ID FILMS: MY BROTHER THE SERIAL KILLER **

Two-Hour Documentary Premieres Wednesday, November 21 at 9 PM ET

Clay Rogers' kid brother isn't like most siblings. Glen Rogers is a convicted serial killer on Florida's death row, due to be executed by electric chair. In March 2010, Clay received a letter from Greg confessing to additional murders and admitting that he has written a secret memoir that details each horrific crime. In fact, Clay even claims that Glen spoke of a desire to kill Nicole Brown Simpson, O.J. Simpson's ex-wife, prior to her June 1994 murder. But Clay is determined to find the truth about his brother's murder spree and explain his actions, but nothing can reconcile his love for his baby brother with the knowledge of Glen's horrific crimes.

PREMIERES

I DIDN'T DO IT TV-14

All-New Original Series Premieres Monday, November 12 at 9 PM ET

I DIDN'T DO IT exposes the dark side of a system that imprisons thousands of innocent people, looking beyond the investigations to reveal the harrowing personal stories of wrongful conviction and long-awaited redemption. The untold story behind these gut-wrenching cases unfolds through reenactments and interviews, from wide-ranging points of view including those of the accused, investigating officers, jurors and prosecuting attorneys. Narrated by Chris Noth, each episode showcases the impact of wrongful convictions, with a ripple effect that far exceeds the unjustly convicted person and their family. And throughout each episode, the desperate search is on for the real perpetrator behind the crime.

- Shadow of Doubt Premieres Monday, November 12 at 9 PM ET College student Jennifer

 Thompson wakes one night to find a rapist by her bed. During the brutal attack she vows to remember what he looks like, and after a daring escape she goes on to identify Ronald Cotton as her assailant. Cotton is given a life sentence for the assault, but he is innocent. And when he finds himself locked up with the real rapist, he must decide between a new campaign for freedom, or killing the man for whose crimes he's serving time. Location: Burlington, NC
- Twice Bitten *Premieres Monday, November 19 at 9 PM ET* When bartender <u>Kim Ancona</u> is found murdered in a bathroom, the investigation focuses on a bite mark found on her breast. Police quickly close in on Ancona's rumored boyfriend, <u>Ray Krone</u>, whose crooked teeth are

- soon deemed a match to the victim's wound. But Krone is innocent. Sentenced to death for a crime he didn't commit, his only hope lies in the efforts of a long lost cousin to uncover new evidence that will set him free. *Location: Phoenix, AZ*
- Smoking Gun *Premieres Monday, November 24 at 9 PM ET* In June 1998, 58-year-old <u>Judy Johnson</u> is raped and murdered in her home. Her 6-year-old granddaughter is also assaulted, but survives and is able to identify the attacker as someone who looks like her uncle. With those words, <u>Clarence Elkins</u> becomes doomed to spend his life behind bars, unless he and his family can prove that a man locked up with him in the same institution is the real perpetrator of the savagery he's been condemned for. *Location: Barberton, OH*

WIVES WITH KNIVES TV-14

All-New Series Premieres Friday, November 23 at 10 PM ET

WIVES WITH KNIVES features gripping stories of women who fight at close range. Some women endured years of sexual, emotional, and physical abuse before fighting back. Others were motivated by greed and jealousy. Some of the victims died and others lived to testify against their attackers. Through personal accounts from the actual women who committed the crimes, as well as the victims themselves, each episode reveals the traumatic events that led to the pair's disturbing demise.

- The Beefcake and the Beauty Queen Premieres Friday, November 23 at 10 PM ET Jamie and Charlie Czerniawski fall hard and fast for each other after meeting at a health club. They enjoy a seemingly lavish lifestyle and soon get married. But the honeymoon is over almost as quickly as it began. The good-looking couple begin to suspect each other of being unfaithful and the extreme jealousy and suspicion lead to intense arguments. When Charlie catches Jamie secretly calling another man, the couple begins to brawl in the kitchen, where Jamie grabs a knife and plunges it into Charlie's arm. She hits an artery and Charlie nearly loses his life, but not before Jamie is arrested. Location: Freehold, NJ
- Fourth Time's A Charm *Premieres Friday, November 30 at 10 PM ET* When single working mother <u>Donna Cobb</u> meets <u>Kevin Cobb</u>, she thinks she's found the man of her dreams. But when Kevin's personality changes from sweet to volatile due to drug abuse, Donna becomes the victim of his uncontrollable rage. One night, Kevin wakes Donna up by punching her in the face. In a fight for her life, Donna ends up stabbing Kevin to death and is arrested. She is later acquitted of all charges. *Location: New York City, NY*

FATAL VOWS TV-14

All-New Original Series Premieres Saturday, November 17 at 10 PM ET

When marriages fail, divorce can turn ugly and even deadly. What was once a passionate union becomes spite, greed, backstabbing, and betrayal. FATAL VOWS explores tumultuous, shocking, and high-stake divorces and the deadly murders linked to them. Guiding viewers through these passionate accounts of love gone wrong are Dr. Stacy Kaiser, a psychotherapist and relationship expert, and Dr. Brian Russell, a forensic psychologist and attorney. From husbands, wives, children, grandparents, mistresses and friends, divorce can lead even the most unthinkable people to commit murder.

