All-New Season Premieres Monday, December 9 at 10/9c

- **Twist of Hate Premieres Monday, December 9 at 10/9c** Single mother Dawn Hillver dates whip-smart men like Mike McClellan. But when Dawn's ready to move on, Mike's not willing to let go and begins a vicious campaign of stalking, and threatening her reputation and life.
- **Cruel Intentions Premieres Monday, December 9 at 10:30/9:30c** Student Christen Naujoks thinks she's met her college sweetheart, John Peck. But when John reveals his cruel nature, she breaks things off. Then a newspaper article exposes his dark past, and John stops at nothing to get revenge.

Ronald was found guilty of attempted murder and sentenced to life. He says he is innocent and wants the chance to tell his side of the story.
- **Friendly Fire Premieres Friday, December 20 at 8/7c** Neighbors Slyvilla Humphrey and Ercell Minix were close friends until a dispute left them in a constant argument. And when the verbal arguments grow into physical altercations, only one neighbor survives.
- **Bloody Murder Premieres Friday, December 27 at 8/7c** Charles Dean Hood has served 24 years on Death Row for killing his housemate Tracie Wallace and mentor Ronald Williamson.
