- A con artist and expert manipulator who tricks one of his closest friends into gunning down his pregnant wife;
- The owner of Hollywood's only silent movie theatre, who becomes sugar daddy to a male hustler and is soon worth more dead than alive when he makes the companion his sole beneficiary;
- A Vietnam vet who hatches a deadly scheme to have his wife killed, until she proves tougher than she looks;
- The brother-on-brother feud that hatched behind the scenes of iconic porn film *Deep Throat* and ended with expertly trained killers stepping in to take care of business.