- **Dead Silence** *Premieres Saturday, November 17 at 10 PM ET* Bob Klosterman is an ambitious naval helicopter pilot just back from Vietnam when he falls for Becky Coffield, a beautiful single mom. The two get married, and Klosterman is on his way to becoming Admiral and Coffield thrives as a Navy wife. But when Coffield becomes entangled in a Navy scandal, Klosterman's career hits a dead end. The retired sailor begins spending more time on the road and less time with his family. Then, one day Coffield gets a bizarre phone call from a strip club and uncovers that her husband has been leading a double life. When she confronts him, he threatens her with a gun. Within days she files for divorce, but before they can finalize the proceedings, two bullets end their relationship instead. *Location: Norfolk, VA*
- Blood and Wine *Premieres Saturday, November 24 at 10 PM ET* Nancy Dillard and Richard Lyon appear happily married, but behind closed doors, they are anything but. Following a separation, there's an infestation of fire ants at the family home and a mysterious gift left on the doorstep. Dillard doesn't know who left the bottle of wine, but she drinks it, and becomes

temporarily, but violently, ill. When Lyon comes back to the family home to treat the fire ant infestation, Dillard's health begins to decline. When she dies of mysterious causes, suspicion quickly falls on her estranged husband. But in court, the skeletons in the Dillard family closet are revealed and everyone realizes that things are not always as they seem. *Location: Dallas, TX*

DISAPPEARED ** TV-14

Season 5 Premieres Monday, November 19 at 10 PM ET

DISAPPEARED follows the unpredictable twists of missing person cases, tracking investigations aimed at solving how and why people simply vanish. While some of the resolutions are heartwarming and others tragic, many cases remain open to this day and continue to be a source of unbearable frustration for family members and friends. Each episode of DISAPPEARED begins from the time immediately before the individual vanished, searching for clues hidden beneath seemingly everyday behavior that may indicate whether or not the person left voluntarily. For the open cases that have gone cold, DISAPPEARED asks viewers to share fresh leads in hope of deciphering what truly happened to the missing and whether foul play may have been involved.

- Lost in the Dark *Premieres Monday, November 19 at 10 PM ET* When recent college graduate Mitrice Richardson exhibits uncharacteristic behavior at a well-known Malibu restaurant, she lands herself in jail. Thinking her daughter is safe, Richardson's mother waits until morning to bail her daughter out. But when dawn breaks, Latice Sutton learns that her daughter is gone, released into the night from the remote police station without a car, phone or wallet. With Richardson nowhere to be found, a controversial and heated battle for answers and justice begins. Then, multiple sightings 300 miles away in Las Vegas have family and authorities divided over the 25-year-old's whereabouts and whether she is alive or dead. Location: Malibu, CA
- The Soldier's Wife Premieres Monday, November 26 at 10 PM ET Besides paying the bills, caring for her son, and keeping up her grades, 21-year-old mother and college student Bethany Decker is also dealing with the stress and loneliness of having a spouse serving in Afghanistan. When her husband comes back on leave, he finds that in his absence, Decker has gotten pregnant by another man. The couple spends a week attempting to reconcile. But on the day Decker is supposed to drive her husband to the airport for his return flight to Afghanistan, she never shows up and no one has seen her since. Accusations fly at both the husband and the boyfriend, as police begin a frantic search into the mysterious disappearance of a young woman at the center of a love triangle. Location: Ashburn, VA

FACING EVIL WITH CANDICE DELONG ** TV-14

Season 3 Premieres Friday, November 23 at 8 PM ET

Retired FBI criminal profiler Candice DeLong goes behind prison walls to sit down with venomous vixens, including some of the actual femmes fatales who appeared on ID's DEADLY WOMEN. DeLong interprets these intimate interviews for audiences with help from an impressive repertoire of sleuthing skills that include trailing terrorists, going undercover within gangs and hunting for the infamous Unabomber.

- Stripped Bare *Premieres Friday, November 23 at 8 PM ET* When Melissa Vanover meets jewelry salesman Michael Nieman, she thinks she has found her knight in shining armor. Lavishing her with gifts and expensive outings, Nieman opens the 26-year-old up to a whole new world. But the champagne and diamonds are soon replaced with drugs, guns, and abuse. Then, one fateful day, Nieman is found shot dead in his own bed. With nearly a million dollars worth of cash, drugs and jewelry stolen, police initially suspect thieves. But when Vanover is unmasked as having pulled the trigger, it is only the beginning of her troubled story. *Location: Miami Township, OH*
- Friends 'Til the End *Premieres Friday, November 23 at 8:30 PM ET* Shirley Jo Phillips and Wilma Plaster were best friends. They bonded over a shared passion for country music and line dancing. But when Plaster suspects her fun loving friend of stealing, things turn sour. Weeks after being reported missing, police find Plaster's body parts scattered throughout the county. Despite her pleas of innocence, Phillips is convicted of her friend's murder. Twenty-three-years after the

- crime she remains adamant she didn't do it. Is this a case of an innocent woman wrongly convicted? Or she is she covering up the crime for someone else? *Location: Hollister, MO*
- Victim of Love *Premieres Friday, November 30 at 8 PM ET* Tyonne Palmer wanted the perfect family. A hard working nurse and mother of three, the 30-year-old divorcee thought she had it all with her new boyfriend, <u>Pastor Tracy Burleson</u> and his teenage son, <u>William Fuller</u>. They dream of starting a new life together, but the trouble is that Burleson is still married. So when the Pastor's wife turns up dead, all eyes are on the Pastor, his mistress and the teenage son. When the police come knocking, shocking secrets are revealed, and relationships are betrayed. Prosecutors say all three had the motive to kill. But who really did it? *Location: Houston, TX*

MOTIVES & MURDERS: CRACKING THE CASE ** TV-14

All-New Series Premieres Saturday, November 3 at 9 PM ET

MOTIVES & MURDERS: CRACKING THE CASE explores the emotional stories of those attempting to find closure in homicide investigations, from the victims' families to the dedicated police officers. Combining the thrill of mystery with the visceral experience of true-crime drama, this series presents competing versions of what may have happened and re-enacts the events from different perspectives as new evidence comes to light. Each episode follows along as those involved relentlessly search for the truth and follow the clues wherever they may lead.

