **Double Initial Murder Premieres Wednesday, February 22 at 10 PM ET** Rochester, NY is the picture of innocence. An old mill town surrounded by lakes and forests, it’s a wonderful place for children to grow up. That was, until three little girls were taken from their neighborhood streets between 1971 and 1973, raped and strangled, then tossed away on the side of the road. Beyond their terrible fate, the victims shared something else. Each of their first and last names started with the same letter along with the town in which they were found. Now, 40 years later, investigative journalist M. William Phelps searches for new answers to the “Alphabet Murders.” All roads seem to lead nowhere, so he and criminal profiler John Kelly rely on their secret contact, “13,” who has his own reasons for taking this so personally. *Location: Rochester, NY*
- **The Jefferson Davis Parish Murders Premieres Wednesday, February 29 at 10 PM ET** Between 2006 and 2009, eight girls from the “wrong side of the tracks” were killed and dumped on the lonely back roads of Jefferson Davis Parish. While all the victims were high when they died and many hung out at the same party house on the seamy side of town, they were different races, and were all killed in different sadistic ways. Townspeople were suspicious of the cops, accusing them of corruption, so in the absence of an arrest, rumors and conspiracies ruled the day. Whoever killed them was never caught, meaning that any day another innocent girl could become the ninth victim of The Jefferson Davis Parish Murders. Born and bred Yankee M. William Phelps is a fish out of water in the Deep South, so he turns to master profiler John Kelly and his murderer on the inside to help break the case that is as murky as a Louisiana bayou. *Location: Jennings, LA*

SCORNED: LOVE KILLS ** TV-14

Season 1 Continues Saturdays at 10 PM ET

Investigation Discovery's SCORNED: LOVE KILLS uncovers crimes of passion sparked by a spurned lover's snap from provocative paramour to predacious threat. The show examines the dark side of love with a voyeuristic peek into the lust and obsession that fueled some of the most senseless, but definitely not emotionless, crimes to make front-page headlines. From dalliances with X-rated dancers to a love triangle born from an underground swingers' club, the stories featured in SCORNED pair sexual intrigue with bedded betrayal to form a recipe for murder.

- **Desperate Housewife Premieres Saturday, February 4 at 10 PM ET** Renee Poole and her high school sweetheart, Brent, were a young family settling into their own home. Brent showed much career promise as a highly-trained mechanic, providing a comfortable life for his wife and young daughter. Renee, however, quickly tired of the house-wife routine. She craved adventure and attention, so when a friend offered her a chance to dance at the local gentleman's club, she jumped on the opportunity. Renee's new employment offered her more than just money. She also acquired a number of lovers, who she brought home with her while Brent was at work. One of these lovers becomes something more. When Brent found out in 1998, he asked Renee to stop seeing the other man. Instead, Brent was gunned down on his wedding anniversary. *Location: Winston-Salem, NC*
- **Hot For Teacher Premieres Saturday, February 11 at 10 PM ET** Pamela Smart loved good times, rock music and, most of all, her new husband Gregg. But after moving to a sleepy New Hampshire town, Gregg cut his rocker hair and began work as an insurance salesman, a job Pam thought was uncool. She found solace in a group of teenage students at the school where she worked. One in particular caught her eye, 15-year-old Billy Flynn. Flaunting her sex appeal, Pam seduced Billy and then poisoned his impressionable mind with stories of her disappointing marriage. The schoolteacher had one thing in mind: convincing her pupil to murder Gregg. Pam pulled all the strings, instructing Billy and his accomplices to stage a burglary as cover, but they mustn't hurt her beloved pooch or get any blood on the couch. In 1990, six days before their first wedding anniversary, Pam returned home to discover the corpse of her college sweetheart shot in the head. *Location: Derry, NH*
- **Afternoon Delight Premieres Saturday, February 18 at 10 PM ET** Dan and Trish Willoughby have the family of their dreams. But things begin to unravel as Dan enters a midlife crisis and enters into a torrid affair. When Trish gets wind of the affair, Dan must choose between his wife and mistress or risk losing them both. In an attempt to reconcile with Trish, Dan plans a family vacation. Dan and the children go sight-seeing while Trish rests. Upon returning from their outing, the children discover Trish severely beaten and bloodied with a knife protruding from her head. The investigation uncovers a lust-fueled affair, a cold-blooded murder and someone who isn't as they seem. *Locations: Puerto Penasco, Mexico and Phoenix, AZ*
- **The Showgirl and the Salesman Premieres Saturday, February 25 at 10 PM ET** In the spring of 1995, Jay Orbin and his former teenage sweetheart, Marjorie, reconnect after years apart. They get married and settle down, but after a while, Marjorie becomes restless. As Marjorie seeks solace in a string of illicit affairs, Jay is increasingly pushed to the sidelines. Family and friends are suspicious and their worst fears are realized when Jay fails to return from a business trip. Police investigate but have little to go on until Jay's brutally dismembered torso is discovered on the outskirts of Phoenix. As cops dig deeper, they discover that Marjorie knows much more than she's letting on. *Location: Phoenix, AZ*

