PREMIERES

THE BIBLE'S GREATEST SECRETS TV-PG

Series Premieres Sunday, December 8 at 9 PM E/P

THE BIBLE'S GREATEST SECRETS explores iconic figures and events from biblical times. With historical, archaeological and anthropological evidence, this journey reveals the Bible's most compelling people and stories.

- The Death of Jesus *Premieres Sunday, December 8 at 9 PM E/P* This episode revisits the trial of Jesus Christ and his horrific death by crucifixion to examine what really happened. Return to the dusty world of first century Judea and the power politics of the Jewish authorities, the Imperial Roman Empire and the revolutionary ideas of Jesus and his followers.

Merrill leads the 3,000 American volunteers of his 5307th Composite Unit (Provisional), aka "Merrill's Marauders," behind Japanese lines across Burma to Myitkyina, pushing beyond their limits and fighting pitched battles at every strongpoint.
