ANIMAL PLANET'S FATAL ATTRACTIONS ENTERS ITS SECOND SEASON WITH FIVE NEW EPISODES

- A passionate Texas animal trainer trusts his beloved animals so much that he introduces his 12year-old daughter to the act. Trusting her father, she feels completely safe in a ring with six fully grown tigers. But can her mother's fear and influence get in the way of her dream?
- In Australia, a nurse has a curious living situation she takes in stray domestic pets, has a 16year-old son and shares her home with three pet crocodiles.
- Things don't turn out well for a New York corrections officer who is rammed and pierced repeatedly by his pet deer.