- In Harms' Way *Premieres Saturday, November 3 at 9 PM ET* Family and friends are frantic when 42-year-old <u>Jeanine Harms</u> goes on a date and disappears into thin air. Puzzled by a lack of evidence or helpful witnesses, police desperately try to find a missing Persian rug from Harms' apartment. It will take years of microscopic forensic work to determine if either of the primary suspects are involved. The passing of time frustrates Harms' family leading her brother to take matters into his own hands. *Location: Los Gatos, CA*
- Web of Lies *Premieres Saturday, November 10 at 9 PM ET* Employees at a West Virginia security company are shocked when their boss, <u>Tod McQuaid</u>, radios in a bewildering SOS: he's been shot and left for dead in the Appalachian Mountains. When McQuaid can't be located, residents of the small town are in disbelief. Police soon uncover a number of people with a motive to kill including a jilted ex-lover, an overly ambitious girlfriend, and a troubled handyman with a murky past. Police struggle to untangle the complex web of lies that surround McQuaid's death. *Location: Lewisburg, WV*
- Relative Suspects *Premieres Saturday, November 17 at 9 PM ET* Barbara Lloyd is a 27-year-old married mother of two, and a well-known member of the Buffalo, N.Y., party scene. When Lloyd is found stabbed 16 times on her bedroom floor her jealous husband and her sexually aggressive brother-in-law are the prime suspects. But police can't find any hard evidence against either of them and the case goes cold. More than 30 years later Lloyd's adult children convince detectives to reopen the case. Can science now add the missing piece to the puzzle of their mother's brutal murder? *Locaiton: Buffalo, NY*
- Body in the Bay *Premieres Saturday, November 24 at 9 PM ET* When Nancy Manni's body is found floating in the Chesapeake Bay the Maryland Natural Resources Police catch the case. Detective Dennis Leland worries that the 23-year-old free spirit may have gotten on the wrong boat with the wrong guy. Of two former boyfriends, one is known to have a violent streak and the other is rumored to have threatened Manni with death. But without any hard evidence, Leland can't connect the dots. Four years later, Manni's homicide is featured on "Unsolved Mysteries," and of the millions watching, one person knows the truth. *Location: Calvert County, MD*

FINALES

Speaking from the grave, ABC's series FINAL WITNESS documents the incredible stories of real-life crimes told from the viewpoint of murder victims who didn't survive. Compelling and compassionate, this series offers a unique look at some of the nation's most shocking murders. Featuring interviews with real-life witnesses, prosecutors, law enforcement, family and friends, FINAL WITNESS creates a haunting study of the human psyche at its core.

- What the Boy Saw *Premieres Monday, November 5 at 10 PM ET* (TV-PG) Beautiful Russian doctor, Nina Reiser, is running errands in her neighborhood when she vanishes into thin air. Family and friends are mystified. An investigation uncovers a tangled web of relationships, thwarted dreams, and three potential suspects. What it doesn't uncover is Reiser. The DA moves forward with a trial, but with minimal evidence and no body, it is an uphill battle. But when a surprise witness takes the stand and tells what he saw the night Reiser disappeared, it forces the killer to reveal himself and lead authorities to her body. *Location: Oakland, CA*
- The Devil You Know *Premieres Monday, November 12 at 10 PM ET* (TV-PG) <u>Donnah Winger</u> has everything she's ever wanted: the perfect husband, the perfect job and now, after years of infertility, the perfect baby. But a chance meeting with a stranger sets in motion a series of events that leaves Winger dead on her kitchen floor bludgeoned with a hammer and fools authorities for years while her killer hides in plain sight. *Location: Springfield, IL*

WHO THE (BLEEP) DID I MARRY? ** TV-PG

Season 3 Finale Airs Wednesday, November 14 at 9 PM ET

Pulling back the curtain on bizarre double lives, WHO THE (BLEEP) DID I MARRY? examines stories of couples in which one spouse has hidden a shocking secret. From bank robbers to bigamists and international spies, these sometimes shocking characters will have viewers shaking their heads in disbelief and wondering how the truths behind these scandalous spouses were kept hidden for so long.

- Ether Man Premieres Wednesday, November 7 at 9 PM ET When single mother Joylynn Martinez met successful businessman Robert "Howard" Bruce, she wasn't looking for love. But Bruce charmed Martinez with his good looks, his dedication to his children, and his unexpected generosity. After two years the couple married, but following the wedding, Martinez noticed that her doting and enigmatic husband had become controlling and quick-tempered. Their picture-perfect life was anything but. Just when Martinez thought things couldn't get any worse in her marriage, she found a shocking videotape and a list of women's names, stumbling upon a 20-year-old cold case that would reveal a dark secret and a twisted double life that Bruce had been hiding from her all along. Location: Pueblo, CO and Albuquerque, NM
- The Ho Hum Bandit *Premieres Wednesday, November 14 at 9 PM ET* Julia Lundstrom was happily single until she met handsome Irishman Adam Lynch. Sparks flew, and the pair quickly became inseparable. But eventually Lundstrom was paying for all of their expenses even though Lynch supposedly had money in the bank, and arguments about money became all too frequent. Lundstrom became suspicious that her boyfriend was hiding something from her, and as the relationship fell apart, she slowly discovered that Lynch was not at all who he claimed to be. In a stunning confession, he admitted to her that he was one of the FBI's most wanted criminals. *Location: Denver, CO*

