<u>VICTORIA STILWELL RESTORES CANINE CONTROL</u> <u>AND DISCIPLINES INDULGENT PET PARENTS ON THE THIRD SEASON</u> <u>OF ANIMAL PLANET'S *IT'S ME OR THE DOG*</u>

In a season full of surprises, Victoria steps outside of her comfort zone by even training a micro-pig! From using doggie yoga to blindfolded boating, she pulls out all the stops to transform these animals and their owners.
