CONTINUING SERIES (New Episodes)

(P) Denotes: Premieres

"Season 25: Oprah Behind The Scenes" Sundays (8-9 p.m. ET/PT)

For the first and last time, "The Oprah Winfrey Show" opens its doors to invite viewers behind the scenes for the making of the farewell season. See what happens off-camera as the staff, guests and Oprah herself reveal a side the public has never seen of one of television's most popular and enduring series. Get an inside look at the passion, the pressure and the people that dedicate their lives to producing one of the most beloved shows in television history.

(P) Sunday, July 10 (8-9 p.m. ET/PT)

Oprah attempts to uncover secrets the producers have planned for her final shows.

(P) Sunday, July 17 (8-9 p.m. ET/PT)

Go backstage as dozens of celebrities and 13,000 fans turn out to surprise Oprah in a surprise farewell tribute.

(P) Sunday, July 24 (8-9 p.m. ET/PT) Special Edition

For the first time, Oprah opens up to her staff about the star-studded surprise spectacular they produced at Chicago's United Center and the whole team shares their candid thoughts in this revealing sit-down.

"Finding Sarah: From Royalty to the Real World" Sundays (9-10 p.m. ET/PT)

After decades under the harsh glare of the media spotlight, Sarah Ferguson, the Duchess of York, is undertaking her toughest challenge yet, rebuilding her life and career. Candid and unprecedented, the new six-episode series follows the Duchess' emotional struggle to find herself and happiness. Following a major scandal last year, the Duchess hit rock bottom. Feeling inspired after a tell-all interview with Oprah Winfrey, the Duchess decides she must confront her past and take positive steps to change her life.

- (P) Sunday, July 10 (9-10 p.m. ET/PT) Episode: Life or Death Challenge...

 Desperate to get into shape, the Duchess agrees to a 26-mile trek through Canada's Arctic an undertaking that will require her to get in the best shape of her life both physically and mentally. With the help of a world-class trainer, she embarks on an intense five-week training program. Her commitment to the challenge is steadfast until she is hit with some unexpected news, which threatens to bring back her self-destructive behavior.
- (P) Sunday, July 17 (9-10 p.m. ET/PT) Episode: The Hardest Journey of All After five weeks of intense training in Los Angeles, the Duchess travels to Yellowknife, Canada where she once honeymooned with Prince Andrew. Now, 25 years later, she's back, to take on a 26-mile trek in below freezing temperatures through the Arctic. Although ready both physically and mentally, being back in Yellowknife stirs up emotions that put the challenge at risk.

(P) Sunday, July 24 (9-10 p.m. ET/PT)

As her journey winds down, the Duchess visits with Oprah and fills her in on what she has learned about herself. She is then surprised when her older sister Jane flies is from Australia for an unexpected visit. After an emotional conversation with Jane, the Duchess heads to see Dr Phil for the last time. Still struggling with the attention that comes with being a high profile personality, he gives her an easy solution – deal with it or leave public life. Back in England, she grapples with that notion when she once again finds herself at the center of a media scandal. With a reinforced sense of strength, she refuses to buckle under the pressure and tackles the crisis head on.

"Ryan & Tatum: The O'Neals" Sundays (10-11 p.m. ET/PT)

This series follows the emotional reunion of acting dynasty Ryan & Tatum O'Neal after 25 years of estrangement. As they look back at the moments that led to their fractured relationship, they struggle to rebuild and piece together their once strong bond.

- (P) Sunday, July 10 (10-11 p.m. ET/PT) Episode: It's Only A Paper Moon
 Ryan and Tatum attend a screening of "Paper Moon" at The Palm Springs Film Festival. For Tatum, the trip is a chance to connect with her father and relive memories of her mother, Ryan's troubled first wife who passed away in Palm Springs 15 years ago.
- (P) Sunday, July 17 (10-11 p.m. ET/PT) Episode: Sobering News
 As Tatum struggles with Ryan's insensitivity to her sobriety, Ryan's therapist suggests it's time for him and Tatum to start joint therapy together to continue mending their relationship.

(P) Sunday, July 24 (10-11 p.m. ET/PT) Episode: For the Love of Farrah

When Ryan invites Tatum to Washington, D.C. to take part in a Farrah Fawcett induction ceremony at the Smithsonian, Tatum is overwhelmed with her feelings of abandonment from when Ryan chose his love for Farrah over his children.

(P) Sunday, July 31 (10-11 p.m. ET/PT) Episode: At A Crossroad

Back home after the confrontation in Washington, D.C., Ryan and Tatum are not speaking. But after a conversation with a friend who lost her father before she had a chance to reconcile with him, Tatum arranges a family therapy session for herself and Ryan.