DEADLY WOMEN ** TV-14

Season 6 Moves to New Timeslot on Friday, November 23 at 9 PM ET Season 6 Finale Airs Friday, November 30 at 9 PM ET

DEADLY WOMEN takes viewers on a journey into the bizarre world of women who kill for thrills. While male murderers are often driven by anger, impulse and destruction, women usually have more complex, long-term motives. Featuring Candice DeLong, a former FBI agent and criminal profiler, this series explores the psyche of female killers, showing what turns love affairs into fatal attractions or how twisted minds and dark secrets can send women on lethal rampages.

- Bury Their Babies Premieres Friday, November 2 at 10 PM ET
 - o <u>Kelly Silk</u> was a mother of four struggling with severe post-partum depression. Unable to cope, Silk stabbed her husband to death while he was sleeping. She then stabbed her 8-

- year-old daughter, <u>Jessica</u>, 61 times and went on to douse the house with gasoline. Silk lit herself on fire, killing herself, her 3-year-old daughter, and 1-year-old son. Jessica and her 4-month-old son survived but were in critical condition. Silk died in her home of self-immolation on June 10, 1999. *Location: East Hartford, CT*
- Stacey Barker was a young mother who dialed 911 in a cry for help, claiming she had been beaten and raped and her infant daughter Emma had been kidnapped from a city park. In truth, police discovered that Barker had suffocated Emma, dumped her tiny body in some bushes, and then inflicted herself with injuries to cover her murderous tracks. In 2001, Barker was convicted of first-degree murder and sentenced 25 years to life in prison. She is eligible for parole in 2036. Location: Lancaster, CA
- Nicole Ann Diar was a single mom who seemed to be growing increasingly tired of caring for her 4-year-old son. In August 2003, Diar's house went up in flames, killing her young son. Diar claimed she tried to rescue him, but investigators found obvious burn marks on the floor where an accelerant had been used. Convicted of aggravated murder and arson, Diar was sentenced to death in October 2005. In 2008 she was resentenced and is now serving life without the possibility of parole. Location: Lorain, OH

• Kinky Killers Premieres Friday, November 9 at 10 PM ET

- Michelle Lyn Michaud had been a reckless teenager, but had settled her wild ways by her early twenties and become a caring mother to her two children. That was until she met bad boy <u>James Daveggio</u>. Within a year she abandoned her children and engaged in a series of kidnappings and sexual assaults that culminated in the torture and murder of a young woman, <u>Vanessa Lei Samson</u>. Both Michaud and Daveggio were sentenced to death in 2002. They are still on death row. *Location: Pleasanton, CA to Lake Tahoe, CA*
- Debra Brown and Alton Coleman were spree killers during the mid-1980s. Brown was Coleman's willing accomplice, actively and aggressively joining him in committing sexually depraved acts. In the summer of 1984, the duo committed at least eight murders, seven rapes, three kidnappings, and 14 armed robberies before they were caught in late July of that year. Brown received life in prison without the possibility of parole. Coleman was given the death penalty and was executed in 2002. *Location: IL, OH, IN, MI, WI, KY*
- o <u>Janice Buttrum</u> came from a life of abuse and severe neglect. Growing up, she was shuttled from one foster home to another until she met and married <u>Danny Buttrum</u>. In 1980, the pair befriended 19-year-old <u>Demetra Faye Parker</u>, but the amicable friendship soon turned deadly, when Buttrum and her husband brutally raped and beat the girl before stabbing her 97 times. Prosecutors argued Parker's rape and murder was part of the couple's sick sexual fantasies. A jury found Buttrum guilty of the murder. She is currently serving life without parole. *Location: Dalton, GA*

• Death Benefits Premieres Friday, November 16 at 10 PM ET

- o Manling Tsang Williams and her husband Neal were happily married with two sons. But after six years of marriage, arguments between the pair were common, and Manling rekindled an old high school love affair. Tired of family life and wanting her freedom, on August 7, 2007, while her husband and children slept, Manling suffocated her sons and then attacked her husband with a ten-inch blade sword from her husband's collection, stabbing him 97 times. Two days later, she was charged with murder and in 2012 sentenced to death. Manling is currently on death row. Location: Rowland Heights, CA
- O Rhonda Bell Martin was a waitress and American serial killer who confessed in March 1956 to poisoning her mother, two husbands, and three of her children. Prosecutors said collecting insurance proceeds prompted Martin's serial killing spree, although this is unlikely, since she only collected enough to cover burial costs, and she never admitted this was the case. Martin was convicted of murder and executed in Alabama's electric chair on October 11, 1957. Location: Alabama
- Marilyn Plantz was a seemingly average suburban wife and mother of two, but in reality, she was unhappy and having an affair with a local teenager. Plantz convinced the boy and his friend to murder her husband so she could collect the death benefit from his insurance

policy. On August 26, 1988, the teens ambushed <u>James Plantz</u> at home, beating him with bats while Marilyn and the kids slept. When Marilyn awoke, she instructed the boys to 'burn him' to make it look like an accident. Marilyn Plantz was sentenced to death and killed by lethal injection in 2001. *Location: Midwest City, OK*