STALKED: SOMEONE'S WATCHING ** TV-14

Season 2 Continues Thursdays at 10 PM ET

With more than three million people falling victim to stalking in the United States each year, this widely misunderstood crime reaches far beyond celebrities and people in the public eye. STALKED: SOMEONE'S WATCHING profiles emotional stories of stalking victims and explores the twisted psychology of the people who relentlessly pursued them. Leading viewers through these tales of obsession is Michelle Ward, Ph.D., a criminal psychologist who has an expertise in neuroscience and personal experience as a stalking victim. Throughout each episode, Dr. Ward provides insight into the possible thoughts and motivations of the stalker and offers viewers important information they can use to protect themselves.

- **Above the Law Premieres Thursday, February 2 at 10:00 PM ET** Vicki Kuper, a divorced mother of four, moves to the small town of Delhi, Iowa. She soon meets 35 year-old Jack Tanner on a weekend camping trip, and sparks fly. He is sweet, charming, and well known around town, but Tanner's jealous tendencies soon surface. Kuper tries to break off the relationship, but can't get away from his controlling grasp. When she goes to the authorities, it becomes clear the whole town has ties to Tanner. Can Kuper escape her stalker in this tiny, secluded town? Dr. Michelle Ward reveals what happens when this idyllic community turns out to be a small town nightmare. *Location: Delhi, IA*
- **Off the Deep End Premieres Thursday, February 9 at 10:00 PM ET** Sheila Taormina is an Olympic gold medalist and tri-athlete at the height of her career. When fellow athlete, Reuben Barrett, calls to hire her as a trainer, she's happy to help. But Taormina quickly learns that Barrett's intentions are romantic, not athletic. She tells him she's not interested, but he won't take no for an answer. When Barrett begins to show up at her meets around the country, Taormina begins to fear for her life. She is assigned a security detail, but even they can't keep Barrett away. Join Dr. Michelle Ward as she finds out what happens when one fan's admiration turns into never-ending obsession. *Location: Livonia, MI*
- **Web of Destruction Premieres Thursday, February 16 at 10:00 PM ET** Mai Hlee Xiong is an outgoing graphic/web designer, and in 2007, competes in a Michigan beauty pageant. With thousands attending, Xiong has no idea that one audience member is watching her closely. That is, until a flood of cyber stalking threats puts her personal and professional life on the line. Protected by the ambiguity of the internet, Xiong's stalker remains nameless. Will Xiong learn her stalkers identity and pick up the shattered pieces of her public image? Follow Dr. Michelle Ward as she finds out what happens when one man's fixation is unleashed into cyber space. *Location: Macomb, MI*
- **Kiss of Death Premieres Thursday, February 23 at 10:00 PM ET** As a limo driver in Las Vegas, Lee Redmond is exposed to both the glamour and the gruffness of Sin City. When he befriends Nicole Thornton, a stripper with no family, he believes he's helping someone in need. But instead, he is setting himself down a path that will destroy his family and threaten his life. How far will Thornton go to make Redmond hers forever? Join Dr. Michelle Ward as she explores what happens when a simple crush meets a deadly end. *Location: Las Vegas, NV*

