September 4 (Labor Day)

"Superman: The Animated Series" (9-9:30 a.m. and 6:30-7 p.m.)

The animated series follows the legendary superhero in exciting new stories that chronicle the adventures of the last son of Krypton as he protects his adoptive home of Earth by battling the forces of villainy and continuing his quest for truth, justice and the American way. Featuring the vocal talents of Tim Daly ("Wings") and Dana Delany ("Body of Evidence," "Desperate Housewives").

"The Aquabats! Super Show!" Marathon (noon-3 p.m.) – Hub TV Network Original Series This Labor Day, The Hub will feature a marathon of six back-to-back episodes of the outrageous comedyadventure series "The Aquabats! "Sliders" (10-11 p.m.)