• Mommy's Little Helpers Premieres Friday, November 23 at 9 PM ET

- Edith McAlinden grew up homeless in a bad part of town. Living the hard life, she quickly learned how to manipulate men and turn tricks for alcohol and cash. On October 17, 2004, a night of scamming friends turned ugly, and McAlinden snapped. She attacked her boyfriend, stabbing him in the leg, and then enlisted the help of her 16-year-old son and his friend to finish what she started. By sunrise, three men were dead. McAlinden pled guilty to murder and received a minimum of 13 years. Location: Glasgow, Scotland
- When Lois Nadean Smith heard a rumor that her son's ex-girlfriend, Cindy Baillee, had threatened to have him killed, she orchestrated a plan to settle the score herself. On the morning of July 4, 1982, Smith convinced Baillee to come for a drive with her and her son to a remote location. Smith interrogated and taunted Baillee with a gun, ultimately firing several bullets into the young girl's body. Found guilty of murder, Smith was sentenced to death and executed by lethal injection in 2001. Location: Oklahoma
- Hilma Marie Witte had endured mental and physical abuse as a child. As an adult, she claimed that her husband, <u>Paul</u>, was physically abusive to her and her two sons. In 1981, after several failed attempts at poisoning Paul, Hilma successfully convinced her 15-year-old son to kill his father. In 1984, Hilma convinced her other teenage son to kill his live-in grandmother so they could collect her social security checks. The family was finally caught in 1985. Hilma will remain in prison until at least 2028. *Location: Indiana*

• Eternal Revenge Premieres Friday, November 30 at 9 PM ET

- <u>Lastania Abarta</u> was a beautiful young woman living in the late 1800s. As the son of one of the state's richest men, <u>Chico Forster</u> was used to getting who and what he wanted. For three years Forster pursued Abarta, who repeatedly refused his advances. Knowing the only way to bed the beauty would be to offer his hand in marriage, Forster did just that, but when Abarta realized she had been used, she was overcome with despair and shot her lying fiancé. Abarta was found not guilty, the jury agreeing with an expert who said that she only reacted the same way any virtuous woman would. *Location: Los Angeles, CA*
- Marcela Whaley and Kimberlyn Estrada were lesbian lovers and Mexican immigrants with big dreams of life in a new country. But their relationship didn't last and the two soon found themselves both vying for the affections of their housemate, <u>Tzatzi Sanchez</u>. When Sanchez chose Estrada as her new lover, Whaley was enraged. Wanting revenge, she hired two men to kill Sanchez, and then fled back to Mexico after the murder. For nearly five years, she was a free woman, but in 2007, she was charged and found guilty and sentenced to more than 37 years in a Mexican jail. Location: Las Vegas, NV
- Diane Borchardt was a woman who seemed to have a happy and loving family, but her home life was toxic and her marriage rapidly disintegrating. Fearing divorce and the loss of her home, Borchardt solicited her students to kill her husband Ruben, offering cars and \$20,000 from her husband's insurance policy. On April 3rd, 1994, the teenagers broke into the house and shot Ruben twice. Borchardt was found guilty a year later and was sentenced to life in prison. Location: Jefferson, WI

Hosted by soap opera legend Susan Lucci, DEADLY AFFAIRS proves that they happen in real life and, sometimes, are even stranger than fiction.

• Predator or Prey Premieres Saturday, November 3 at 10 PM E/P

- Carey and Robin Heidt seem to have it all. Pillars of the community, the Heidts built up a real estate empire with the family business. All this comes crashing down when Craig, the black sheep of the family, starts having eyes for his brother's wife. After more than a decade of marriage a little adventure is exactly what Robin is looking for, leading to an affair with her husband's bad boy brother. Location: Georgia
- Shane and Jessica Hill look like any happy young couple, but when Shane's best hunting buddy moves in with them, their happy lives are flipped upside down. Life as a truck driver takes Shane on the road and with her husband away Jessica takes things into overdrive with his best friend. This brotherly bond is about to get deadly. *Location: Iowa*

• Love Thy Neighbor Premieres Saturday, November 10 at 10 PM E/P

- After nearly two decades of life on the road as a military family, <u>Kay and David Parsons</u> settle down in a quiet suburb of Augusta, Georgia. The Parsons family easily bond with their new neighbors, the Sears. It's not long before <u>Becky Sears</u> finds herself drawn to David's attention. A secret affair quickly spirals out of control leading to broken hearts, shattered lives, and a most tragic murder. *Location: Augusta, GA*
- Randy and Teresa Stone are known in their community as trustworthy neighbors and active and generous congregants at the local Baptist church. But it seems that the new pastor is taking special attention to Teresa. Pastor Love and Teresa begin a passionate and forbidden romance. And after a torrid decade-long affair, it is only a matter of time before everything comes crashing down and someone ends up dead. Location: Kansas City, MO

SINS & SECRETS TV-14

Season 3 Finale Airs Sunday, November 25 at 9 PM ET

In SINS & SECRETS, the location of the crime is a central character in each case. Each immersive one-hour episode shows how a crime alters the community in which it occurs, and reveals how the people and place are irrevocably changed by the terrible aftermath.