Season 4 Continues Mondays at 9 PM ET

Each episode of DISAPPEARED begins at the time immediately before the individual vanished, and chronicles the search for clues hidden beneath seemingly everyday behavior that may indicate what happened to the missing. While some of the resolutions are heartwarming and others tragic, many cases remain open to this day and continue to be a source of unbearable frustration for the loved ones left behind. For the open cases that have gone cold, DISAPPEARED asks viewers to share any fresh leads in hopes of deciphering what truly happened to the missing.

- **Daddy's Girl Premieres Monday, February 6 at 9 PM ET** When 19-year-old Danice Day doesn't show up for work and can't be found at home caring for her two young children, her father panics. Knowing that Day recently beat a drug addiction and was starting to regain control of her life, friends and family are shocked by her disappearance and begin an aggressive search. However, the formal investigation is less inspiring as signs of small town connections seem to be working to the possible suspect's advantage and outlandish comments made by the sheriff appear to compromise the case. Then just when family members start to give up hope, a new sheriff takes office, renewing their faith that one day they will have answers. *Location: Monte Vista, CO*
- **Last Call Premieres Monday, February 13 at 9 PM ET** Thirty-four-year-old Allison Jackson-Foy has recently moved from Long Island to North Carolina with her husband and two daughters. She has left behind friends and family in hopes that a new beginning will mend her already turbulent marriage, but the move only makes matters worse. Jackson-Foy turns to prescription drugs to help her cope, but just as she seems to be hitting rock bottom, she gets a new job. Excited to celebrate, she and a friend meet at their favorite bar. With last call nearing, Jackson-Foy walks out the front door and is never seen or heard from again. A family's nightmare begins, but their determination could possibly help investigators unravel the case. *Location: Wilmington, NC*

- **Hometown Hero Premieres Monday, February 20 at 9 PM ET** Local police know Margaret Haddican McEnroe as a hero firefighter, with a fiery temper but strong maternal instincts. So when she disappears from her home, leaving behind her infant daughter alone in her crib, authorities, friends and family are all baffled. How could this loving mother vanish without a trace? It seems unlikely the feisty Army veteran was abducted by a stranger, so the investigation focuses on people she knows. Finally, the FBI is called in and the focus of suspicion narrows down to someone that McEnroe knows very well indeed. *Location: Warren Township, NJ*
- **A Soldier's Story Premieres Monday, February 27 at 9 PM ET** In August 2010, Noah Pippin, a 31-year-old ex-marine leaves his parents' home in Lake Ann, Michigan headed west to report for drills with the California National Guard. But Pippin never shows up. Investigators pick up a trail that leads them far from California and into the heart of some of the harshest wilderness in the U.S. As time passes and the clues in Pippin's case grow more ominous, his parents can only wonder what's driving their son deeper into the unknown. *Location: Glacier National Park, MT*

SINS & SECRETS TV-14

Season 2 Continues Thursdays at 9 PM ET

In SINS & SECRETS, the location of the crime is a central character in each case. Each immersive one-hour episode shows how a crime alters the community in which it occurs, and reveals how the people and place are irrevocably changed by the terrible aftermath.

