### **The Rivers Edge**

**Sunday, July 8 at 10 PM ET**

When seventeen-year-old high school student Stacey Fairchild disappears from a mall parking lot, Lancaster, Ohio police wonder if she ran away, was she kidnapped, or succumbed to a worst fate. Zahn speaks with a young woman who escaped from an attack inside a tanning salon and helped police link DNA from her attacker to the Fairchild mystery.