- Boone *Premieres Sunday, November 4 at 9 PM ET* Boone, N.C., is part hippie-friendly college town, part rural mountain village. The town's mix of free-thinking and seclusion has lured folks for years. But when resident <u>Jeni Gray</u> mysteriously vanished, the entire town was left wondering what happened. Gray was nowhere to be found and police were at their wit's end when a second woman, <u>Leigh Cooper</u>, disappeared. But unlike Gray, Cooper soon reappeared, and the story she told was a shocker she'd just escaped from a killer. A killer that was stalking the women of Boone one by one.
- Omaha *Premieres Sunday, November 11 at 9 PM ET* Omaha, Neb., is a Midwest boomtown built on cattle and cash. But in 2009, the city's growth was setback when local father and son, Brian and Ryan Carson, mysteriously disappeared following a break-in at their home. Police searched the city and surrounding area for signs of either man. But after analyzing the evidence and digging into their backgrounds, investigators soon realized there was more to this case than met the eye. And that behind the dual disappearances wasn't a burglary-gone-awry, but a conspiracy with deep family ties.
- Palo Alto *Premieres Sunday, November 18 at 9 PM ET* Palo Alto, Calif., is the heart of Silicon Valley. But in 2009 a shocking murder would leave hipsters clutching their laptops in fear. Popular couple Paul Zumot and Jennifer Schipsi's cottage mysteriously caught fire. Schipsi was pronounced dead at the scene, but she didn't die of smoke inhalation. Rather, she been strangled to death. When Zumot produced a solid alibi, a string of abusive ex-boyfriends came under fire. And the well-to-do community was divided in controversy.
- Carthage *Premieres Sunday*, *November 25 at 9 PM ET* Carthage, Texas is a friendly little city known for its big heart and welcoming hands. But there was one person in Carthage who wasn't so hospitable: millionaire widow <u>Marjorie Nugent</u>. Nugent had a grudge with nearly everyone in town, so when she disappeared in 1997, almost every citizen was a suspect. But as the investigation progressed, and the suspect pool began to narrow, the case would come to center on the one person in town no one suspected.

When a killer strikes, the trail to conviction can be long and arduous. Investigators sift through a tangle of evidence from crime scenes slick with blood; suspects and witnesses seem be hiding something; and even the most suspicious characters claim to have an alibi. BLOOD, LIES AND ALIBIS tracks criminal investigators as they unravel the stories behind cold blooded killings. With the help of forensic evidence, old fashioned legwork, and years of dogged determination, detectives and district attorneys deliver justice to families and communities mourning their dead.

- The Laser Man *Premieres Monday, November 5 at 9 PM ET* During a time when immigration in Sweden is growing, feelings of racism are also on the rise. On August 2, 1991, one man begins a desperate attack by shooting young immigrants on the streets of Stockholm. His weapon of choice is a laser-guided rifle, which would eventually earn him the dubious nickname "The Laser Man". *Location: Stockholm, Sweden*
- The Happy Face Killer *Premieres Monday, November 12 at 8 PM ET* A common-law couple is found guilty of the 1990 rape and murder of <u>Taunja Bennett</u>. However, a letter signed with a happy face sent to a Portland newspaper claims responsibility for the murder of Bennett and others. The letter remains a mystery until <u>Keith Jesperson</u> is arrested on an unrelated murder charge. Investigators unravel the truth, convicting Jesperson, "The Happy Face Killer," of Bennett's murder, and free the wrongfully convicted couple. *Location: Portland, OR*
- The Slave Master *Premieres Monday, November 19 at 8 PM ET* Several women go missing from the Kansas City area in the 1980s and 1990s, three of whom disappear shortly after traveling to Missouri to meet a man they had initially encountered online. Police come to believe that one man is behind all the disappearances. Their surveillance of conman <u>John Edward Robinson</u> lead them to the gruesome discovery of the women's fate. *Location: Kansas City, MO*
- The Abducted Atheist *Premieres Monday, November 26 at 8 PM ET* American Atheist founder Madalyn Murray O'Hair and her family vanish in August 1995, leaving behind an ominous note claiming a family emergency. When the IRS start looking for some of the organization's missing money, they instead find a former employee with a motive to commit murder. Fellow Atheist David Waters is convicted and the complex case is finally put to rest. *Location: San Antonio, TX*

DEVIL YOU KNOW TV-14

DEVIL YOU KNOW delves into the secret lives of men and women who masquerade as law-abiding citizens but, behind the charade, are hiding deadly intentions from their loved ones. As each story unfolds, family and friends give first-hand accounts of the unimaginable betrayal that left them in the dark. These harrowing personal testimonials take viewers on a twisted journey as witnesses wrestle with the demons and devils they have come to know all too well.

- Twisted Faith *Premieres Wednesday, November 7 at 10 PM ET* Jennifer and Michael Blagg seemed to have the perfect Christian marriage. Michael was a successful engineer who had served as lieutenant commander during Operation Desert Storm, and Jennifer was a devoted stay-athome mom. But tragedy struck in November 2001, when Michael returned home to find his wife and daughter missing from their upscale Colorado home. Was it a kidnapping? If so, why was there so much blood in the master bedroom? As Michael made public appeals that sparked a nation's sympathy, police were on the hunt for a cold-blooded killer. *Location: Redlands, CO*
- The Cleveland Strangler Premieres Wednesday, November 14 at 10 PM ET Lori Frazier was by no means living a charmed life in Cleveland's rough Eastside neighborhood. But hope was renewed the day she met handsome Anthony Sowell, who took her into his home and treated her with loving care. The ex-marine had a strong work ethic, and liked to cook and clean. But when Sowell turned to addiction in 2007, women began to vanish off the streets without a trace. Frazier would be horrified when she learned how Sowell's sanctuary had become a house of horrors. Location: Cleveland, OH