- **Tampa Premieres Thursday, February 2 at 9 PM ET** Tampa, FL, is a gulf-coast metropolis with an electric nightlife. But the party came to a sudden halt when bartender Sandee Rozzo was gunned down in her garage. During their investigation, police learned Rozzo was about to testify that ex-boyfriend Tracey Humphrey had sexually assaulted her for over 10 years. So police asked one of Humphrey's clients to wear a wire, and discovered his wife Ashley had really pulled the trigger. Eventually, Ashley pled guilty to second-degree murder in exchange for testimony against her husband that would send him away for life. *Location: Tampa, FL*
- **Cleveland Premieres Thursday, February 9 at 9 PM ET** Cleveland, OH, is a fallen industrial center in the midst of a rock revival, but in 2005, the city's comeback would be derailed by a dark and sinister mystery. Local resident Rose Marie Essa unexpectedly died after a seemingly minor fender bender, and doctors and police were left perplexed as the 38-year-old didn't have a scratch on her. According to her physician husband, Dr. Yazeed Essa, Rose Marie had been the image of health. An initial autopsy failed to uncover the cause of her death, but an investigation soon uncovered some troubling truths about the Essa's marriage, and evidence that suggested Rosie's death was no accident at all. *Location: Cleveland, OH*
- **Key West Premieres Thursday, February 16 at 9 PM ET** Key West, FL, is a shabby island considered home by anyone looking to relax, party, or disappear. But this island paradise turned into a nightmare when beloved 63-year-old botanist Rodger Keller, was found dead in his home. The crime scene pointed to a botched armed robbery, until detectives unearthed some shocking clues. A scandalous set of nude photos and financial information suggested that a former tenant, and possible gay lover of Keller's named Johnny Ray Holt, had bled Keller's bank account of nearly \$10,000 before killing him in cold blood. *Location: Key West, FL*
- **Newry Premieres Thursday, February 23 at 9 PM ET** Newry, ME, is a postcard of a village nestled in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. In 2003, 65-year-old Julie Bullard fulfilled a dream by moving to Maine from San Francisco and opening the Black Bear Inn. Her daughter Selby soon followed her across the country, both women eager for the chance to return to a simpler way of life. That dream was shattered less than three years later, when the police discovered their mutilated bodies in a woodpile behind Bullard's Inn, uncovering the dark side of this seemingly tranquil town. *Location: Newry, ME*

NIGHTMARE NEXT DOOR ** TV-14

Season 2 Continues Sundays at 9 PM ET

How well do you know your neighbors? NIGHTMARE NEXT DOOR tells the tales of mysterious murders from behind white picket fences that rocked Middle America. Each hour bring a new murder mystery and a new look into the evil that can lurk in the heart and soul of a tight-knit community. Interviews with investigators, prosecutors, family members and/or neighbors piece together the twisting tale of a classic whodunit, and forensic experiments lead viewers into the heart of the investigation.

- **The Lady Killer Premieres Sunday, February 12 at 9 PM ET** The Old Port section of Portland, Maine is known for its vibrant nightlife, and after a night out on the town in October 2001, 25-year-old Amy St. Laurent disappears without a trace. With no body to work from, the police don't know what to make of the case and St. Laurent's many suspicious male admirers. However, when investigators discover her body seven weeks later, St. Laurent's family finally has closure. Police focus in on a local playboy as the culprit, but when the suspect skips town, it's a race down south to bring a killer to justice. *Location: Portland, ME*
- **Deadly Disloyalty Premieres Sunday, February 19 at 9 PM ET** The quiet southern town of Navasota, Texas is far removed from the hustle and bustle of the big city. So residents are understandably shaken when murder comes calling on their peaceful community. A telling 911 call alerts police to the scene where 54 year-old Lonnie Turner, Sr., is found shot to death in his own home. As investigators hunt for the killer, their search narrows on the people closest to Turner. But when a disguise found near the scene points police in the right direction, they soon learn that's just the beginning of a sordid tale. *Location: Navasota, TX*
- **Road to Hell Premieres Sunday, February 26 at 9 PM ET** Summerfield, FL is known for its rich pastures and beautiful countryside, but the town's landscape is permanently soiled when longtime resident Debra Rawls is found murdered inside her own home. Police zero in on her husband, who has a long record of abuse. When the lead fails to materialize, investigators rely on a slew of tips from the community. A confession by an infamous town degenerate all but seals the case until police learn it's a charade. Ultimately, it is a drop of blood that unveils the true criminal behind Summerfield's most cryptic crime. *Location: Summerfield, FL*
