PREMIERES

BULLET POINTS TV-PG

Season 1 Premieres Monday, April 15 at 10 PM E/P

Each action-packed episode of BULLET POINTS dives into history's most important battles to learn their larger significance in the outcome of the war. - **Battle for the Pacific premieres Monday, April 15 at 10 PM E/P** How did America recover from Pearl Harbor and, in one short year, achieve supremacy in the Pacific over the fearsome Japanese empire? From the Battle of the Coral Sea to the Guadalcanal Campaign, BULLET POINTS highlights the defining battles and identifies the decisive moments that turned the tide for the Americans and led to victory in the Pacific theater. - **The Vietnam War premieres Monday, April 29 at 10 PM E/P** American military involvement in Vietnam lasted twelve years and cost the lives of almost 60,000 soldiers. From the first shots fired in the Gulf of Tonkin through the fall of Saigon, take a new look the war's defining moments most important battles. - **Bulge: Holding the Line premieres Tuesday, April 2 at 10 PM E/P** In December 1944, Hitler launched one of the biggest campaigns of World War II. 200,000 Nazi troops attacked 83,000 Americans in the Ardennes Forest, Belgium, and forced a 50-mile salient deep into Allied lines. Under-supplied, living in fox holes in sub-zero temperatures, and facing an experienced and aggressive enemy, American infantry and paratroopers had to first hold, then try to turn the might of the German army, and force them back the way they came. The Battle of the Bulge cost 19,000 American lives, becoming the largest and bloodiest battle of the Second World War