• Against All Odds *Premieres Wednesday, November 28 at 10 PM ET* After a string of bad relationships, <u>Frankie Cochran</u> was hopeful the day she met <u>Dave Gerard</u> while waitressing tables in a rural diner. Gerard was a hard-working truck driver who treated her well. When they both found work in a dairy barn, Cochran thought she had achieved her dream come true – a simple life in the country with animals. But oddly, the cows seemed to scare every time Gerard paid her a visit in the milking parlor. Then, one night in March, Cochran would come face-to-face with a monster, and police would be on the hunt for a serial killer who had eluded them for too long. *Location: Oakville, WA*

ONGOING SERIES

HOMICIDE HUNTER: LT. JOE KENDA ** TV-14

Season 2 Continues Tuesdays at 9 PM ET

A murder will change the life of a victim, their families, and the convicted killer...but what about the investigator whose days and nights are consumed by finding answers? In each episode of **HOMICIDE HUNTER: LT. JOE KENDA**, the 24-year veteran of Colorado's homicide investigation unit – who has one of the highest case closure rates in the country – reveals chillingly vivid memories of murders that still haunt him today. Through personal interviews, and with the help of reenactments, Kenda recounts in detail the twists, turns, and emotional tribulations of trying to bring peace to each victim's family.

- Slaughterhouse Six *Premieres Tuesday, November 6 at 9 PM ET* Off-duty soldier and father of two, <u>Layne Schmidtke</u>, is brutally beaten to death by a mob of angry teenagers on his way home from a bar. Lt. Joe Kenda must meticulously reconstruct the chaotic scene through a conflicting assortment of witness testimonies, but his hopes rest on forensic evidence taken at the scene. As the mystery unfolds, a group of high school girls bravely step forward to reveal a shocking motive and an unlikely suspect as the murderous ringleader.
- Drive Thru Murder *Premieres Tuesday, November 13 at 9 PM ET* Hard-working fast food manager Missy Berry is found in an idling car at a deserted intersection with a single bullet wound to the head. Lt. Joe Kenda retraces Berry's path and uncovers a few promising leads. When the investigation reaches an impasse, Kenda gets a tip from a fellow cop that shines a light on an unassuming suspect. But as Kenda gets closer to cracking the case, a surprise twist takes him into uncharted territory.
- **Primal Fear** *Premieres Tuesday, November 20 at 9 PM ET* Promising student <u>J.L. Jackson</u> is gunned down in a vicious shooting, only steps from his high school. To find out who wanted the popular 14-year-old dead, Lieutenant Joe Kenda must comb through the unreliable testimony of dozens of teen witnesses, and assemble a timeline of the events leading up to the murder. As the pieces fall into place, Kenda uncovers a simmering vendetta stemming from a heated lunchroom confrontation, and zeroes in on a new kid with a violent and overprotective family.
- A Beautiful Shade of Death *Premieres Tuesday, November 27 at 9 PM ET* When first responders discover the lifeless bodies of <u>Sophia Gerardo</u>, four children, and a house cat, police suspect they've stumbled onto the gruesome aftermath of a ritualistic mass murder. But when Lieutenant Joe Kenda takes over the investigation, he discovers a reality far more frightening and deadly than anyone could have imagined. After a series of false leads, Kenda uncovers a bizarre chain of events that bring him face to face with a stealthy killer and an unwitting accomplice.

THE WILL: FAMILY SECRETS REVEALED returns featuring the outrageousness that abounds when the famous depart. With royalties and residuals up for grabs, celebrities leave behind a lot more than a mansion full of cash – and they also leave behind managers, mom-agers, mistresses, and family members who all want a piece of the pie. This new season runs the gamut in spotlighting superstars that range from up-and-comers who die young and will-less like <u>Ritchie Valens</u> to icons like <u>Jerry Garcia</u>, whose grateful

heart promised too much to too many. When the personalities are big but the pocketbooks are even bigger, now *that's* when things get really interesting.

- The Estate of Ted Williams *Premieres Thursday, November 1 at 9 PM ET* In July 2002, legendary Red Sox hitter <u>Ted Williams</u> dies at the age of 83. Without informing his half-sister, Williams' youngest children whisk away his body to be cryogenically preserved. But Williams' official will requested cremation, and his eldest daughter takes to the courts to fight to have his body returned, dividing the family with allegations of manipulation, estrangement, and fraud...until a former employee at the cryonics company reports that Ted Williams's body has met a horrifying fate.
- The Estate of Andy Warhol *Premieres Thursday, November 8 at 9 PM ET* In February, 1987, Andy Warhol, the iconoclastic artist and 'prince of pop art,' dies from complications after a routine operation. Just 58 years old, he is one of the wealthiest artists of his time. With appraisals of his work ranging from \$95 million to almost \$600 million, the fight for art gets ugly. His estate lawyer and his charitable foundation duke it out amid allegations of fraud, price-fixing, and shady backroom deals. The dispute culminates in a legal standoff that calls into question Warhol's value as an artist and his legacy as a cultural icon and just how much his own "15 minutes of fame" is worth
- The Estate of Etta James *Premieres Thursday, November 15 at 9 PM ET* After a roller coaster life of musical highs and drug addicted lows, Grammy Award-winning singer Etta James is on her deathbed—50 years after her signature song "At Last" topped the charts. But in her final days, James is too weak to express her dying wishes, and instead of rallying together, her family is bitterly divided over who should control James' end-of-life decisions—and her fortune. Her husband fights to keep her at home no matter the cost, while her sons fear their stepfather is being reckless with what's left of their mother's estate. The debate rages on in the courtroom—and the clock is ticking to find a resolution before it's too late. Will Etta James find peace at last?
- The Estate of LaTanya Haggerty *Premieres Thursday, November 29 at 9 PM ET* In 1999, 26-year-old LaTanya Haggerty is shot dead by Chicago police in a high-speed car chase. Her bereft family discovers Haggerty died without a will. They sue the City of Chicago for wrongful death and negotiate an \$18 million dollar settlement the largest in Chicago's history. A third of the funds go to the lawyers, and the rest is doled out to Haggerty's family members. But Haggerty's half-sister has been cut out of the deal, and she fights tooth and nail for her portion of the settlement fund. But it's up to the courts to decide how much she gets and that depends entirely on how close they decide the two sisters, 20 years apart, really were. *Location: Chicago, IL*

VERY BAD MEN ** TV-14

Season 2 Continues Thursdays at 10 PM ET

Predators, swindlers and masters of fraud, very bad men are everywhere. This incredible true crime series exposes some of the most notorious criminals on record as told by key members of the police, family, friends and the victims themselves. Each episode details the methods of fraud, bigamy, crimes of passion, murder and the horrendous impact these men have had on their victim's lives, leaving little doubt that these are some VERY BAD MEN.

- The Bayou Strangler *Premieres Thursday, November 1 at 10 PM ET* In 2005, ditches, bayous, and cornfields across three parishes are becoming the gravesites for young men. Sodomized, then strangled, their dead bodies are left out in the open. The killer is dubbed the Bayou Strangler by the media, and as the body count goes up, so does the pressure to catch him. With a task force assembled and help from the FBI, police finally crack the case with old-fashioned investigation skills. They unmask an unlikely killer: a quiet loner, with a dangerously clever MO. *Location: Louisiana*
- A Deadly Burning Passion *Premieres Thursday, November 8 at 10 PM ET* Between February 2003 and December 2004, a serial arsonist sets off a series of house fires that grow bigger and deadlier with each new blaze. District fire investigators chase the fire bug who targets detached homes, setting fire in the doorways with a tell-tale incendiary device: a cloth wick in a plastic jug of gasoline. Even worse, the arsonist appears to be setting fires for sexual gratification.

- Investigators race against the clock to stop a faceless killer, before the next fire can claim another innocent life. *Location: Washington, DC*
- Captured Alive *Premieres Thursday*, *November 15 at 10 PM ET* When a house goes up in flames, police have no reason to suspect that the reclusive owner has been kidnapped and held prisoner by a sexual sadist. After sifting through the rubble of <u>Lois Pearson's</u> home, investigators determine that the homeowner is the victim of arson, yet her body remains missing. The sinister reality finally comes to light when a man tries to cash her personal check. But nothing can prepare investigators for the horror they witness when they investigate the man behind the fraudulent check. *Location: Witt, TX*
- A Killer in Disguise *Premieres Thursday, November 29 at 10 PM ET* In March 1994, a gunman is on a crime spree across Orange County, California. He's armed and dangerous, and the violence of his crimes is escalating rapidly. By July, when a simple robbery turns into brutal murder, police must find the gunman before his next crime. But their suspect is a master of disguise. He has amassed an arsenal of deadly weapons, and now police must use all their investigative skills to catch the gunman before he detonates. *Location: Orange County, CA*

UNUSUAL SUSPECTS ** TV-14

Season 4 Continues Sundays at 10 PM ET

Each one-hour episode showcases some of the most baffling and challenging cases in contemporary law enforcement, and commends the unwavering investigations that led to the arrest of these unlikely culprits. Featuring in-depth interviews from some of America's top investigative forces, viewers find out how these illusive offenders evaded justice for years, and how persistent police work and a passion for justice ultimately got them caught.

- Triple Threat Premieres Sunday, November 11 at 10 PM ET In June 1993, 32-year-old Norma Rodriguez is found strangled on the floor of her home, her head wrapped entirely in duct tape. Rodriguez and her estranged husband were in constant conflict over child support and custody for their 4-year-old son. Did he end their once-happy union in a fit of rage? Rodriguez's keys, which had gone missing during a BBQ she hosted three days earlier, are found beside her body. Could she have rubbed shoulders with her killer at her own party for family and friends? In the ensuing weeks, two more women are brutally murdered in their homes. Investigators wonder if Rodriguez was the first victim of a homegrown serial killer. Unwilling to let the case go, a veteran detective uncovers new evidence that finally brings a killer to justice. Location: Port Hueneme, CA
- City Under Siege Premieres Sunday, November 18 at 10 PM ET In 2006, 20-year-old Claudia Gutierrez-Cruz is brutally gunned down while walking home from her shift at a nightclub. Police grill everyone who had contact with the victim. But they must also consider another grim possibility. For more than a year, the city has been plagued by a string of drive-by pedestrian shootings. Is Claudia just the latest victim? Investigators chase down jealous boyfriends and fearless police impersonators with equal zeal until Gutierrez-Cruz's killer is finally brought to justice. Location: Scottsdale, AZ
- **Killings in Kentucky** *Premieres Sunday, November 25 at 10 PM ET* On a winter morning in 1993, a rural Kentucky town is gripped with shock when the bodies of beloved Veterinarian <u>Joe Wellnitz</u>, his wife <u>Beth</u>, and their adult son <u>Dennis</u> are found gunned down in their farmhouse. The Wellnitz family is well-respected in the community and known for its generosity, so deducing a motive for the horrific home invasion is no easy task. Police sift through promising leads and suspects from salacious family secrets and disgruntled business associates to links to the Occult and an eerily similar murder in the area. Finally, the unwavering detectives uncover the bitter truth behind the tragic triple-slaying. *Location: Columbia, KY*
